PH IMPROVES GLOBAL INNOVATION INDEX, HITS TOP 50; NEEDS TO SUPPORT MORE R&D AND INNOVATION PROGRAMS – DTI CHIEF

MANILA — The Philippines continues to prove that it is among the world's most innovative economies as it ranked 50th out of 131 countries in 2020 as reported in the annual Global Innovation Index (GII), up from 54th

last year. This is the first time that the Philippines has breached the top 50 of the GII, which recognizes the country as an "innovation achiever" for the second year in a row. "Together with the Department of Science

and Technology (DOST), the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA), the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOPHL), and other national government agencies, we are

delighted to see that our efforts to develop the country's innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem are bearing fruit," said Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Secretary Ramon Lopez. "We are also

committed to sustaining our gains in fostering a culture of innovation among our Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), as well as enabling the close collaboration between industry and

the academe. Both of these are crucial as we endure the pandemic and we push to revitalize businesses, investments, livelihoods, and domestic demand," Sec. Lopez added.

IMUS CITY, Cavite -- The Department of Agriculture (DA) Region 4A (CALABARZON) recently rolled out its KAtuwang sa DIwa at GaWA (KADIWA) ni Ani at Kita Project on Wheels at Unioil Anabu 1 and Unioil Anabu 2.

The project is a partnership between DA, the Department of Energy (DOE) and Unioil that aims to bring farmers' fresh farm produce closer to the consumers at a cheaper cost since no middle men or traders are involved in the wholesale

of fresh farm products. "With the help of DA, we are able to consolidate and sell farm products from across the region even from places which remain in lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic," Raffy Aromin said.

Aromin is the chairman of the Samahan ng Galing Ulan at Lupa Ating Yamanin (SAGULAY) Farmers Association, one of the beneficiaries of the project.

The KADIWA on Wheels serves as a venue to promote and exhibit the farmers' fresh and quality produce to help them earn more to support their livelihood amid the on-going pandemic.

This activity will run every Saturdays and Sundays of September with fresh harvested quality products of the participating groups like the SAGULAY Farmers Association and other farmers groups in CALABARZON on sale. (RF/DA-4A RAFIS)

The trade chief also stressed the need for government to continuously invest in research and development (R&D) and innovation to sustain economic growth. He also underscored the importance of closer collaboration with the private sector, increased access to credit for all Filipinos, provision of microfinancing opportunities and livelihood and business trainings for MSMEs.

The GII 2020 noted that "over the past seven years, and taken together, China, the Philippines, India, and Vietnam are the GII economies in the top 50 with the most significant rank progress over time."

This was facilitated by their integration in global value chains and innovation networks. More specifically for the Philippines, from a rank of 100th in 2014

and reaching 50th in 2020, the GII highlighted country's continued performance in pushing above expectations in its level of development. This placed the country among the top 10 best-ranked lower middle-income economies in the GII, which includes Vietnam, India, and Indonesia.

"The DTI has long-recognized that for the Philippines to be competitive in the Fourth Industrial Revolution, our enterprises and industries need to have strong linkages in domestic and global value chains and participate in innovation and production networks. These are essential in our Inclusive Innovation Industrial Strategy (i3S), which we have been implementing since 2014 and guides our efforts in building Regional Inclusive Innovation Centers (RIICs) across the country consistent

with our Inclusive Filipinovation and Entrepreneurship Roadmap," said Undersecretary Rafaelita Aldaba.

"The RIICs bring together stakeholders from government, industry, and the academe to collaborate and commercialize innovations in order to generate better employment opportunities, more entrepreneurial activities, and sustainable economic prosperity in the country's regions," said Undersecretary Aldaba.

The country's rankings in the GII's input and output sub-indices continues to improve year-on-year. From a rank of 76th in 2019, the Philippine input sub-index rank rose to 70th, and from a rank of 42nd in 2019, the Philippine output sub-index rank moved up to 41st.

Furthermore, the country's rankings significantly increased from last year's in four of the GII's seven pillars: market sophistication (110th to 86th), business sophistication (32nd to 29th), knowledge & technology outputs (31st to 26th), and creative outputs (63rd to 57th).

The GII 2020 also indicated that the Philippines's strengths include: trade,

competition, and market scale (20th); knowledge absorption (7th); knowledge diffusion (8th); utility models by origin (8th); productivity growth (6th); high-tech net exports (3rd); ICT services exports (8th); firms offering formal training (7th); creative goods exports (10th); e-participation (19th); and high-tech imports (1st).

"We are confident

that the Philippines can improve its innovation performance and move up the GII in the coming years, especially with the implementation of the Philippine Innovation Act and Innovative Startups Act. Filipinovation will remain central to sustaining our competitiveness and national development through this pandemic and beyond," remarked Sec. Lopez. (dti.gov.ph)

House panel, magsasampa ng kaso laban kay Duque

Sinabi ni Senior Deputy Majority Leader at Cavite Rep. Jesus Crispin Remulla na iimbestigahan ng joint House panel ang mga iregularidad sa Philippine Health Insurance Corporation at sasampahan ng kaso si Health Secretary Francisco Duque III.

"Ako hindi ko sasabihin kay Duque resign, basta kakasuhan namin siya," saad ni Remulla nitong Sabado sa Executive Session program sa DZRH.

Hindi naman isiwalat ni Remulla ang mga pangalan ng iba pang mga opisyal na makakasama sa sasampahan ng kaso.

Nauna nang inirekomenda ng Senate Committee of the Whole ang pagsasampa ng mga kasong kriminal laban kay Duque dahil sa diumano ay hindi wasto at ilegal na paglabas ng pondo sa ilalim ng patakaran ng Internal Reimbursement Mechanism (IRM) ng PhilHealth.

Sinabi ni Duque na hindi niya ikinatuwa ang rekomendasyon ng panel

ng Senado at iginiit na hindi siya pumirma o sumali sa deliberasyon para sa resolusyon ng IRM.

Sinabi rin niya magpapatuloy siya sa kanyang tungkulin maliban na lamang kung sabihin ng Pangulo na kailangan na nyang umalis sa posisyon.

"If the findings are by design so that they can remove me, let it be said that I have a constitutional duty to do my job unless the President says otherwise. If my service is no longer needed, I will



go," ani Duque.

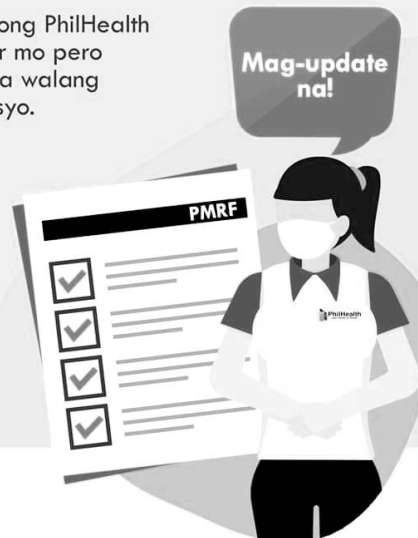

Maynilad, mag-iinvest ng P350-M para sa modular treatment plants sa Cavite

Gagastos ang west zone concessionaire na Maynilad Water Services Inc. ng halagang P350 million para sa pag-install ng dalawang modular treatment plants (MTP) sa lalawigan ng Cavite.

Sa pahayag ng Maynilad, sinabi nito na ang dalawang MTPs ay magbibigay ng karagdagang 13 million liters per day (MLD) ng tubig para sa suplay na kailangan ng nasa

may 50,000 na konsumer sa lugar.

"The MTPs will use Ultrafiltration (UF) and Reverse Osmosis (RO) technology to treat raw water drawn from rivers in Imus, Cavite," saad nito.

"The installation of the MTPs, along with the laying of a discharge pipeline to connect the facility to Maynilad's existing pipe network in the area, is

targeted for completion by February 2021," dagdag pa nito.

Pinaplano rin ng naturang concessionaire na maglagay pa ng dalawang MTPs sa Bacoor at Las Piñas sa last quarter ng 2021.

"This will yield yet another 13-MLD of potable water, for distribution to the southern portion of Maynilad's concession area," pahayag ng Maynilad.(GOCAVITE)

we are facing today, the PNP is one of our partners to widen the reach of the local government's programs and to ensure the safety and security of the people of Imus," Mayor Maliksi said.

Despite the ongoing pandemic, the Imus PNP had conducted 128 operations that resulted to 335 arrests.

Aside from their peace keeping program Oplan Sita, the Imus City Police force had provided other services

especially during this health emergency crisis like the distribution and provision of relief packs to 206 beneficiaries thru their "Kapwa Ko, Sagot Ko" program.

Likewise, the Imus PNP had provided free transportation with the "Hatid Tulong" program in which 13 residents availed of the program while 55 commuters took advantage of the "Libreng Sakay."

The PNP personnel had kept the city safe

during the community quarantine by manning the check-points located in strategic areas in the city and roaming the city streets to monitor the movements of the residents to contain the spread of the COVID-19 disease, and also tasked to validate the applications for the issuance of Travel Authorities for the Locally Stranded Individuals.

The above-mentioned programs and initiatives were just some of the services the Imus City PNP had undertaken in support for the local government's massive campaign to keep the city safe to live in.

Imus PNP is headed by PLtCol. Gerald S. Dee with a full staff of 150 personnel composed of seven (7) Police Commissioned Officers (PCO), 137 Police Non-Commissioned Officers (PNCO), and six (6) Non-Uniformed Personnel (NUP).

Ngayong nasa "full swing" na ang naturang proyektong, pansamantalang isasara ng LRMC ang southernbound lane sa kahabaan ng CAVITEX malapit sa tulay ng Paranaque mula Setyembre 15 hanggang Disyembre 15, 2020.

Sa kadahilanang ito ay maisaayos at mailipat ng Maynilad ang mga tubo na kinakailangan para sa konstruksyon sa lugar, maging ang follow-through ng mga test pit works na isinagawa sa parehong lugar apat na buwan na ang nakalilipas.

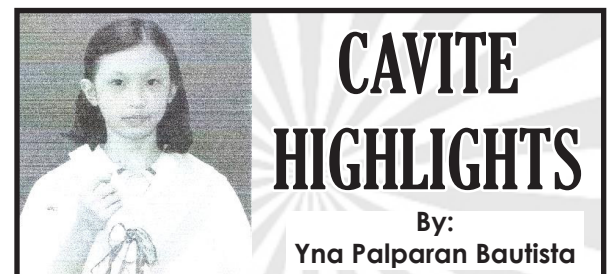

He was working as clerk of Court in Pampanga when he was arrested by the Spaniards for propaganda work for the Katipunan. He was released in 1897 and he joined the forces of Gen. Mariano Trias. He was made a Colonel when he effected the surrender of the Spaniards in Malabon (Gen. Trias) in 1898. He was appointed as Politico-Military Governor of Cavite succeeding Emiliano Riego De Dios.

CALABARZON RDC opens 6th RSI through Virtual Oral Presentation and Presentation

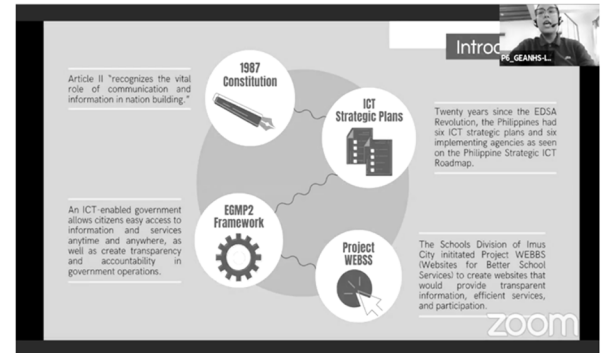
The CALABARZON Regional Development Council (RDC) through its Regional Research and Innovation Committee (RRIC) conducted the Virtual Oral Presentation and Evaluation of research papers from August 26-28 and September 1

& 2 as a preliminary of the 6th CALABARZON Research, Statistics, and Innovation (RSI) Forum that will be held on October 15, 2020.

A total of 60 researchers presented their papers for the final evaluation. These 60 papers classified

under environment, social, and agriculture sectors were initially screened from 257 and then down to 103 entries. The entries came from the academe, public and private research

institutions, and different consortia. Around 340 participants viewed the 5-day virtual oral presentations and garnered a total of 5,274 post engagements. Such initiative helps



in showcasing the significant findings of research studies as well as promoting research culture in the region.

The oral presentations were evaluated by the panel of judges from different government agencies namely Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Region IV-A, Commission on Higher Education (CHED) Region IV-A, Department of Agriculture (DA) Regional Office IV-A, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) - CALABARZON, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) IV-A, Department of Science and Technology (DOST) CALABARZON, Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON, Department of Education (DepEd) IV-A, and Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Region 4A.

This year's

CALABARZON RSI Forum's theme is "Bridging Research and Innovation towards C A L A B A R Z O N ' s S u s t a i n a b l e and Inclusive Development". The RDC-RRIC conducts the RSI Forum biennially in search of papers that support the development of the following sectors: Industry, Social, Environment and Natural Resources, Infrastructure, and Agriculture.

Presentation and evaluation of the scientific posters will happen on September 21-25 via Zoom and Facebook Live in DOST-CALABARZON page as DOST-CALABARZON heads the paper evaluation committee. The posters will also be uploaded on DOST-CALABARZON's facebook page for the viewer's choice award. Winners of the oral presentation, poster presentation, and viewer's choice will be awarded on October 15, 2020.
