Just months after the enactment of a law providing a P15,000monthly increase to Filipino war veterans, another round of increase is being proposed to be granted to them, their dependents included this time.

Sen. Bong Revilla has filed a bill seeking a P3,000 increase in the monthly pension of war veterans.

In filing Senate Bill No. 456, Revilla cited the State's policy in providing immediate and adequate

care, benefits and other forms of assistance to war veterans and veterans of military campaigns, their surviving spouses and orphans.

"This bill aims to further this policy by increasing the monthly pension due our war veterans by P3,000. This will be of great help to our veterans and their

dependents during these trying times where the cost of our basic necessities is at an all-time high," the senator said.
"More than the

monetary value of this proposed measure, we are showing our veterans that to this day, we have not forgotten their loyalty and bravery," Revilla added.

Under the measure,

the monthly pension shall be granted directly to the war veteran and in case of death, his pension shall be released in favor of his surviving spouse and in case of the latter's incapacity, to the oldest legitimate child of the war veteran.



Batangas, Rizal. Quezon to help them innovate and be at par with the competition in the global market. The director also disclosed during her welcome remarks that by the end of this year, 402 MSMEs under the **KMME** program are expected to graduate. RD Toledo likewise thanked DTI-Cavite Provincial Director Noly Guevara for hosting the first MME, as well as to the Go Negosyo Adviser for MSME Development Engr. Merly Cruz, for bringing MME in the region.

Meanwhile, USEC Cruz on the overview of the Money and Market Encounter and Innovative Approaches in Developing MSMEs, underscored the value of MME menteegraduates, plus its impact

on bridging the gap for inclusive growth as the program can link them different financial institutions and market opportunities.

During the money forum with Sumo Takoyaki Owner and Franchiser Bong Magpayo, mentees learned from a variety of micro finance loans that will increase their capital. Presenters who came from banks and MFIs including the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP), Small Business Corporation, Card SME Bank, Inter Asia Development Bank and Banko Mabuhay-Tanza laid their loan programs for the benefit of MSMEs. They also shared the importance simple financial of management, especially

when it comes to recordreminding keeping, business owners of the famous line, "Debit, Credit, Walang Kupit," for sustainability of the business.

Participants also took the opportunity from the money forum to solicit commitment of the financial institutions, asking banks to somehow prioritize MSMEs by not considering them as risks but instead, as partners for growth.

On the other hand, Market Forum proper moderated by the President of the Laguna Food Processors Association, Mr. Clarke Nebrao, also from Go Negosyo talked about penetrating the Brick and Mortar Platform. Operations managers of malls together with DTI-Rizal PD Mercedes Parreño discussed about trade fairs and bazaars where MSMEs can participate, saying that DTI is consistently looking for opportunities in linking with marketing

Among the issues raised in the market forum were cases of being taken advantage by trade fair organizers, terms of getting paid, tedious process of application and negotiation with merchandising the department of stores/ malls, repacking and the not-so-marketable showcase areas being MSME given for products. Due to these concerns, Mr. Nebrao and the participants all agreed for the conduct of a regional dialogue where leaders of various sectors

can sit down and wrap up agreement among market players and mall managers.

Aside from talks on the money and market side, digitalization also became a topic which was facilitated by Ms. Chie Malaki of Highly Succeed, a Philippinesbased IT servicing company that specializes on a wide range of webbased services. Resource speakers who from G-Cash, Shopee Philippines, Cashalo, Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship (PCE) and ROC.ph Digital Marketing Services all believed that in today's economic climate, one must not be afraid of digital transformation particularly in doing business.

The one-day activity

also had booth set ups and consultation, mentorship session to further discuss mentees' needs. Concluding the program was PD Tadiosa Iulieta of DTI-Quezon with her words of challenge and encouragement to MSMEs in the region to continue with their positive mindset. On behalf of the DTI family and all beneficiaries the **KMME** of program, she thanked Presidential Adviser for Entrepreneurship and Go Negosyo Founder Concepcion for Joey the nonstop assistance in strengthening MSMEs, as well as the Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship for extending help in achieving a smooth program flow. 






PGC's MEDICAL AND DENTAL MISSION, CULTIVATING STRONGER COMMUNITY

implementation of the measure will be included in the yearly appropriations of the Department of National Defense (DND).

"Our nation will forever be grateful for the sacrifices they have made for the Filipino people. This act institutionalizes the gratitude of a nation who will never forget those who came before them," said Revilla.

It was only on Dec. 20 last year that the law increasing the P5,000 monthly old-age pension of veterans of World War II, Korean War and the Vietnam War was increased to P20,000 following President Duterte's signing of RA 11164.

This law, however, covers only the eligible living senior veterans and their pensions are not transferable to any of their family members or dependents.###
