DTI PUSHES FOR URGENT PASSAGE OF STIMULUS PACKAGE VS. COVID-19

MANILA – The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) is seeking the urgent passage of the proposed Philippine Economic Stimulus Act of 2020 (PESA), which aims to provide immediate assistance to workers and businesses and help the economy recover from the impact of the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) pandemic.

“We affirm the need to help sustain the income of workers and businesses adversely impacted by the pandemic as we gradually reopen our economy,” Trade Secretary Ramon

Lopez said in a statement Monday.

Under the PESA bill, the government will earmark PHP1.3 trillion as a post-pandemic stimulus package, which includes a budget of PHP650 billion for an expanded infrastructure program on healthcare, education, and food security.

“By providing working capital assistance, technical and entrepreneurial education, and financial management, among others, we will be able to protect Filipinos by

ensuring businesses will continue operating post-lockdown and help turn the tide for businesses and workers affected by the health crisis,” Lopez said.

The proposed law will also allot PHP300 billion for the National Emergency and Investment Corp., which seeks to “minimize the damage” wrought by Covid-19 to the economy; PHP200 billion for wage subsidies and the grant of interest-free loans to assist micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), including businesses labeled “non-essential”

during the lockdown; as well as PHP128 billion for the Credit Mediation and Restructuring Guarantee Fund, an expanded loan program that will cover all “critically-impacted businesses” nationwide, among others.

The bill is aimed at restoring business confidence and operations, as well as preventing business closure prior to the imposition of the enhanced community quarantine (ECQ).

It has also been the subject of many consultations and hearings



under the Committees on Economic Affairs under Chairperson Sharon Garin and Trade and Industry under Chairman Wes Gatchalian, which consolidates the proposals of Albay 2nd District Rep.

Joey Salceda and Marikina Rep. Stella Luz Quimbo.

Lopez thanked the House of Representatives led by Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano and Majority Leader Martin Romualdez

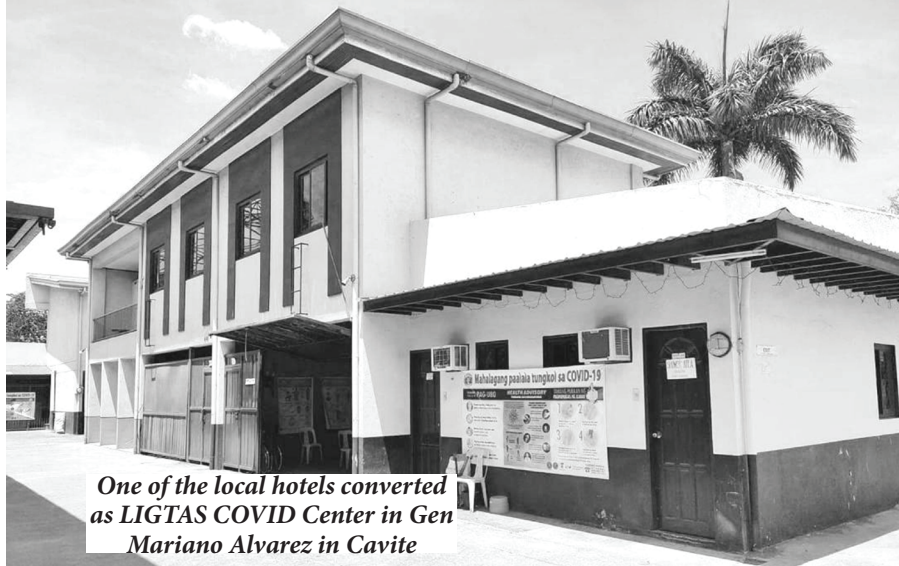

“Even with the lifting of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in most provinces of the region who are now under General Community Quarantine (GCQ), except for Laguna, these isolation facilities will continue to operate and accommodate individuals who will be identified as possible and confirmed COVID-19 with mild symptoms”, Regional

Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

“These centers will facilitate the treatment and care of COVID patients in the communities should a second wave of COVID-19 cases occur. It is best that the health system is ready and capable to handle such situation,” he emphasized.

LIGTAS COVID Centers are managed by a Local COVID-19 Task

Force (LCTF), Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT), a Sanitation Officer, and an assigned LIGTAS COVID manager.

The LGUs shall ensure that all health care workers and other frontline personnel exposed to the risk of infection are provided with proper and adequate personal protective equipment (PPE) according to

their roles and responsibilities.

According to Director Janairo, the regional office has already provided the necessary and essential personal protection equipment (PPEs) to various LGUs in the region.

For the province of Cavite, there are a total of 24 CIUs located in various cities and municipalities. Laguna province with 40 isolation facilities. Batangas province with 54 isolation facilities. Rizal province with 19 CIUs in operation. In Quezon, 117 LIGTAS COVID Centers were established.

As of May 17, 2020, there are a total of 1,399 COVID-19 cases were reported in the region, with 25 new cases, 266 patients have recovered and a total of 94 deaths.

There is now a grand total of 12,305 cases, with 2,561 patients recovered and 817 deaths recorded nationwide.

BACOR CITY, Cavite -- The transition of the province and most of the neighboring cities from ECQ to MECQ and GCQ lessened the restrictions allowing for more movement of the people with more business establishments already operational.

In the "New Normal" set-up, business operations should comply with the minimum public health standards to ensure the safety of every

one, thus contactless transaction is the newest service offered by the Metro Pacific Tollways South Management Corporation (MPT South).

The said service encourages the use of the Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) which allows for contactless passage through the toll plazas that can be availed in several convenient cashless transactions.

LGU Imus extends help to SAP beneficiaries not included in payout

Imus City, Cavite -- The local government here announced the granting of financial aid to qualified beneficiaries of the Social Amelioration Program (SAP) of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) but was not included in the payout distribution.

To address the problem, Mayor Maliksi established the Imus Grievance and Redress Committee Hotline number that focused on the complaints of the affected Imuseños with thousands of beneficiaries that turned out from this service.

Thus, the city government came up with their financial subsidy programs: the Imus Ex-

panded SAP amounting to Php6,500.00 cash aid to be given to eligible household qualified under the DSWD SAP national program but were not included in the payout, and the Lingap Imuseño Assistance program amounting to Php2,000.00 to be given to all eligible household that were not qualified under the programs of the DSWD like the SAP, 4Ps, Senior Citizen pension; Imus Extended SAP; DOLE TUPAD, CAMP and all other financial aid of any other agencies under the national government.

Mayor Maliksi was

grateful for the combined efforts of the employees of the City Social Welfare and Development Office, City Treasurer's Office, Liga ng mga Barangay, and other volunteer personnel from the different offices of the city government who tirelessly evaluated and processed the applications of said beneficiaries.

He proudly said, "Ulanin man ng batikos, buo ang loob ng bawat isa na manatili sa pagseserbisyo, umulan man o umaraw, umagahin man at dilimin, hindi alintana ang pagod at panganib sa kalusugan ng bawat isa

makapaglingkod lamang. Maraming salamat sa inyo."

HONTIVEROS: DEPORT AND BLACKLIST CHINESE NATIONALS INVOLVED IN 'UNDERGROUND' CLINICS

"Deport and blacklist these criminals. Hindi pwedeng ang higpit natin sa mga Pilipino pero maluwa tayo sa mga Chinese na sangkot sa krimen."

This was the remark of Senator Risa Hontiveros on Thursday as she called for the immediate deportation and blacklisting of Chinese nationals who were caught involved in unauthorized makeshift

medical facilities allegedly catering to Chinese patients suspected of infection with the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

"While we are working hard to protect our people from the virus, these criminals freely roam and pose danger to public health. This blatant disregard of our laws should merit immediate deportation and blacklisting," Hontiveros said in a statement. "Insulto ito sa ating mga batas, at insulto rin sa bawat Pilipinong sumusunod sa ating quarantine measures," she added.

The senator made her call after the raid of various establishments

in Parañaque, Pampanga, and Makati that were found to be illegally operating as hospitals and pharmacies primarily catering to employees of Philippine Offshore Gaming Operators (POGO) and Chinese nationals.

Chinese operators of said makeshift hospitals may face charges for the violation of the Food and Drug Administration Law, Medical Act of 1959 and the Hospital Licensure Act.

Hontiveros emphasized that underground and unlicensed medical facilities pose as a danger to public health. "They have zero regulation

Cavite prepares for post-COVID 'New Normal' world

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite-- Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla expressed his concerns on how classes could safely resume, how the province's economy could fully recover and how could the corona virus be eradicated and somehow bring normalcy to the province.

Two measures were seen as immediate solutions to the first two concerns: targeted testing, and investment in a post-Covid world.

The governor emphasized the importance of testing everyone but not possible thus, the provincial

government focused on targeted testing beginning with the frontliners who were tested this week.

As previously stated, succession for the targeted testing after the frontliners/healthworkers are the police personnel then followed by factory workers, some senior citizens, then public school teachers, and the students that should be tested before the school year starts on August 24, 2020.

Governor Jonvic reported the current testing capacity of the De La Salle Medical Health **(cont. P.5)**

for their strong support to revive the economy.

"Businesses have already lost a significant amount of income due to the challenges in logistics brought about by the ECQ," Lopez said.

He said more businesses will be able to operate as the country works towards the gradual lifting of the quarantine, but at lower capacities due to limited capital resources that dwindled during the quarantine

period.

"There are also strict health measures that are being imposed and the firms would need working capital loans," he added. "At a very critical time such as this, we must not only ensure a safe working environment for our citizens, but also continue to find means to support, and more importantly save the jobs of those adversely affected to facilitate faster economic recovery." **(PNA)**

**CALABARZON HOSPITALS RECEIVES
AMBULANCES FROM DOH**

On May 22, 2020, the Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) distributed the first batch of land ambulances to 9 various hospitals in the region to augment the much-needed COVID-19 response and other emergency situations.

"These emergency vehicles will be used in responding to the present pandemic, in preparation of a surge or second wave of the virus, preparing for the new normal, preparing for the Balik-Probinsya program and preparing for the next epidemic/pandemic", Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

A total of 98 ambulances were procured by the regional office under the Health Facility Enhancement Program (HFEP) which aims for the improvement

of health facilities and special service delivery units in the rural areas.

Among the recipients of the first tranche of brand new ambulances are Imus District Hospital in Cavite; San Pedro District Hospital and Sta. Rosa Community Hospital in Laguna; Don

Manuel Lopez Memorial District Hospital and Malainin Barangay Health Station in Batangas; Antipolo Hospital System IV (Mambugan) and Rodriguez Rural Health Unit 2 in Rizal; and Bondoc Peninsula District Hospital and San Narciso Municipal Hospital in

Quezon.

"These will be distributed to priority areas in need of emergency vehicles. Kasama na dito ang pagbibigay ng training sa mga personnel na mag-operate at maghahandle sa mga ambulansya".

"Importante na mayroong silang proper knowledge sa essential life support, gaya ng cardiopulmonary resuscitation o CPR".

"An ambulance driver must be able to travel in any given traffic situations with caution and readiness and without risking the safety of the public or the patient. They should also ensure that the vehicle is sufficiently fueled and complete with the necessary medical supplies" he emphasized.

Janairo also reminded hospital officials to use the ambulances as it is intended - to transport sick or injured patients requiring immediate medical treatment. "Huwag natin itong

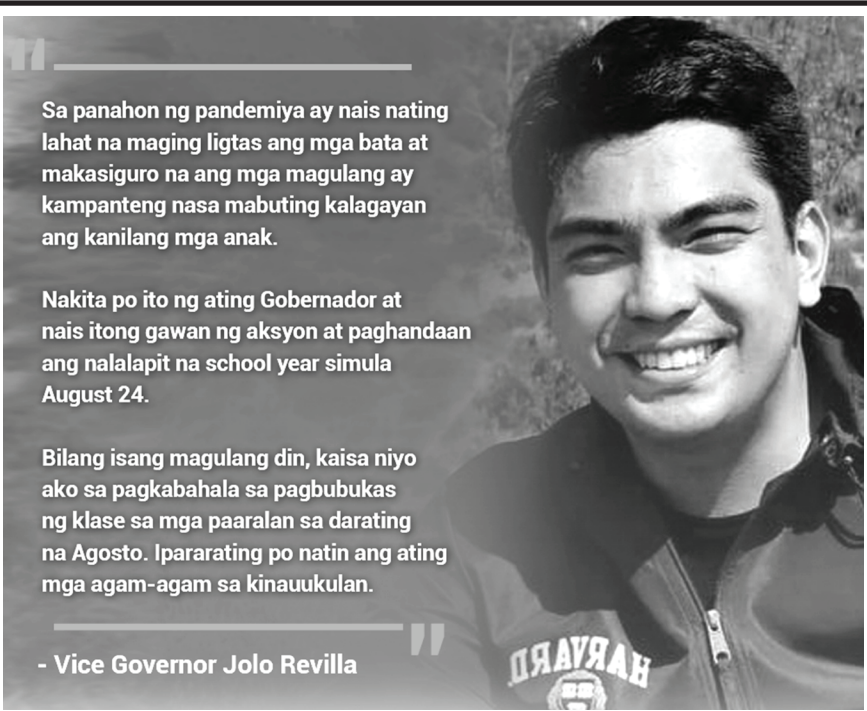

Sciences Institute (DLSM-HSI) laboratory is about 300 tests a day but with the new laboratory, about 8,000 tests could be accommodated daily by next week.

"This will somehow speed up the completion of the targeted testing in the province, but then again the mass testing is not feasible," the Gov. said.

Delving on the issue on securing the confidence of the parents for the safety of their children during the resumption of classes, the governor thought of investments to be made to ensure the children's safety and the continuation of their education.

He saw the need to set up hand washing facilities in every school. The barangay basketball covered courts will be used as alternative remote learning centers due to imminent shortage of classrooms to allow social distancing in school, and investment for free WIFI with estimated cost of Php1B with about 15,000 computers to be installed in the province.

Also, targeted testing for the teachers and students will not be a onetime activity but should be year round to ensure their continued health and safety and control the possible infection in the school premises.

Likewise, part of the safety protocols would be the provision of mass transportation for the students to minimize the risk of exposure to the corona virus and to any other accidents.

Governor Remulla said, "We will continue to talk to the mayors and congressmen about these concerns. Rest assured, we will continue to look for solutions to these problems." (PIA)

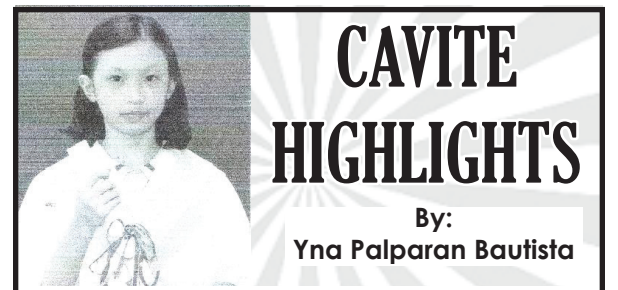

Pantaleon was one of the Five Brigade Commanders to assault Manila in the beginning of the Philippine- American War. He was the Commanding General of the Filipino Forces in Central Luzon while Gen. Aguinaldo shifted to guerilla warfare and went to Palanan. Garcia was captured in Jaen, Nueva Ecija in May 1900 and he swore allegiance to America.

FIRST COVID ISOLATION FACILITY FOR PDLs OPENS IN BATANGAS

The Batangas Provincial Government yesterday officially turned over the Batangas Isolation Facility for Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) to the Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) located in Barangay Malainin at the town of Ibaan, Batangas.

“Batangas is the first province to initiate and organize a structure that will accommodate PDLs (Persons Deprived of Liberty) who will be positive with the COVID-19 virus. Una ang Batangas na gumawa ng paraan para maasikaso ang ating mga PDL na nagpositibo sa virus, alisin sila sa kampo o sa prison at ilagay sa isang facility na magkakaroon sila ng mas magandang kalagayan, mas mabibigyan ng karampatang lunas at importante hindi sila magkakahawaan,” Regional Director Janairo stated during the ceremony was attended by officials of the DOH regional office and Batangas provincial government and PNP.

“Dito rin ilalagay ang ibang mga residente na magpopositibo sa virus at sila

ay ilalagay sa ibang building na hiwalay sa ating mga PDLs. There will be 20 rooms for male and another 20 for female PDLs at makakasama natin sa pagma-manage dito ang provincial Philippine National Police (PNP). This will be a secure facility for both local residents and PDLs who will undergo treatment and quarantine procedures,” he added.

There are at least 15 PNP health personnel from the provincial who will be working closely with DOH in the management of inmates who will be detained in the facility

The Batangas Isolation Facility for PDLs has a 100-bed capacity. The facility was built and designed as a drug rehabilitation facility and was known as the Malainin Rehabilitation Center and was used as a temporary shelter for evacuees during the Taal eruption last January and now converted as the first an isolation facility in the country for PDLs.

According to Janairo, the regional office will provide the necessary funding and logistics to upgrade the facility to 300-beds. “Kailangang magkaroon ito

ng sariling hospital facility na mangelalaga sa mga pasyente upang hindi na pumunta pa ng Batangas Medical Center.”

Under a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Batangas Provincial government and DOH-CALABARZON, the latter will handle the operation and management of the facility, provide the staff, working capital and provision of the necessary facilities to address the COVID pandemic.

The provincial government has spent 50 million pesos for the conversion of the rehab

facility.

As of May 21, 2020,

PhilHealth's Interim Reimbursement Mechanism (IRM)

The **Interim Reimbursement Mechanism** or **IRM** is an emergency cash advance measure applied by PhilHealth to provide hospitals with an emergency fund to respond to unanticipated events like natural disaster and calamities.

When the Covid-19 global pandemic was declared in February 2020, and drawing from the modeling forecast available at the time, PhilHealth prepared an IRM response equivalent to 90 days of annual historical benefit claims to be made available to all health care institutions nationwide including dialysis centers and lying in clinics. This requirement was estimated to be P30 Billion.

Since the emergence of the first locally transmitted Covid-19 cases in February, the following pattern has emerged that will require PhilHealth to recalibrate its IRM response:

- **The disease is concentrated only in high population density** areas like the NCR and Regions 3, 4, 7 and 11. Many areas exhibit low or Covid-19-free incidence. PhilHealth's strategy is to provide IRM to all referral hospitals and laboratories in all provinces. This has already been achieved.

- Government's anti-Covid 19 strategy will entail **expanded targeted testing** and subsequent **quarantine** of confirmed individuals. This will require funding which will fall on PhilHealth.

- **Financial sustainability** of the anti-Covid-19 response. With still no vaccine in sight PhilHealth will take the prudent path to ensure that sufficient funds continue to be available to protect all citizens from the severe impact of the pandemic.

To date PhilHealth has released a total of P13.8 Billion to 599 health care institutions nationwide, P7.3 Billion or 53% of which was released to private institutions. Of this, almost P4 Billion or 29.7% was released to NCR, the ground zero of Covid-19.

PhilHealth will now scale down its IRM release and preserve its funds for the anticipated expanded targeted testing required by the national anti-Covid 19 strategy. Further releases will be selective and following above mentioned considerations.

DTI 4-A's SSF-assisted coop runs 1st eco-friendly PUVs in Cavite



In line with the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) of the Department of Transportation to make the country's public transportation system efficient and environment-friendly by 2020, a beneficiary of the Department of Trade and

Industry Region 4-A's Shared Service Facilities Program—the Silang Transport Service and Development Cooperative (STSDC)—introduced their 23 new and modernized units of PUV to provide service in Imus City and Silang, Cavite last May 21, 2020.

Through the financial assistance of the Department of Budget and Management and the effort of STSDC's Manager, Mr. Sulpicio Arellano, the Cooperative has successfully paved the way to offer and run the first eco-friendly and conducive PUV in the province.

They demonstrated their readiness to serve the public by observing social distancing and other health protocols with their passengers.

According to STSDC, this is their answer to the government's call for an eco-friendly transportation system

and the LGUs' call to service commuters plying from Silang to Imus and Silang to Tagaytay and vice-versa. Routes will be stretched once the new normal is in place in the province.

Established in 1991, fifteen individuals from different transport associations in Silang joined and worked for the registration of the STSDC. They started their business and services to members by applying passenger utilities jeepney franchise from the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board.

In 2013, the DTI 4-A through its SSF program awarded the STSDC with equipment such as a hydraulic pipe bender, universal sheet bender, sheet metal cutter, acetylene torch, and welding machine for body fabrication and repair. Thus, Cooperative was able to increase its services to the members on repairs up to 15%, assemble

additional cooperative owned unit, and increase motor shop income to 10%, greatly improving their production and capacity to address the needs of its members. Through the SSF, members and member-drivers will continue to use the equipment to their modernized PUVs in terms of maintenance and repair.

Presently, the Cooperative has 174 member operators.

"We would like to congratulate the STSDC for this achievement! You have proven that there are, indeed, many ways to thrive amidst this pandemic through a sheer amount of perseverance, optimism, and determination. We really believe that through the relentless effort and convergence of the government and the private sector, we will be able to survive in this crisis," said DTI CALABARZON Director Marilou Q. Toledo.
