### Testing Czar visits Bacoor City.

Secretary Vince Dizon visited the city yesterday to hold a dialogue with the members of the Bacoor City Task Force COVID-19 led by City Mayor Lani Revilla.

consultation between the City Task Force and the party of Sec. Vince Dizon discussed the current status of the testing and isolation facilities of the city.

Revilla Mayor presented the COVID-19 Update in the city that showed an upsurge in the number of positive cases of the coronavirus since the beginning of the month of July. Based on the latest data, almost 60% of the new cases are employees working in

The upscale trend highlighted the need for a massive and aggressive PCR testing that would result to the shortage of isolation and quarantine facilities.

Testing Czar The committed to immediately act on the issues brought up in the dialogue with provision of additional swab teams from the NTF for the massive testing, and offered to add more isolation and quarantine facilities in the city because of an expected increase in the number of cases after conducting testing of all suspect cases in the city.

Dizon said, Sec. "The city of Bacoor is no different in the situation and needs of those in the NCR because of its location.'

Aside from the Sec. Dizon dialogue, with officers together of the Department of Health IV-A turned-over 5,000 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) sets comprised of body suits, face masks and gloves and about 2,000 pieces of PCR test kits for the 1st batch of donations to the city government.

Mayor Lani was thankful for these interventions by the NTF and also called for the help and cooperation of the companies and employers of Bacooreño workers in NCR to help with the provision of isolation facilities so as not to require the patients to return home to prevent the spread of infection to their immediate family and to the community as

Hontiveros and Bayan Rep. Muna Carlos Isagani Zarate lamented that Duterte used his penultimate SONA to lambast his critics, such as Senate Minority Leader Franklin Drilon and the Lopezes.

Francis Senator Pangilinan, on the other hand, was dismayed that Duterte did not mention the government's "miss targets" in mass testing, contact tracing, and the disbursement of cash assistance to poor families affected by the pandemic.

Some senators also claimed Duterte was not able to give a "clear"

Covid-19 recovery roadmap.

Roque said the lawmakers' reactions no longer surprised the Palace.

"Kaniya-kaniyang pananaw po iyan. At siyempre galing sa oposisyon, wala naman silang mabuting makikita sinabi ni doon sa Presidente (We all have different views. And of course, the reactions came from the opposition who do not see anything good in what the President has said)," he said.

Roque maintained that the government's policy is to further boost the country's capacity to test, isolate, trace, and treat Covid-19 patients.

He added that the government would use available funds to reboot the economy, which has suffered a recession because of the pandemic.

He also noted that Duterte has pushed for priority legislative measures that would help restart economic activities

proposed Bayanihan to Recover as One (Bayanihan 2) Act, which contains a stimulus package that would revive the country's economy in the aftermath

of the Covid-19 crisis, was among the legislative priorities outlined by Duterte in his 5th SONA, Roque said.

"At kahapon naman po, nangako 'yung liderato ng Kongreso na within the month 'no, or siguro itong darating na month ng Agosto, maisasabatas o maia-approve nila in third and final reading (Yesterday, Congress leaders promised that they would approve the [priority measures] on third and final reading within the month or this coming August)," he said.



## Imus CASO launches Project Punla, LGU initiative for food sufficiency



IMUS CITY, Cavite -- The local government thru the City Agriculture Services Office (CASO) launched recently the Project Punla, the city government's main response in ensuring food sufficiency and adequacy level during emergency situation.

According to the Imus Public Information Office (PIO), the project has a Plant, Plant, Plant Program concept which aims to increase the city's agricultural production particularly rice and vegetables, through intensified use of quality seeds, appropriate inputs, and modern technologies to increase and ensure level of productivity, availability, accessibility and affordability.

For its immediate program, it will focus on the farmers who are engaged in rice and vegetable production that can immediately respond to the food supply needs of the city.

Meanwhile, for the backyard gardening or small-scale farming such as container and vertical-gardening are the focus for the medium term program.

The long-term program will focus on the conversion and development of idle lands, and vacant lots into organic vegetable farms to ensure sustainable food production at a high sufficient level thru Gulayan sa Paaralan Program mushroom production, and the establishment of Gulayan sa Barangay (Communal Gardening).

The City Government of Imus spearheads the implementation of Project Punla with the full support of the City Mayor's Office, City Agricultural Services Office, City Information Office, City Tourism and Development Office, Farmers/ Land Owners, Homeowners' Association, Department of Education, and the Senior Citizens.

## Distribution of Financial and Burial Assistance

Amidst the Covid 19 pandemic, provincial the government led by Governor Jonvic Remulla never cease find ways to to deliver its services the people of Cavite, particularly the distribution of financial assistance which was temporarily suspended due to the outbreak. Prioritizing the safety of its constituents, mass distribution which will gather a huge crowd was disallowed prompting the Office of the Governor to spearhead the houseto-house distribution

of aid to beneficiaries.

Aside from the Botika on wheels caters which the medical needs of the locals, the team from the Office Governor of the and the Provincial Social Welfare Development Office went down barangays to dispense financial and burial assistance which were already processed in the previous months and awaiting release.

On July 21-23, a total of 116 beneficiaries were given assistance including those from the municipality of Mendez with 33 recipients, 40 from Tagaytay City and 43 citizens from General Emilio Aguinaldo.

batch Another of composed 408 recipients were granted assistance on July 28-31 with 114 beneficiaries from Ternate, 53 fromresidents Alfonso, 104 from Magallanes and 137 frombeneficiaries Amadeo.

Owing to the huge impact of the pandemic to the health and livelihood of Caviteños, the provincial government's response actions

focus not only in stopping the further spread of the virus through policies and guidelines, education and information, treatment, testing ang contact tracing but also in providing the needed assistance like financial aids, food and nonfood commodities, and ways to

## **Noveleta with lowest COVID-19 cases in t**

NOVELETA, Cavite -- The local government reported that among the municipalities in the 1st District of the province, it has the lowest COVID-19 confirmed cases recorded with 23 as of July 20, 2020.

On the other hand, neighboring towns of Kawit has 31 cases, Rosario with 32, and Cavite City with 34 cases.

Town Mayor Dino Chua attributed this to the vigorous campaign of each barangay that was fully supported by the local government resulting to majority of the barangays (10 out of 16 barangays) remaining COVID free.

Since the outbreak hit Barangay San Rafael June 24, 2020 with 11 cases recorded, disease had spread to neighboring barangays of San Juan 1 and San Antonio 1 with 4 cases each, San

Juan 2 with 2 cases. and Barangays Salcedo and San Rafael with 1 case each.

Mayor Chua said, "The LGU is determined that they can pass this pandemic with the help of every single citizen of Noveleta."

Out of the 23 COVID patients, six were treated at the Noveleta MedCare Center, the designated COVID-19 center in the town under Municipal Health Officer Dr. Hilda Bucu.

The quarantine center was commended for its clealiness and comfortable facilities including the good medical care and attention provided by the nursing staff.

Meanwhile, since the start of the community quarantine the LGU continuously provided food packs the families particularly those greatly affected by the lockdown in Barangay

San Rafael III.

The Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Office Management distributed free face masks to all the vendors in the public markets for the safety of both the vendors and market goers.

Moreover, local government had established a program with the Unlad Noveleta network provider for the provision of WiFi access to free all 16 barangays in preparation for the of online opening classes on August 24,

"Instead providing school supplies every day of school, the local government is preparing to provide gadgets to every public school for the online and modular classes,' the mayor stated.

"For our safety, please follow government protocols of proper wearing of face masks, physical distancing, proper hand washing, and avoid crowded places," concluded Mayor Chua. (PIA)









Being the Provincial Jail Warden, he would release the prisoners to capture the Spanish infantry.Revolutionists of Kawit , Malabon (Gen.Trias) and Noveleta seized the Spaniards in their towns. Lapidario hesitated and the plan was learned by the Spaniards, so he and twelve others were seized and executed at Plaza De Armas on September 12, 1896. Born in Imus, Cavite, he became a Freemason and a supporter of the aspiration to be free.

## LGU GenTri conducts rapid testing for frontliners in the cit

City, Cavite -- About 120 frontliners underwent COVID-19 rapid testing on 24 conducted July by the City Health Department to make sure that employees of the city government are healthy while attending to their duties in the frontline.

staffs working for our town.'


