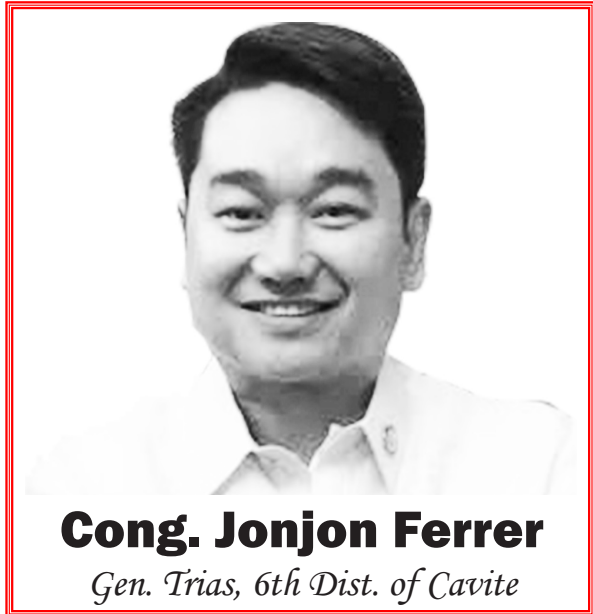

Cavite-Batangas Evacuation Plan SimEx for Taal Volcano Eruption Conducted

Cavite Provincial Government in partnership with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management offices of different LGUs in Cavite and in Batangas successfully conducted the simulation exercises for the Taal Volcano Eruption Evacuation Plan on Monday, March 15, 2021 amid drizzly weather and challenging routes.

Participating teams in the simulation mainly from the Philippine National Police headed by PMAJ Jonathan Asnan, Chief for Operations of the Cavite-Police Provincial Office, converged at two assembly areas, the Tagaytay City Evacuation Center in Brgy. Sungay West and at Amuyong-Alfonso Crossing early in the morning to receive final instructions prior



to take off heading to the different pickup areas in the four municipalities of Batangas – Talisay, Agoncillo, Lemery and Laurel.

Pick up areas in Talisay were Banga Elementary School, Calocan Covered Court and Old Sampaloc Barangay Hall while for Agoncillo is Barigon Elementary School. In Lemery, the pickup up location is Payapa National High School, and Montevideo De Tagaytay in Brgy. Dayap Itaas for the municipality of Laurel. Around 830 participants taking the role as Individually Displaced Individuals (IDPs) were transported to Cavite from all the pickup locations.

Matatandaang si Revilla ang Chairman of the Senate Committee on Civil Service at Government Reorganization and Professional Regulation.

Ayon sa kaniya bagaman ilang beses nang idineklara ng Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) na

ang mga sertipiko ng kapanganakan na inilalabas nila ay walang expiration, maraming ahensya pa rin ng gobyerno at pribadong organisasyon ang nangangailangan o nanghihingi ng mga dokumentong ito sa pinakabagong security paper na nagkakahalaga ng P155 para sa authenticated copy at P365 naman kung personal na ihahatid sa kanilang mga address.

"This requirement costs our people valuable time and money. Lalo na po ngayong panahon ng pandemya ung kailan apektado nang husto ang ating ekonomiya, anumang karagdagang gastusin ay iindahin talaga ng mga kababayan natin. Dagdag pa rito ang panganib o risk na mahawahan ng virus kung sila ay lalabas ng bahay upang kumuha ng birth certificate," ani

Revilla.

Nagpapahayag naman ng pagsuporta ang PSA, Civil Service Commission (CSC) at Department of Education (DepEd) sa panukalang ito.

Tinalakay din ng komite ang pagbaba ng edad ng pagreretiro ng mga empleyado ng gobyerno at kumunsulta sa ilang mga ahensya tulad ng Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), Department of Budget and Management (DBM), pati sa mga non-government associations na kinabibilangan ng Philippine Government Employees Association (PGEA), Philippine Public School Teachers Associations (PPSTA), Confederation for Unity, Recognition and Advancement of Government Employees (COURAGE), Teachers Dignity Coalition, Alliance for Concerned Teachers (ACT), Sentro ng Nagkakaisa at Progresibong Manggagawa (SENTRO), Non-Uniformed Personnel Association, Inc. (NUPAI).

"Ang paglilingkod sa bayan bilang isang

kawani ng pamahalaan ay isang karangalan. Ang karangalang ito ay tinatapatan naman nila ng sipag at dedikasyon sa kanilang trabaho. Kaya't ang mga umaabot ng retirement age sa gobyerno ay maituturing na mga haligi at huwaran ng serbisyo publiko," pahayag ni Revilla.

"Lowering the retirement age will ensure that our senior citizens will be able to enjoy the fruits of their labor and spend more time with their family and friends as well as pursue other endeavours as they approach the twilight of their years," saad pa ng senador patungkol sa Senate Bill No. 72, na nagmumungkahi ng pagbaba ng sapilitan edad ng pagreretiro ng mga empleyado ng gobyerno mula 65 hanggang 60, at ang opsyonal na edad ng pagreretiro mula 60 hanggang 55.

Nagpahayag ng suporta ang GSIS sa mga hakbang, ngunit nagbigay ng mungkahi ng mga reserbasyon na dapat isinasalang-alang para sa posibleng epekto nito sa insurance fund life. (GOCAVITE)

ng Sinovac mula sa National Government. Mayroon ding dumating na 238 vials na karagdagang dala ni DOH RD Janairo ngayong araw na siya namang gagamitin sa Biyernes, March 12.

"Ang mga Bacooreño ay nagpapasalamat sa ating Pangulo, Pres. Rodrigo Roa Duterte, sa ating Vaccine Czar Sec. Galvez at DOH Secretary Duque dahil nabigyan ng mga bakuna kontra Covid-19 ang Lungsod ng Bacoor. Salamat dahil naumpisahan na ang ating vaccination

sa ating mga health care workers." pahayag ni Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla.

Ayon naman kay Dr. Ephraim Rubiano, STRH Director, "Makasaysayan ang araw na ito sa yugto ng pandemya dahil ito na ang araw na ating pinakahihintay. Mag-isang taon na ang community quarantine at sa wakas ay nandito na sa lungsod ng Bacoor ang unang batch ng bakuna, at umaasa tayo na magtutuloy-tuloy na ang pagdating ng bakuna".

DPWH Sec. Mark A. Villar is joined by Municipality of Silang, Cavite Mayor Corrie Poblete and Vice Mayor Aidel Paul Belamide in the ocular inspection of CALAX Subsection 5- Santa Rosa to Silang. Expected to serve 5,000 vehicles upon its opening targeted on Q3 2021.

The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Secretary Mark A. Villar, together with MPCALA Holdings Inc Executives, conducted an ocular inspection for the construction development of Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) Subsection 5 targeted to open to motorists, by 3rd quarter of 2021.

The MPCALA HOLDINGS INC. (MHI), a subsidiary of Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), has already achieved, 83% construction progress on the new Subsection 5 of CALAX.

“As travel restrictions are slowly but surely being lifted, this new subsection of CALAX will help accelerate economic progress in Laguna and Cavite by providing interconnection between the two provinces of Region 4-A. This segment is crucial since it is expected to serve almost 5,000 cars per day, and will ease traffic along Governor’s Drive, Aguinaldo Highway, and Sta. Rosa-Tagaytay Road once opened. Right of way acquisition has been a challenge, so we are giving our full effort to deliver and eventually open with as little deviation to

the original timeline as possible. The completed and operational segments namely Mamplasan to Santa Rosa are currently servicing about 10,000 vehicles daily. We target to finish the whole 45Km stretch of CALAX and serve 50,000 cars before 2022 ends.” said Sec. Villar.

Subsection 5 covers the 7.2-kilometer link from Santa Rosa-Tagaytay Interchange to Silang East Interchange. On-going works include bridge deck and pavement construction, drainage works, road furniture and sound barriers, (cont. P.4)

Una niyang binigyang pagkilala si Kylen

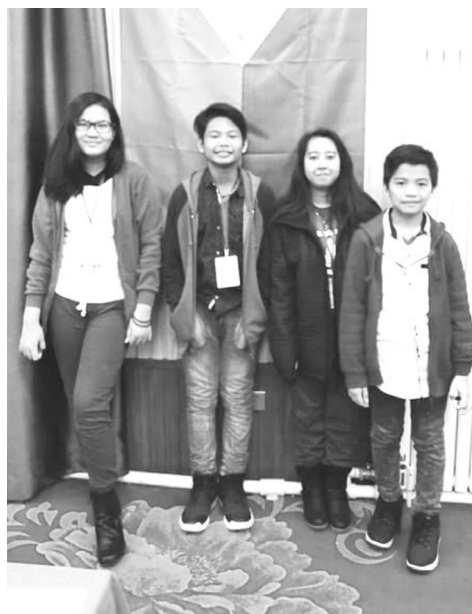
Joy Mordido, 18, na isang Woman International Master (WIM) mula sa Sampaloc IV, at kasalukuyang nag-aaral National University.

Alam naman natin na may kakapusan ang supply ng bakuna sa buong bansa kaya maswerteng nakasama ang ating mga health care workers sa mga unang mababakunahan. Kaya naman, gagawin natin ang lahat para magpatuloy ang ating vaccination rollout."

Matapos ang unang batch ng vaccination rollout sa health care workers sa STRH at CHO ngayong araw ay masusundan ito ng susunod na batch sa Biyernes. At sa mga susunod na linggo ay magpapatuloy ang serye ng mga trainings and seminars sa ating mga personnel na involved sa rollout. Gaganapin

din ang simulation sa dalawang Mega Vaccine Hubs sa Bacoor, isa sa Bacoor Elementary School sa Brgy. Alima at Bacoor Coliseum sa Molino 3.

and structures of Silang (Aguinaldo) Interchange

"With the combined efforts of DPWH and MHI we are optimistic and excited to open the new Subsection 5, hence as soon as Right of Way is handed over to us, we doubleconstruction efforts to avoid any unnecessary delay, while ensuring safety in the workplace," said Mr. Roberto V. Bontia, MPCALA President and General Manager.

A simultaneous intensified effort is the construction of Subsection 4 which is up to Silang (Aguinaldo) Interchange 1st quarter of 2022.

Moreover, according to Mr. Bontia, MPCALA strictly follows the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and COVID-19 Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) health protocols to ensure the protection of its workers from COVID-19.

Upon completion this 24.2B, 4-lane expressway will connect the Manila-Cavite Expressway (Cavite) in Kawit, Cavite to the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) at Greenfield (Mamplasan) Interchange in Biñan, Laguna.

CALAX spans 45 kilometers and has eight (8) interchanges beginning at Kawit, Governor's Drive, Open Canal, Silang

(Aguinaldo) Highway, Silang East, Santa Rosa-Tagaytay, Laguna Boulevard, and Laguna Technopark.

MPTC holds the concession rights for the CALAX, CAVITEX, C-5 Link Expressway, North Luzon Expressway (NLEX), NLEX Connector Road, Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway (SCTEX), and Cebu-Cordova Link Expressway (CCLEX) in Cebu.

initially taken to the COVID-19 swabbing stations, one at Tagaytay City Evacuation Center and the other at Pansin Elementary School in Alfonso. Sample swabbing using Antigen test kits were done on site by medical personnel from Cavite Provincial Health Office headed by Provincial Epidemiologist Dr. Nelson Soriano. Those with negative results

were then taken to their assigned evacuation center following the LGU twinning arrangements agreed upon by Cavite-Batangas cities and municipalities. Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla personally observed the simulation exercise which was supervised by the Provincial DRRMO headed by Ms. Eloisa Rozul together with

members of the Provincial Emergency Operations Response Clusters and in partnership with LDDRMOs of Alfonso, Tagaytay City, Mendez, Amadeo, Indang, Silang, Magallanes and Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo in the province of Cavite as well as partner DRRMOs in Batangas.

Agoncillo, Batangas Mayor Daniel Reyes also observed the transporting of his constituents by the Cavite team at Barigon Elementary School. Likewise, Cavite Provincial Administrator for Community Affairs Mr. Alvin Mojica was present during the drills as well as Cavite-PNP Provincial Director PCOL Marlon Santos who was at the Command Post to guide the police force.

Aside from the personnel and vehicles deployed by the provincial government, the LDDRMOs and the PNP, other volunteers who joined and provided logistics to the SimEx were from the Southern

town. In an interview with The Cavite Rising, Noveleta Mayor Dino Chua said the representatives of each town had a discussion with Presidential Legal Counsel Salvador Panelo to convey their plans and programs to the national

government. "Parang napag-iwanan na tayo ng ibang lugar sa Cavite province. [We are the] first district pero parang last tayo sa mga programs so gusto namin isulong ang 'First District First.' Dapat unang distrito, una rin tayo sa serbisyo," Chua

said. The newly-formed alliance of the local officials plans to build a public hospital for the first district of Cavite.

According to Chua, it has long been the sentiment of the first district to have a free hospitalization for their

constituents.

"Like now, may COVID tayo, ang hirap pumunta sa mga hospitals. Kapag wala kang public hospital, ang mahal ng binabayaran. So yung mahihirap or the poorest of the poor, problema na nila yon. Kapag wala silang pang-down payment, hindi sila matatanggap," the mayor emphasized.

The local governments, moreover, intend to uplift their respective economy by providing assistance to local entrepreneurs and opening more jobs in partnership with the

Department of Labor and Employment.

Furthermore, he said: "Yung mga national government programs like the financial assistance of DSWD, yung mga recovery programs, very seldom makarating sa first district kaya 'yon ang isa rin sa problema natin."

Likewise, Chua also mentioned that the newly-formed alliance eyes to enhance the scholarship program within the first district.

"E d u c a t i o n a l assistance is a real assistance. Dapat 'yan P5,000 and up depende sa

pangangailangan," Chua explained.

Aside from Chua, the other officials who participated were Rosario Mayor Jose Voltaire Ricafrente, Kawit Mayor Angelo Aguinaldo, Cavite City Vice Mayor Denver Chua and Cavite 1st District Board Member Davey Chua.

Meanwhile, during the same event, Ricafrente received a Malacanang recognition for his late father and former Rosario Mayor Jose "Nonong" Ricafrente Jr. who also served in the Presidential Action Center.

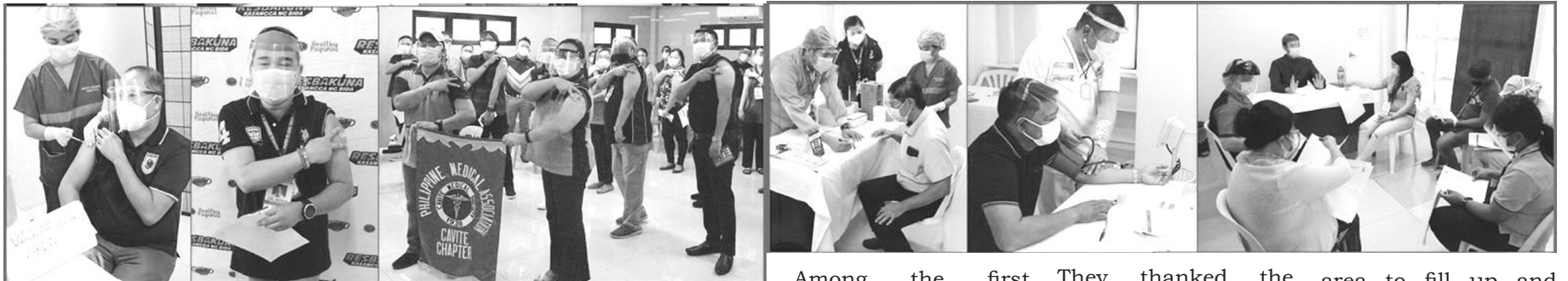

COVID-19 VACCINATION ROLLOUT IN CAVITE



The province of Cavite started its COVID-19 vaccination rollout on March 10, 2021 at the Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital (GEAMH) in Trece Martires City. GEAMH is one of the official vaccination sites in

the province identified by the Department of Health-Regional Office, among others were De La Salle University Medical Center, Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital, Ospital ng Imus and Tagaytay International

Convention Center. Three hundred eighty-nine Sinovac vaccines and ninety-one Astra Zeneca vaccines were delivered on March 9, 2021 which were used in the vaccination rollout scheduled until March 12.

Among the first vaccinees were Dr. Nonie John Dalisay, Officer-in-Charge of the Provincial Health Office, Dr. Romulo Lua, chief of hospitals, Dr. Aldous Angeles, satellite hospitals chief and Dr. Regina B. Salazar, head-GEAMH Dental Department.

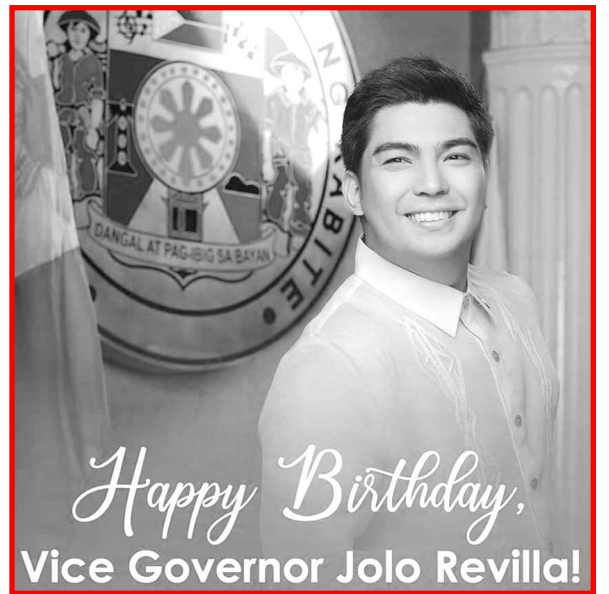
They thanked the government for providing vaccines for the medical front liners and encouraged the public to be vaccinated for them to be protected against the virus as well as their families and other people. Around 150 vaccinees is targeted on the first day of vaccination.

The process started at the waiting area where candidates for vaccination took the cue to proceed to the next step at the registration

area to fill up and check necessary requirements. They then proceeded to the counselling area. Afterwards, they were endorsed to the screening area where a resident doctor checked and screened if the patient qualified for vaccination. Next stage was the actual administration of vaccine and the final stage was the post vaccination monitoring wherein patients were observed for possible reactions.(PICAD)
