94% OF ECONOMY TO OPEN UNDER GCQ: DTI CHIEF

MANILA - About 94 percent of economic activities will open under a general community quarantine (GCQ), Trade Secretary Ramon Lopez said Thursday.

But Lopez said companies are still encouraged to implement work-from-home arrangements even when most of the economic activities will return under GCQ.

He said the remaining 6 percent of economic activities that are not

allowed to operate even in GCQ status are under Category 4.

"The criteria for this is (that) the risk in operating when it comes to transmission, is high," he said in a television interview.

He added it will be too risky for those under Category 4 to re-open their operation even under GCQ because these have mass gatherings while physical distancing is difficult to implement.

Establishments

under Category 4 include libraries, museums, art galleries, botanical and zoological gardens, water parks, beaches, resorts, travel agencies, tour operators, casinos and other gambling activities, massage parlors, sauna baths, facial and foot spa, and waxing salons, and other amusement and leisure places.

Since the start of the month, some parts of the country are already under GCQ while enhanced community quarantine

(ECQ) is extended until May 15 in Metro Manila, Central Luzon, Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, and Quezon), Pangasinan, Benguet, Iloilo, and Cebu.

The DTI and the Department of Labor and Employment issued minimum health protocols for businesses that will re-open under the GCQ.

Among these health standards that should be implemented in the



workplace include wearing face masks, observing physical distancing, regular disinfection process, constant checking of temperature, and submission of a

daily health symptoms questionnaire.

Companies should also test their employees who are sick or are suspected of having Covid-19. (PNA)

DOH establishes more COVID-19 isolation facilities in Cavite

The Department of Health (DOH)-CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) together with the local government units of Cavite have established isolation facilities in the province to be used as quarantine facilities for persons under investigation (PUI) and confirmed patients with mild symptoms of the COVID 19 virus.

"These isolation facilities were identified by the municipal and city government units of the province to be designated as quarantine facilities for COVID-19

patients. They were temporarily converted and designated for isolation and quarantine services," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

Among the designated community isolation units already accredited by DOH includes the Kawit ISO Facility and the Cavite City Quarantine Facility which both operated last April 29, 2020, the Noveleta MeDCare Center CoVID-19 Isolation Facility in Barangay San Jose 1 in Noveleta opened on April 30, 2020 and the Rosario

ISO Facility located in Poblacion, Rosario, Cavite which began operation on May 4, 2020.

"The regional office will ensure that patients accommodated in these facilities will be well-taken cared of until they are fully recovered and tested negative of the novel corona virus," he assured.

Community Isolation Units (CIUs) are DOH certified publicly or privately owned none hospital facilities set-up in coordination with or by the national government or local government (cont. P.2)

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite -- The provincial government thru the Provincial Tourism and Cultural Affairs (PTCAO) and tourism offices of several LGUs recently assisted Caviteño domestic tourists stranded in different cities and provinces in the country.

About 74 domestic tourists were flown in via domestic sweeper flights arranged by the Department of Tourism (DOT) in response to the authorization given by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on COVID-19.

They arrived at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) on May 1 & 2, 2020 and were transported to their respective hometowns using the Cavite Provincial Government shuttle bus and LGU service vehicles.

units (LGUs) to serve as quarantine facilities for probable and confirmed cases of COVID-19 based on DOH guidelines.

As of May 7, 2020, a total of 1,251 COVID-19 cases were reported in the region, with 156 patients recovered and 84 recorded deaths.

The province of Rizal has the highest number of COVID-19 with 394 followed by Laguna

with 360, Cavite with 288, Batangas - 109 and Quezon - 64.

There are currently 10,343 cases with 1,618 recovered and 685 deaths nationwide.

"Let us continue to be vigilant, stay safe, stay at home at always practice proper hygiene and make it a part of your daily routine," Janairo emphasized.

Gen. Juan Castañeda was one of the Leaders of the Revolution in Imus , Cavite. He was arrested and exiled to Spain and then to Fernando Po in Africa. He was repatriated during the early part of the American regime and was detained by the Americans. He was released upon the clamor of the people of Imus and was appointed as Capitan Municipal but he resigned after two months and joined the insurgents. He became sick and he was captured. He is now remembered as the former Worshipful Master of Pilar Lodge who raised Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo to the third degree of Freemasonry.

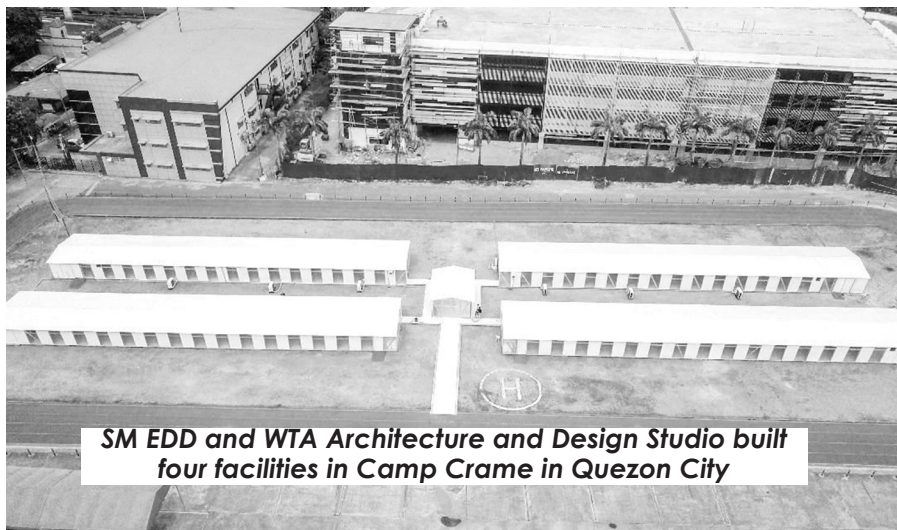

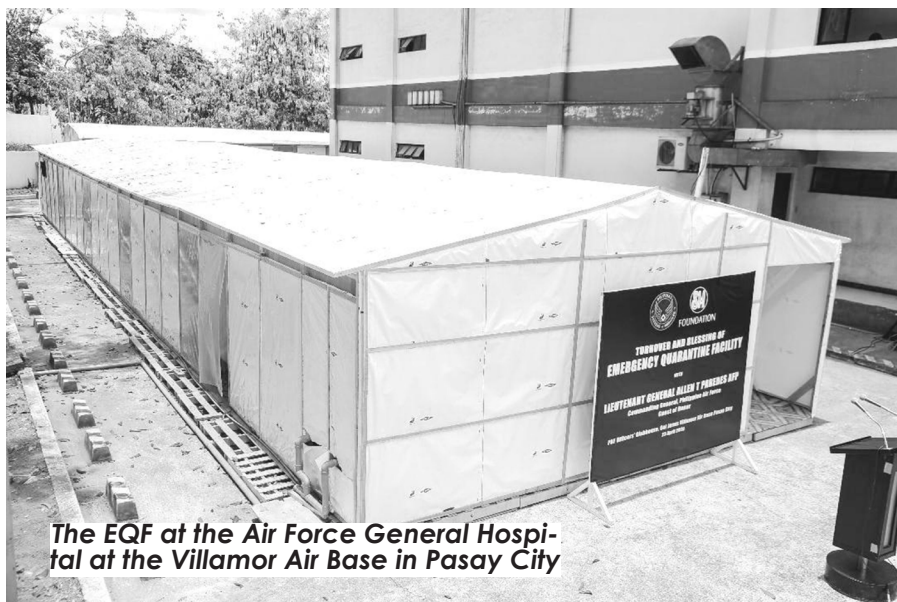
SM Builds Seven Emergency Quarantine Facilities in Metro Manila

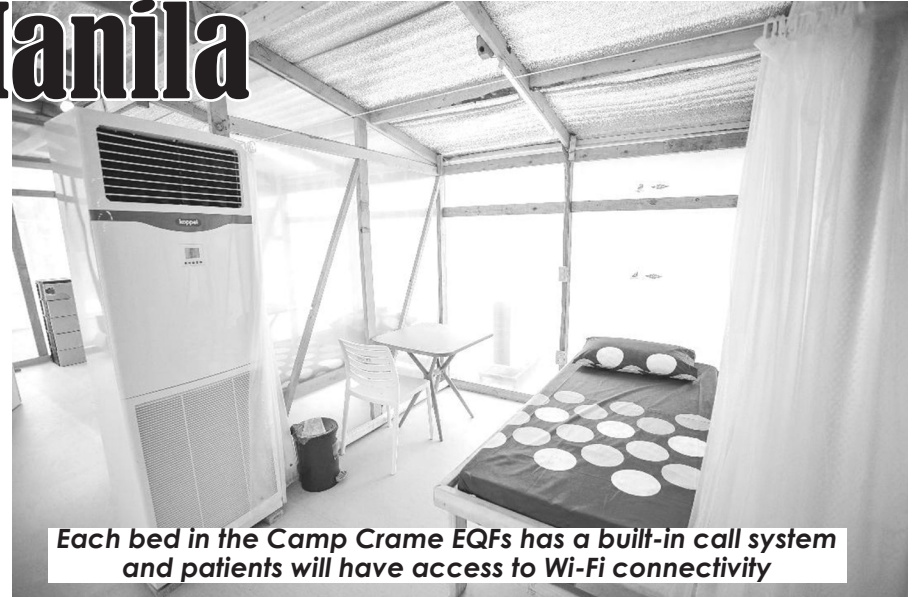
Built by the SM Engineering Design and Development (SM EDD)

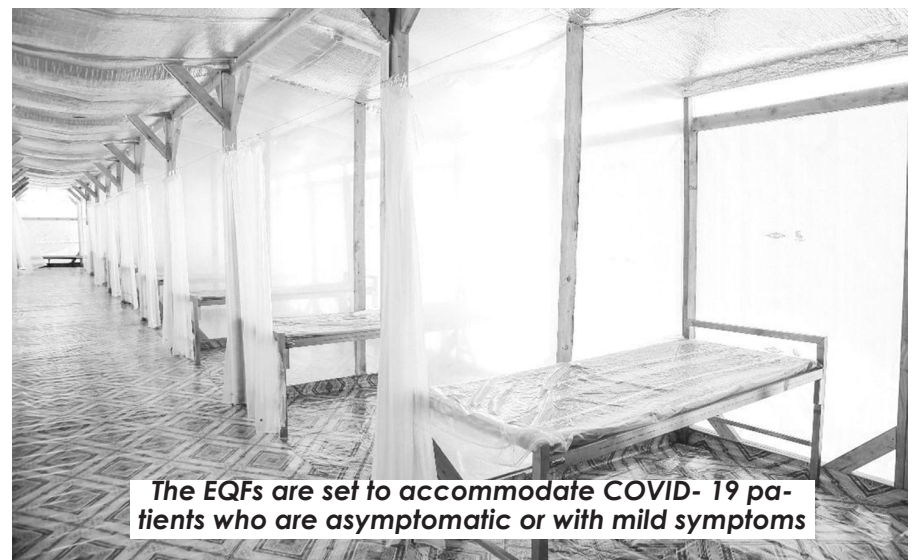
Completed within a span of six to ten days,

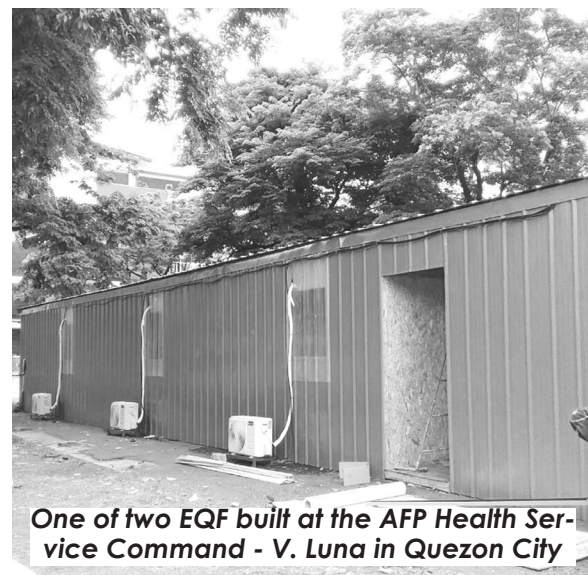
In the Camp Crame EQFs, each bed has a built-in call system and patients

Guidelines set for establishments to operate in Trece Martires

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite -- The local government here recently issued the guidelines for operations of business establishments within the city while under enhance community quarantine (ECQ).

To be operational, business establishments are required to secure a Special Permit to Operate (SPO) from the City Hall free of charge and observe certain requirements pursuant to the IATF Resolution No. 30, DTI Guidelines, DOLE Memorandum and other city

ordinance, resolution and executive orders.

Gyms and sports facilities; wellness & spa; entertainment like cinemas, theaters, carnivals, arenas, pubs and bars; convention centers, events places and other businesses where there are mass gatherings; computer shops, gambling and betting sites; resorts, hotels and apartelles and travel agencies and tourism related

businesses, and schools are not allowed to resume their operations.

However, restaurants and food chains will only accept delivery and take-out transactions.

Qualified businesses should be registered with the City Business and Licensing Office, must comply with DOLE Labor Advisory #09-2020 and only 50

percent of the regular workforce will be allowed to report for work.

Business establishments will only be operational upon the issuance of the SPO and must ensure that ECQ protocols will always be observed like mandatory wearing of face mask; observance of social distancing among employees and customers; provision of

alcohol (70% solution) at strategic locations within the store or workplace, and daily disinfection of all the equipment and the workplace.

Businesses will be open from Mondays-Saturdays but 'Cluster Schedule' of residents must strictly be monitored to prevent overcrowding to give way for physical distancing among customers.

The local government reiterated

that business establishments already operating prior to May 1-15, 2020 will remain operational and are not required to secure a SPO.

Meanwhile, local authorities and concerned government agencies warned that business owners caught operating without the necessary permit will be penalized and charged according to the law. (RF, PIA-Cavite, Mayor Gemma Lubigan fb)
