PopCom-DSWD program emerges amid rising 'unintended' pregnancy

MANILA – The Commission on Population and Development (PopCom) will start a social protection program for adolescents with unintended pregnancies.

The program, in partnership with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), is eyed for launch by the third quarter of 2021, PopCom chief Dr. Juan Antonio Perez III told the Philippine News Agency (PNA) on Friday.

"The Philippine government will strive to meet their needs constantly and comprehensively through constant communication with the young heads of families," Perez said, adding that PopCom was tapped by Congress to develop the program.

It will have multidimensional sources of protection, such as the possible provision of livelihood.

"These elements will ensure young people

everywhere will have meaningful participation and safe spaces during these times, as the pandemic unleashes a host of challenges," he said.

The move was a response to a University of the Philippines Population Institute (UPPI) and United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) study that showed a 42-percent increase in unintended pregnancies among Filipinos in 2020.

The increase was about 79,000 additional unintended pregnancies per month during the pandemic.

The results also cited

a 67-percent hike in unmet needs for family planning among Filipino women.

One of 10 in the data was an adolescent.

The UPPI and UNFPA conducted the study to estimate the potential impact of the pandemic on key sexual and reproductive health.

The PopCom-DSWD program will prioritize the financially challenged and first-time mothers during the pandemic.

"These adolescents have no decision-making power, economic independence, autonomy, and are considered by many countries as powerless. They face



greater risks of repeat pregnancies and are vulnerable to gender-based violence, as well as intergenerational poverty during, and as a result, of their early childbearing," Perez said.

He said young people need to have access to safe, trusted, and reliable information integrated into services ensuring health, protection, and psychosocial support.

"It is a fulfillment of their constitutional rights under Republic Act 10354, or the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act of 2012," Perez added.

He said isolation and physical-distancing measures stemming from the pandemic's safety protocols could be limiting the capacity of the youth to exercise their rights. (PNA)

Una ay kaniyang ipinaliwanag ang ayudang inilaan ng pamahalaan sa bayan ng Naic na kung tutuusin umano ay kulang para sa lahat ng kabahayan.

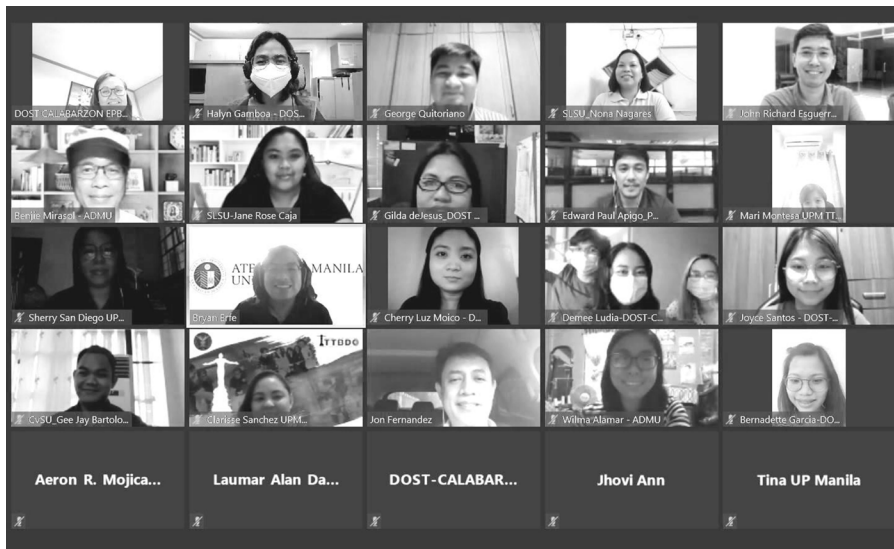

TENTS TO SERVE AS COVID
ICUs/WARDS IN CALABARZON**



The 44-bed capacity heavy duty collapsible modular tent which will serve as emergency intensive care unit and ward for Covid patients in CALABARZON. It is a close tent with a 5-meter wide and 12-meter-long floor area fully covered with soft PVC side wall and with eave height. One modular tent cost Php294,850.00

The Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) delivered a total of 16 collapsible tents to priority health facilities in the region to serve as an emergency intensive care unit (ICU) and ward for Covid patients.

“We have to augment and expand the capacity of our health facilities to accommodate the increasing number of Covid patients in the region. Hindi natin pwedeng sabihing puno na ang mga hospitals natin at hindi sila tanggapin. We have to find ways to help them. Buhay ng tao ang nakasalalay dito and we have to accept them. Naghihirap na nga sila, huwag na nating pahirapan pa. We must provide them the

health access and service they need. Every health facility must be able to take care of patients seeking treatment,” Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

“The present Covid pandemic is an unprecedented health crisis that requires extraordinary

amount of resources for an indefinite period of time. Lahat tayo dapat magtulungan to ensure that health facilities remain strong and stable in its ability to provide health care to all, especially during this time of pandemic.”

In the afternoon, the participants drafted their own pitch decks and presented it to the judges for critiquing.

Mock Pitching Event

The third part of the StARTT program is the Mock Pitching event where 12 technologies from the chosen RDIs and SUCs will present their recorded pitching videos to the panelists, followed by the open forum.

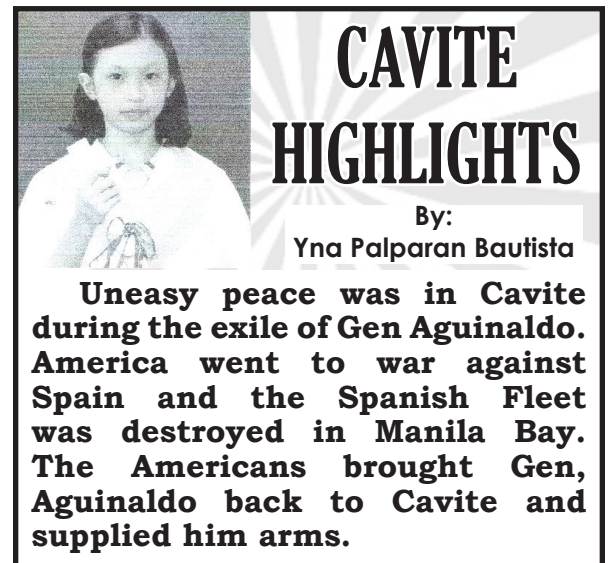
Ms. Russell Pili, Chief Science Research Specialist and Chief Technology Transfer Officer of the Research Information and Technology Transfer Division (RITTD) of DOST-PCIEERD, gave the opening remarks.

“I know that this is not exhaustive enough but this is enough to give you at least a glimpse of what it’s like [to pitch],” admitted Ms. Pili, “The purpose of the pitch naman is to start a conversation.” She assured the participants—

especially the new ones—in the form of a joke, saying that while they should be nervous, they should also envision the mock pitching event as the “real” pitching session.

The program proper involved the video presentations from the chosen RDIs and SUCs in the first session of StARTT last month. After each product pitch, the panelists offered their critiques and suggested ways on how to better “market” these technologies. Mr. Edward Paul Apigo of DOST-PCIEERD, together with the speakers from the previous StARTT workshop on investment pitching namely, Mr. Benjie Mirasol, Mr. Jon Fernandez, and Mr. George Quitoriano of ADMU, served as the panelists.

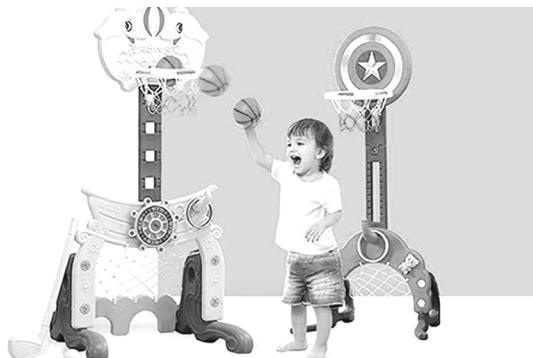

The 44-bed capacity modular tent will serve as an extension of the health facility. The tent has a 5-meter wide and 12-meter-long floor area. It is a closed tent, fully covered with soft PVC side wall and with eave height. One modular tent cost Php294,850.00

Among the sixteen (16) health facilities who received the heavy duty collapsible tents were Carsigma District Hospital in GMA, General

Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital in Trece Martires City, Ospital ng Imus in Imus and Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoor in the province of Cavite; General Cailles Memorial District Hospital in Pakil, Laguna Medical Center in Sta. Cruz, San Pablo City General Hospital in San Pablo City, and San Pablo City District Hospital in San Pablo City in Laguna; Bondoc Peninsula District Hospital in Cat-

anauan, Claro M. Recto Memorial District Hospital in Infanta, Gumaca District Hospital in Gumaca, Magsaysay Memorial District Hospital in Lopez, Quezon Medical Center in Lucena City and RAKK Prophet Medical Center Inc. in Gumaca in the province of Quezon; San Juan District Hospital in San Juan and Mabini Community Hospital in

Mabini in Batangas province.

Janairo also disclosed that the provinces of Rizal and Batangas are now at high risk in terms of bed occupancy rate with 77.8% and 74.3%, respectively.

"We have moderate risk for total beds occupancy rate for the provinces of Cavite (65.2%), Laguna 63.8% and Lucena

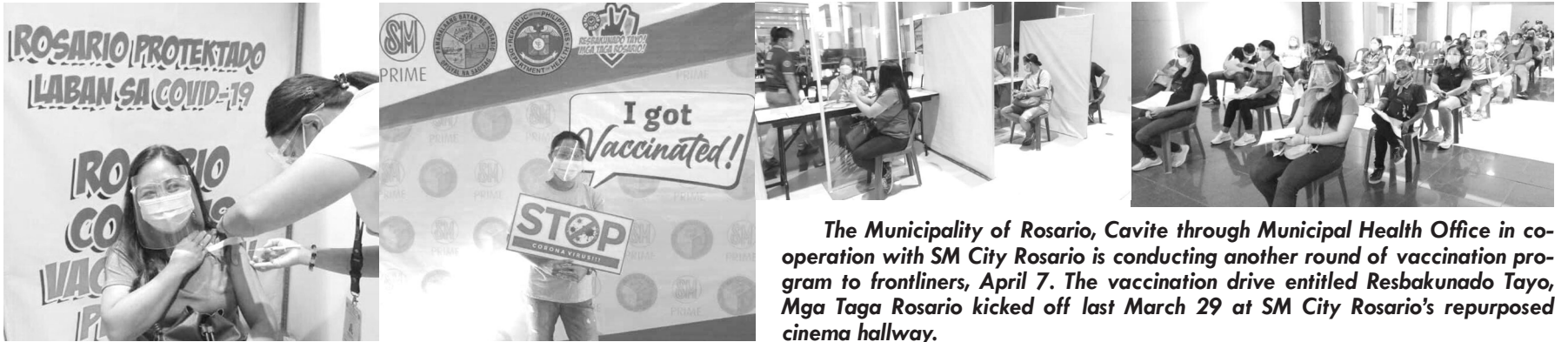
City (65.2%). The province of Quezon is at low risk with 57.8%."

"We have to be prepared to handle the influx of Covid patients not only from the provinces but also those of nearby Metro Manila. Our health facilities in the region are already accepting Covid patients from NCR for treatment and care," he emphasized.

The four mega quarantine facilities in the region are now at 64% occupancy rate with a total of 534 admitted patients from a total number of 839 beds capacity.

As of April 6, 2021, a total of 100,440 Covid cases were recorded in the region with 16,860 active cases. There are 80,901 recoveries with 2,679 deaths. (GLEN RAMOS)
