Marawi IDPs get livelihood intervention from DOST

Three technologies from the Department of Science and Technology-Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI) handed over to the Maranao People Center, Development (MARADECA, Inc. Inc.) for the livelihood and development of the Marawi siege victims on April 10-11, 2019 at the Provincial Capitol, Marawi City.

One of the technologies was the Essential Oil Extractor which extracts essential oils from Citronella Grass and other plant materials that are abundant in Marawi City.

Essential oils are the aroma-giving constituents of aromatic plants. These oils are water-insoluble organic liquids or solids.

The second was the Charcoal Briquetting Equipment which was made up of ITDI Modified Drum Carbonizer, Crusher, Mixer, and Manual Briquettor.

Briquetting is a process of molding or compacting materials such as charcoal fines of biomass or coal, with or without binder under

pressure.

The other technology was the Tea Bag Processing Equipment. The participants were trained on herbal processing from the collection of plant materials to Herbal Tea and Herbal Capsule production.

The Marawi IDPs were able to processed Moringa Herbal Tea and Turmeric Herbal Tea out of the collected Moringa and Turmeric plant materials.


The three equipment are now available anytime for the use and livelihood of the Marawi IDPs.

Aside from the turned-over equipment, DOST-ITDI also trained the Maranaos on Personal and Home Care products wherein the participants were able to produce Dishwashing Liquid, Hand Wash, and different

kinds of soap.

The conduct of the activity was in collaboration with DOST, DOST-ITDI, Task Force Bangon Marawi, NDRRMC, The Ethne Essence Project, LGU-Marawi, and the Province of Lanao del Sur.

Together, they expected an impact of improved living quality of Maranaos through sustainable livelihood programs using their natural resources. Ma. Lilibeth P. Padilla

Live coral cover discovered in Manila Bay

Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) found live coral cover in the Manila Bay, giving hopes that the heavily-polluted body of water could still be returned to its natural condition.

DENR's research arm Ecosystems

and Development Bureau (ERDB) has administered an inventory of the coral ecosystems within Manila Bay, and discovered that many of them are flourishing despite environmental and human pressures.

ERDB supervising science research specialist Jose Isidro Michael Padin said a majority of the coral cover was found in Corregidor and Caballo Islands in Cavite province.


"Nearly 72 percent of the estimated reef area is found in Cavite. The reef sites in Maragondon and few stations in Corregidor and Caballo Islands had fair to good live coral cover," Padin said.

He, however, these reefs were continually being endangered by sedimentation, nutrient contamination, reduced water clarity, and high fishing pressure due to increased vulnerability sheltering the bay.

Based on the coastal resource map prepared by the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority or NAM-RIA, Manila Bay's coral cover spans 293.68 hectares, but this data does not yet include that of Mariveles in Bataan.

DENR Secretary Roy Cimatu, who oversees the inter-agency Manila Bay Task Force, said that the findings that coral reefs were still growing in many parts of the bay gas given the government more reason to proceed with the rehabilitation. (gocavite)

Moreover, they are floored with artificial grass mats to decrease the risk of play injuries. Also, these parks are lighted with double-arm lampposts. Aside from this, two (2) security guards are on-duty during the park operating hours. The

days. On the other hand, the Emmanuel Bergado park opens from 5pm to 8pm from Mondays to Sundays.



Calabarzon soon an insurgency-free region

Presidential er for Southern Tagalog, Secretary Dennis Hernandez, expressed optimism on Wednesday the Calabarzon region will soon become insurgency-free.

He said this in his remarks during Wednesday's closing rites of the Regional Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict (RTF ELCAC) 4A's Indigenous People's Summit here.

Hernandez said Calabarzon is seen to eradicate the insurgency soon following the recent dismantling of the New People's Army (NPA) front operating in the provinces of Batangas and Cavite.

Hernandez said this development was followed by the declaration of Cavite as the first province in the country with Stable Internal Peace and Security (SIPS).

"President Rodrigo Duterte is very serious in ending insurgency and the key to attaining this is convergence, something that we have been doing in Southern Tagalog," said Hernandez, who also serves as chair of the RTF ELCAC 4A.

Local peace talks and initiatives have contributed to the efforts to ensure an all-inclusive peace and development in the region, he said.

He said through the teamwork and convergence among government agencies, local government units and development stakeholders, poverty and insurgency in the region would be addressed. Aside from Batangas and Cavite, included in the Calabarzon region are the provinces of Laguna, Rizal and Que-

During the summit, Undersecretary naldo Mapagu of the Department of National Defense's Task Force Balik-Loob lauded "Team Southern Tagalog" for the activation of RTF ELCAC, implementation of the enhanced comprehensive local integration program, and addressing the needs and concerns of the IP community.







CITY, Cavite - The city government directed on Tuesday its engineering, fire and general services

immediately inspect all private and public buildings, including vital infrastructure projects

the 6.1 quake that jolted Luzon last April 22.

In an interview, city Business Permit and said the directive, issued through a memorandum signed by Mayor Antonio A. Ferrer, is in response to the call of Interior and Local Government Secretary Eduardo M. Año's to all local government units (LGUs) to inspect all buildings in their areas of responsibility to ensure public safety.

Año, in a press briefing last week, urged all LGUs to last week, immediately inspect all buildings following the 6.1-magniture earthquake on April 22 which jolted parts of Luzon, including Cavite's Tagaytay City (intensity IV), and the cities of Dasmariñas, General Trias, Cavite and the town of Indang (intensity III).

"Although the city's joint inspection team (comprised of BPLO, city fire, engineering, health, environment, planning and treasurer's offices) conducts weekly inspection to validate the local establishments' compliance to local national safety regulations, another round of inspection will be conducted.

"To check whether the previous earthquake caused any structural jeopardize the safety and health of its users," Olimpo said.

General Trias, component city of Cavite, is home to the Gateway Business Park, and boasts of a steady increase in its registered commercial e s t a b l i s h m e n t s and infrastructure developments.

Although the city has no government jurisdiction over factories inside the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA), it will closely coordinate with PEZA's engineering department regarding the DILG directive. (PNA)


