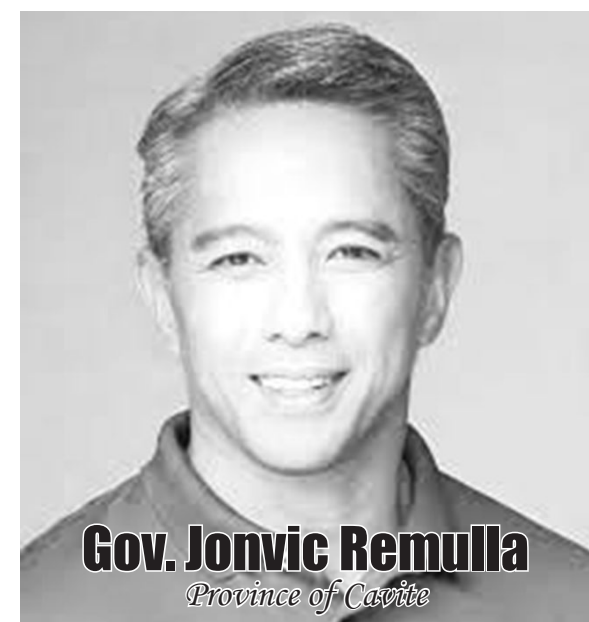

The provincial government continues its advocacy in providing the basic health needs of the Caviteños through the Botika on Wheels program. The team visited Barangays Camposanto, Digmaan, Kaingin, Maliksi 1, Maliksi 2, Maliksi 3 and Poblacion (Tabing Dagat) in the



City of Bacoor to deliver their medical needs on February 26, 2021. A total of 1,807 seniors were given their prescribed medicines while 504 children received vitamins and insect repellent lotion. The BOW team were welcomed by the city government represented by former City Councilor Atty. Venus de Castro, head of the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA), Barangay health workers and barangay nutrition scholars who assisted in the distribution of medicines. DOST-PSTC Cavite inaugurates Tubig Talino Water Refilling Station in Carmona, Cavite



Engr. Raul D. Castañeda, the Provincial Director of the DOST-PSTC Cavite, mentions the potential impact of the establishment of the Tubig Talino Water Refilling Station, in his short message during the inauguration activity. Prior to the passing of Republic Act No. 8172 (An Act Promoting Salt Iodization Nationwide, or ASIN Law), micronutrient malnutrition, especially among children, had been a public concern. With Tubig Talino, the DOST and its technology adopters is able to respond to this ongoing issue.

During the event, Engr. Castañeda, on behalf of the DOST-CALABARZON and the DOST-PSTC Cavite, likewise presented a plaque of recognition as the 2020 Best Grants-in-Aid Community-Based Project (GIA-CBP) Beneficiary in Cavite to the LGU of Carmona for their active engagement with the DOST in the adoption of S&T interventions. One such intervention is the upgrading of its

On February 17, 2021, the Department of Science and Technology – CALABARZON (DOST-CALABARZON), through its Provincial Science and Technology Center in Cavite (DOST-PSTC Cavite), attended the blessing and inauguration of the Buhay Autismo Incorporated (BAI) Tubig Talino Water Refilling Station in Barangay Mabuhay,

Carmona, Cavite. The event is part of the line-up of induction activities celebrating the 164th Founding Anniversary of the Municipality of Carmona, Cavite.

The BAI is a non-government organization established in October 2017 by parents of children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) in Carmona. With the assistance of the

Persons with Disabilities Affairs Office (PDAO) in the municipality, the organization became empowered to spearhead livelihood projects to support the care and to raise the living conditions of persons with ASD and their families. One of such projects is the establishment of the Tubig Talino Water Refilling Station. The DOST-PSTC Cavite funded the

installment of the station equipment and tools for iodine fortification, and helped the BAI to comply with food safety and hygiene standards, and to acquire license to operate with the Food and Drug Administration.

Tubig Talino, or the DOST – Food and Nutrition Research Institute (DOST-FNRI) Iodine Rich Drinking Technology, is among

the DOST technologies available for adoption through the DOST regional offices and provincial centers, including the DOST-CALABARZON and the DOST-PSTC Cavite. The technology (Tubig Talino) addresses the prevalence of iodine deficiency common in Filipino children as drinking at least five glasses of the Tubig Talino meets 33% of the iodine daily requirement of the body.

the provincial capitol in Trece Martires City on March 2, 2021.

Earlier on his official FB page, the governor extended his condolences to the family. His message read, "On behalf of the people serving the Capitol, the Remulla Family and the Province of Cavite, I would like to extend my condolences to the Maliksi family for the loss of their beloved patriarch Erineo 'Ayong' Maliksi." Governor Remulla

also acknowledged the contributions of the late governor adding that Governor Maliksi was part of his father's journey in transforming the province and his contributions should never be forgotten. He also described the former governor as a giant in his generation and a loving father to a grieving family.

The governor has ordered the Philippine flag in the provincial capitol in half mast to

honor his service and as a sign of respect to the former governor.

During the necrological service, the Cavite Mayors' League thru its president, Mendez Mayor Frederick Vida presented Resolution No. 03 – 2021 while members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan led by Vice Governor Jolo Revilla presented Provincial Resolution No. 1721 – 2021 both expressing deepest sympathy to the

bereaved family of the late former Governor Erineo 'Ayong' Maliksi.

Former Governor Ayong Maliksi has served the province for almost 40 years being the Vice Mayor of Imus in 1980-1986, Imus Mayor from 1986-1998, Representative of the City of Imus in 1998-2001 and 2010-2013, and Provincial Governor from 2001-2010.

Governor Ayong Maliksi died at the age of 82. (PICAD)

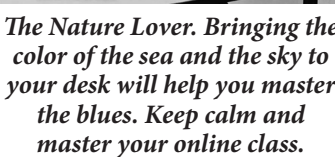

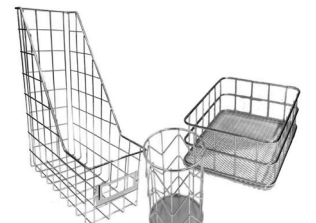

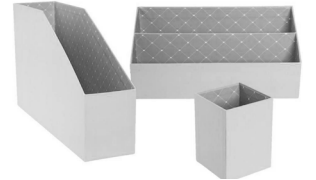

The S-PaSS, developed by DOST VI initially as a travel management system, was primarily intended to make a hassle-free journey for Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs), Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs), Emergency Travelers (ETs), and other travelers during this pandemic. The S-PaSS is also meant to benefit not only the travelers but also the authorities to properly monitor the movement of people in different locations in the effort to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus. will then automatically record information on its eLogBook for recording and monitoring purposes. Together with the use of S-PaSS, authorities shall still continue to strictly implement the minimum public health standards, such as physical distancing, hand hygiene, cough etiquette, and wearing of face masks and face shields across all settings. Clinical and exposure assessment shall be strictly implemented in all ports of entry and exit

while health assessment of passengers, supervised by medical doctors, shall be mandatory upon entry in the port/terminal and exit at point of destination. The DILG, Department of Health (DOH), Department of Tourism (DOT), Department of Transportation (DOTr), the DOST and the Philippine National Police (PNP), as well as the LGUs, shall together ensure the smooth implementation of these protocols.

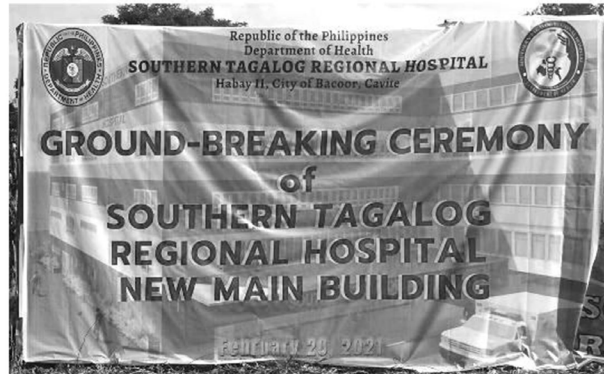
