# PRES. DUTERTE RE-EXTENDS GCQ IN METRO MANILA UNTIL JULY 31

MANILA - According to Roque, the National Capital Region (NCR) or Metro Manila will remain under general community quarantine (GCQ).

He said the President initially agreed with the recommendation of the University of the Philippines (UP) to revert NCR to modified ECQ but changed his mind after Metro Manila mayors vowed to implement more

proactive restrictions under GCQ.

“There was a recommendation from UP to revert Metro Manila to MECQ to slow down the spread of the disease. At first, the President agreed but our chief implementer (Carlito Galvez Jr.) and our Secretary of Interior (Eduardo Año) appealed to reconsider because our Metro Manila mayors vowed to strictly enforce

localized lockdowns, enhance testing, tracing, and treatment, and implement expanded restrictions under GCQ. So the President agreed not to revert Metro Manila to MECQ for the next two weeks,” Roque said in Filipino.

He warned that there is still a possibility that Metro Manila could revert to MECQ if the situation worsens.

He also urged the public to help the government prove that Covid-19 cases in the country would not swell to 80,000 by July

# LGU Bacoor amends EO 24 for expansion of Zapote 1-P Critical Zone

Bacoor City, Cavite -- The local government here led by Mayor Lani Revilla ordered the amendment and expansion of the localized lockdown of Barangay Zapote 1-Proper Critical Zone and containment of the households of COVID-19 positive patients effective 12 noon of July 11, 2020 up to 5am of July 24, 2020.

This developed after the RT-PCR (Real Time-Polymerase Chain Reaction) testing in said area resulted to a clustering of a total of 19 confirmed cases by July 9, 2020, out of which 3 had died, and 16 are active cases plus several symptomatic suspects and probable cases who were

reactive in their rapid anti-body tests.

With the said order, the total of the Zapote 1-P CrZ now consists of more than 1,500 households with boudaries moved to Rosal St., on the northwest (NW), Aster Extension on the northeast (NE), Campuput St., on the southwest (SW), and Camia St. on the southeast (SE) including the old Zapote market area and the Sampalukan area which consists of 400 families.

The order also states that the Zapote 1 Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT), in coordination with the City Health Office (CHO) and the City

Contact Tracing Team (CTT) shall continue to carry out inventory and surveillance of the concerned households in this critical zone, conduct case finding and investigation in search of more household members

# DTI releases 1st batch of loan to small firms under CARES program

MANILA – The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) released Friday the first batch of loans under the Covid-19 Assistance to Restart Enterprises (CARES) program to micro and small enterprises.

Fifteen borrowers from the National Capital Region and 26 borrowers from the Cordillera Administrative Region received the first batch of CARES program loans.

DTI Secretary Ramon Lopez said a total of PHP100 million loans were approved by the Small Business (SB) Corp. for 1,175 applicants.

He said 1,153 applications with aggregate loans amounting to PHP97.9 million are pending approval.

Earlier, Lopez said SB Corp., the financing arm of DTI that leads the CARES program,

targets to complete the disbursement of the PHP1-billion fund earmarked for this program by the end of this month.

SB Corp. received a total of 22,932 applications for the CARES program loan that amounted to over PHP2 billion worth of borrowings, he said.

“For extra funds needed, we will use our other P3 (Pondo sa Pagbabago at Pag-Asenso) portfolio fund which is about PHP3.5 billion,” he added.

Lopez said that with the arrangement with the Department of Finance, SB Corp. may also access from the Land Bank

of the Philippines and Development Bank of the Philippines to augment the needed fund.

The CARES program provides interest-free loans to micro-businesses with assets not exceeding PHP3 million, and small businesses with assets not exceeding PHP15 million.

The SB Corp. can lend from PHP10,000 to PHP200,000 for micro-enterprises, and up to PHP500,000 for small enterprises payable for 18 to 30 months.

This is DTI’s response to help small-scale businesses survive amid the Covid-19 pandemic as well as to save jobs. (PNA)

# Amadeo town gives cash incentive to namesake residents as part of founding anniversary celebration

AMADEO, Cavite – Residents with the same name as the Coffee Capital of the Philippines got a special treat ahead of the municipality’s 148th founding anniversary.

On Monday (July 13), Mayor Redel Dionisio awarded four persons with P1,000 cash each

simply for being named “Amadeo.” The local government unit located the awardees by going through the records of their Local Civil Registrar.

It has been the municipal government’s practice to give cash incentives to centenarians during the annual Amadeo

Day celebration. This year, however, no one qualified for the incentive, so they came up with another prize to brighten up the festivities.

Amadeo Day is celebrated every July 15, but with general community quarantine (GCQ) measures making

it impossible to hold mass gatherings amid the threat of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the local tourism office is taking its activities online.

This year’s celebration is a tribute to frontliners and features an essay writing contest and a dance tribute video competition, entries for which were uploaded online.

They also held a poster making contest, and since the participants are minors, local tourism officers had to pick up the entries from their homes.

The competitions will be judged tomorrow and the announcement of winners will be made via Facebook.(PIA)

mote local artistry, Harl's produces crafts valuable to the community, coinciding with its social responsibility to provide employment to people with disability and underprivileged craftsmen. They train aspiring artisans to produce products that would qualify in the international market.

While some companies use machines in certain phases of the manufacturing process, Harl's takes pride with their products that are purely and skillfully handmade. What sets them apart from other leather brands is how they use waste materials and genuine leather to create upcycled products. Their products have visible natural leather markings on them such as a few scratches, discoloration, or burn marks to more character and uniqueness to the products. They do not use linings and make only one

of each product, especially with their bags. Every batch produced has different sets of leather choices and will not be produced again. These are all crafted proudly and dexterously by differently-abled workers who are either mute, deaf, or cripple.

For the past years, Harl's handcrafted items are a staple at the regional and national trade fairs and bazaars of the Department of Trade and Industry. In 2018 at the DTI's SikatPinoy National Trade Fair and National Arts and Crafts Fair, differently-abled workers from Harl's conducted a leathercrafts workshop where guests can create their own wallet, coin purse, and other leather goods.

But like any other businesses, Harl's was

caught off guard when the pandemic happened.

"I had to unload the ship for it to sail further. To put it simply, I needed to let go one of my stores. I needed to prioritize what's best for the company and for my employees," said Harley.

"We were not prepared for the pandemic, but what can we do about it? Instead of constantly thinking of problems and feeling dejected, I use my time during this quarantine period to become more productive by thinking of new ways for my business to survive and to sustain the needs of my employees," added Harley.

With these in mind, Harl's started crafting face masks made from leather and ticogmat, and they call it maska. Ticogis harvested by an Abre Linea

weaving community in San Miguel, Leyte.

According to Harley, maska doesn't just provide safety but also comfort and durability because of the materials used. One purchase of maska will not only feed one PWD family but will also support San Miguel's weaving community.

Moreover, through the donations of customers and friends, Harley conducted the "Harl's COVID-19 Response" by distributing relief packages to several underprivileged and PWD families in their area.

"Harl's bounce back story is very remarkable. We hope that his experience will help our MSMEs to be inspired to move forward and start the process of putting their businesses back on track. We, in the

DTI, and with our programs and activities for our MSMEs want them to be ready to embrace the new normal," said DTI CALABARZON Director Marilou Q. Toledo.

"Harl's is here not to have business; we're here to inspire and survive. We continue to serve our purpose by helping others," said Harley.

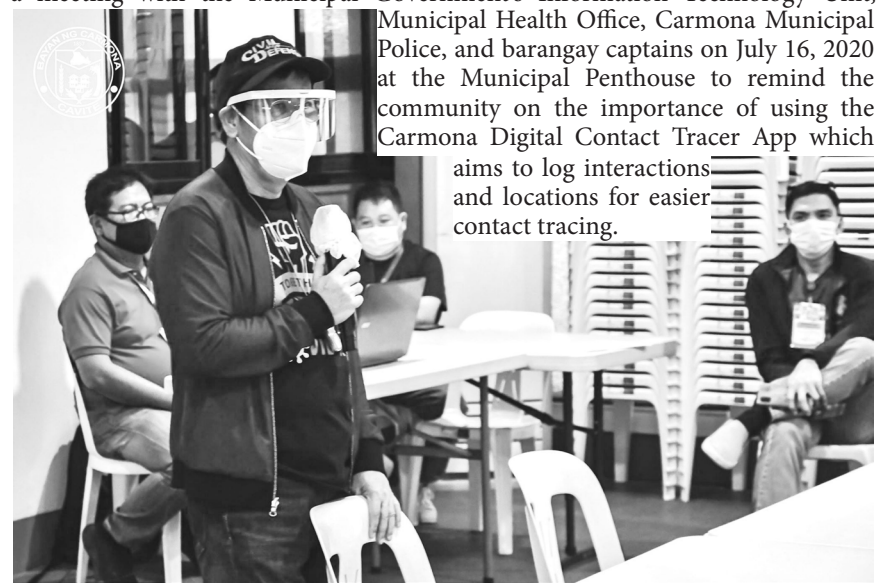

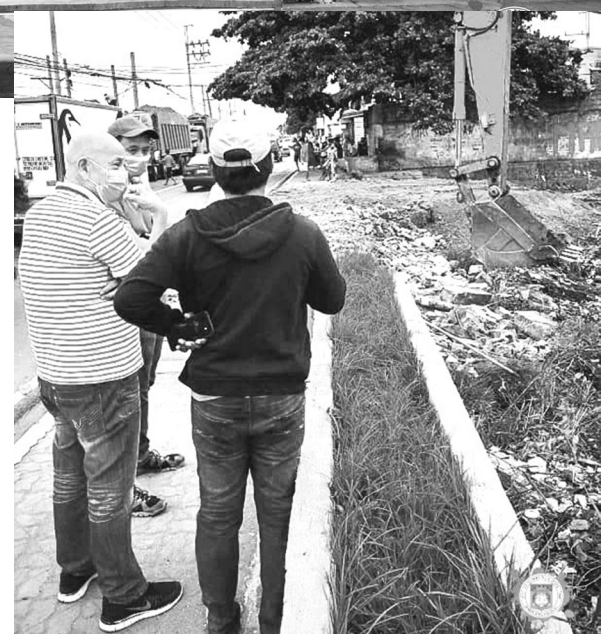

having symptoms.

A Strict Stay at Home Order for all residents which means that no one, not even Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR) will not be allowed to leave their homes with all Quarantine ID Passes of households within the containment area are suspended.

The local government will provide food packs that will be distributed and rationed for all houses within the containment zone within the lockdown period including maintenance medicines

that will be bought for and/or delivered by Barangay Health Workers who shall give out a contact number for the said purpose. Other essential supplies may be arranged for delivery.

Meanwhile, transportation vehicles shall not be allowed within the lockdown area even when used for personal purposes but vehicles of the Barangay can be used by designated persons who shall go to the market or stores to buy food and other essentials for and in behalf of the contained residents.

Disinfection of all areas visited by the confirmed cases shall be conducted within 24 - 48 hours by the City-ENRO.

Likewise, home quarantining/home isolation of all suspected, probable and confirmed cases are strictly not allowed and will be admitted to the Community Isolation Unit (CIU) or hospital depending on the physical assessment of the City Health Officer, based on DOH protocols.

The City Social Welfare and Development Officers (CSWDO), and the Emergency Operations Center are directed to implement programs and inventory logistics for the provision of assistance to the Barangay LGU and to the residents of the Zapote 1-P CrZ who are most affected by the lockdown and confinement of the barangay.

The enforcement of this order will be carried out by all the Barangay Officials, the Bacoor PNP and other duly delegated local enforcers to ensure that compliance of all confinement regulations by the residents are done. (PIA)

31 as indicated by UP researchers.

"It's correct to encourage each other to take all steps to make sure the 80,000 Covid-19 cases projection doesn't come true by July 31," he said.

Duterte also placed the following areas under GCQ: Laguna, Cavite, and Rizal for Region 4-A (Calabarzon); Lapu Lapu City, Mandaue City for Region 7 (Central Visayas), Ormoc City, Southern Leyte, Zamboanga City, Butuan City, Agusan del Norte and Basilan.

The cities of Talisay, Minglanilla, and Consolacion in Cebu province will also under be under GCQ.

Areas under "medium-risk" modified general community quarantine (MGCQ) are: Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) - Benguet, Baguio City; Region 1 (Ilocos region) - Ilocos Sur, Pangasinan, Ilocos Norte, La Union, Dagupan City; Region 2 (Cagayan Valley) - Cagayan, Isabela, Nueva Vizcaya; Region 3 (Central Luzon) - Bataan, Nueva Ecija, Pampanga, Bulacan, Tarlac, Zambales, Angeles City; Region 4-A (Calabarzon) - Batangas, Quezon, Lucena City; Region 4-B (Mimaropa) - Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro, and Puerto Princesa City.

Also under medium-risk MGCQ are: Albay, Masbate, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Sorsogon, Naga City for Region 5 (Bicol); Iloilo, Negros Occidental, Capiz, Antique, Aklan, Guimaras, Iloilo City, Bacolod City for Region

6 (Western Visayas); Negros Oriental, Bohol, Cebu Province for Region 7 (Central Visayas); Western Samar, Leyte, Biliran, Tacloban City for Region 8 (Eastern Visayas); Zamboanga del Sur, Zamboanga Sibugay, Zamboanga del Norte for Region 9 (Zamboanga); Misamis Occidental, Bukidnon, Lanao del Norte, Cagayan de Oro City, Iligan City for Region 10 (Northern Mindanao); Davao Oriental, Davao del Norte, Davao del Sur, Davao de Oro, Davao City for Region 11 (Davao region); Sultan Kudarat, Cotabato, South Cotabato, General Santos City for Region 12 (Soccsksargen); Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao for BARM; and Agusan del Sur, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, and Surigao del Sur Region 13.

The rest of the country will remain under "low-risk" MGCQ until July 31.

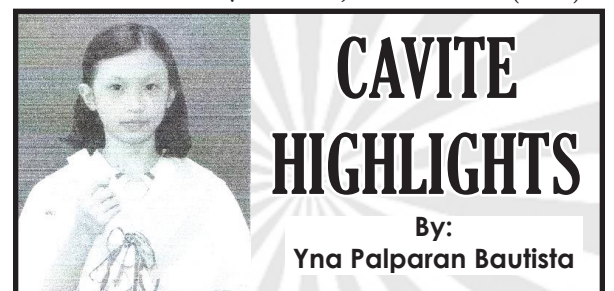
Earlier, Roque said present data shows that Metro Manila may not

downgrade to the MGCQ as case doubling rate and critical care capacity of the region do not suggest an easing of quarantine protocols.

Metro Manila mayors have recommended that NCR be placed under "hybrid" GCQ amid the rising number of Covid-19 cases in the past weeks.

In a hybrid GCQ, movement of people will be restricted but economic activity will continue, provided that the private sector will take "equal responsibility" for containing the spread of the virus.

The public is still encouraged to strictly observe minimum health and safety standards such as physical distancing, wearing of face masks, and frequent handwashing to minimize the risk of catching or spreading the disease. As of July 14, there are a total of 58,850 confirmed Covid-19 cases in the country, of which 20,976 are recoveries and 1,614 are deaths. (PNA)

of the resolution passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod as requested by Mayor Barzaga to help the families left homeless and suffered because of the fire.

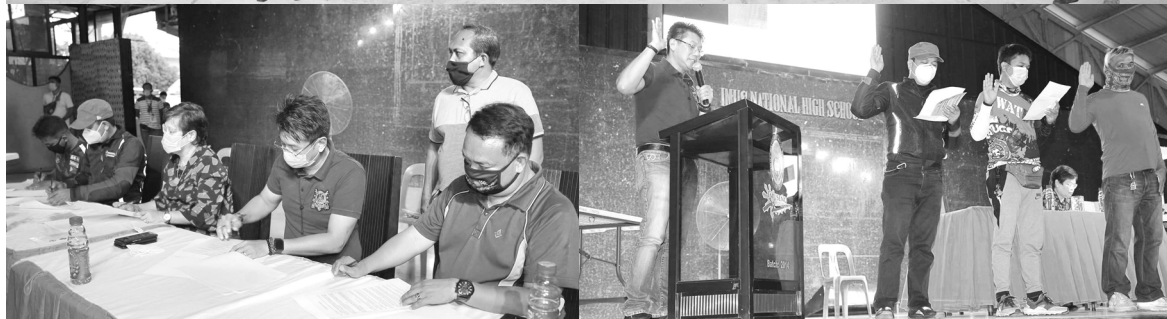
The amount granted for the households affected depends on the degree of damage sustained. A total of P3.75M were distributed to the households broken down as follows: P1,880,000 for the 44 households in Block 44 that were totally damaged; P1,845,000 to 44 households that were totally damaged



on Block 43; P25,000 to 5 households that were partially damaged; and P210,000 for the 21 households renting. The families also received assistance from the office of the

The Bautista fire victims are still sheltered in the five barangay covered courts in the city where they were immediately evacuated and given collapsible tents to allow social distancing.

Mayor Barzaga assured the local government will continue to help especially in the processing of documents they lost during the fire. (PIA)
