## SEN. REVILLA CLEARED OF GRAFT OVER PORK BARREL SCAM

Senator Ramon “Bong” Revilla on Monday July 7, 2021 praised the Sandiganbayan’s decision clearing him of charges related to the so-called pork barrel scam and said he can now move on “free of this nuisance.”

“The truth has come out,” he said in a statement posted on Facebook. “Now, I can move forward to serving our nation and our people even further, free of this nuisance.”

“The Sandiganbayan, by granting our Demurrer

to Evidence and dismissing all the charges against me, validates what we have known from the very beginning – that all the accusations against me have no basis and any leg to stand on,” he added.

In its decision, the

Sandiganbayan Special First Division granted Revilla’s demurrer to evidence and acquitted the senator of 16 counts of graft.

“Nakitapong Korte na walang basehan ang mga akusasyon sa akin. Hindi

ko na nga kinailangan pang depensahan ang aking sarili at magbigay ng aming ebidensya. Sa mga isinumite pa lamang ng prosekusyon ay wala silang napatunayan,” the senator also said.

## DENR proposes sanitary landfill in Cavite to solve garbage problem

QUEZON CITY -- and Natural Resources Department of Environment (DENR) Secretary Roy A.

Cimatu plans to put up a compliant sanitary landfill (SLF) in the province of Cavite to help manage its garbage problem that is affecting the ongoing Manila Bay rehabilitation project.

Cimatu, who is chair of the Manila Bay Task Force, and some DENR officials met with Cavite Governor Juanito Victor "Jonvic" Remulla and the mayors of Cavite province to discuss ways to encourage their cooperation in addressing solid waste and water quality management issues in the six major river systems in the province.

During the event, DENR Calabarzon Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria identified Cavite's six major rivers as Imus River, Zapote River, Rio Grande-Ylang-Ylang River, Cañas River, Labac River and Maragondon River, all of which empty out into the historic bay.

"We cannot complete the rehabilitation of Manila Bay if we will not solve the garbage problem in the province. There is a very big connection between that," Cimatu told Cavite officials during their meeting held at Oasis Hotel in Imus City on June 24.

"The only way for us to solve the problem of Manila Bay is to solve the garbage problem and water quality of the rivers in Cavite," he added.

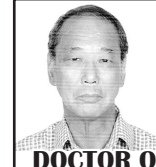
Present at the meeting were mayors from the cities of Cavite, Gen. Trias and Trece Martires, and the municipalities of Amadeo, GMA, Indang, Mendez, Naic, Silang, and Tanza.

Remulla said solid waste management is the number one problem of Cavite when it comes to the environment, as he noted that an estimated 50 percent of solid waste in the province goes to its rivers accounting to approximately 2,000 tons a day, of which 90 percent goes to Manila Bay.

The provincial chief executive disclosed that 21 of the 23 cities and municipalities of the province "do not have the capacity to put up their own solid waste facility because of the limitations of land" of which he appealed for the DENR to help in setting up an SLF.

Cimatu, explained that due to the recent rainfalls, trash from various waterways including those from the rivers of Cavite drift to Manila Bay, countering the latest significant improvements in the Baywalk area in terms of coliform level and solid waste collection.

He added that the evident increase in garbage in the rivers may be attributed to the closure of all dumpsites in the province in compliance with Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste

"I'd like to appeal to the Mayors of Cavite to please help us," Cimatu said, as he pointed out that under the law, local government units (LGUs) are primarily responsible for waste segregation and disposal.

Meanwhile, DENR Undersecretary for Solid Waste Management and LGUs Concerns and Cavite Cluster Task Force head Benny D. Antiporda suggested some strategies that the LGUs may implement to address the garbage problem in their respective localities.

These include having "environmental marshals" in the barangays, influencing behavioral change, enforcement of policies and city ordinances, and checking the environmental compliance of various industries and establishments

in their respective areas of responsibility.

Antiporda said the DENR is committed to help the LGUs to complement their ongoing cleanup efforts like installing trash traps, employing additional river rangers, and managing the wastes generated by informal settlers.

Also present during the meeting were City Environment and Natural Resources Officers; Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officers; and representatives from the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office, Manila Bay Coordinating Office, and regional offices of the DENR, Mines and Geosciences Bureau, Environmental Management Bureau, and Department of the Interior and Local Government. 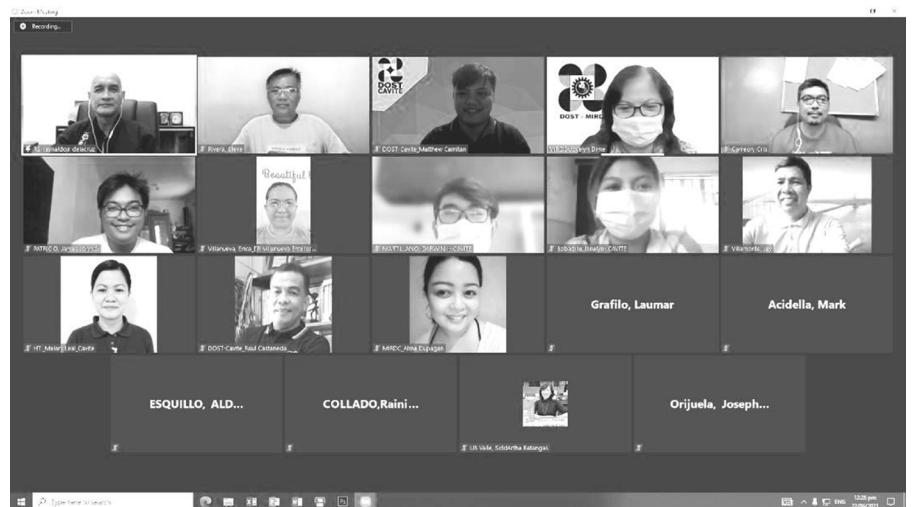

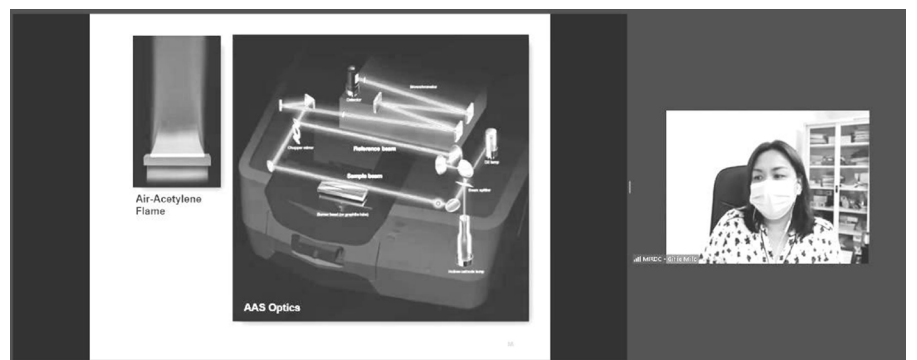
# DOST-Cavite and DOST-MIRDC capacitate 15 Cavite metals and engineering firms on metal identification and selection



Thirty-three (33) metal workers representing 15 Cavite-based fabrication firms completed the two-day webinar on metal identification and selection on June 23, 2021. The Department of Science and Technology – CALABARZON, through its Provincial Science and Technology Center in Cavite (DOST-Cavite), in cooperation with the DOST – Metals

Industry Research and Development Center (DOST-MIRDC), spearheaded the activity to capacitate the participants in conducting metal identification tests, and to determine the heat treatment for each metal type. Engr. Reynaldo L. Dela Cruz, Jr., Engr. Mervin B. Gorospe, Engr. Rey N. Mariposque, and Engr. Girlie M. Millo of the DOST-MIRDC

each discussed a topic during the activity. Engr. Dela Cruz introduced metal identification and selection, and showcased different samples of metals to the participants. Engr. Gorospe talked about metallography—the study of the microstructure of metals—and heat treatment. Heat treatment is the controlled process of altering the microstructure of metals through the use of



conventional furnaces. On the second day, Ms. Alma C. Dupagan of the DOST-MIRDC, facilitated a pre-test before introducing Engr. Mariposque. The latter presented the different DOST-MIRDC mechanical tests, and demonstrated how each of these tests are used. Lastly, Engr. Millo discussed chemical analysis of metals.

The DOST-MIRDC is the principal government agency in support of the metals and engineering industry. Established in 1966 under the name Metals Industry Development Center, the agency is tasked to create a strong link and close rapport between the government and the industry. Through the partnership between the DOST-Cavite and DOST-

MIRDC, capacity building activities such as this are brought closer to Cavite. Mr. Matthew Henry G. 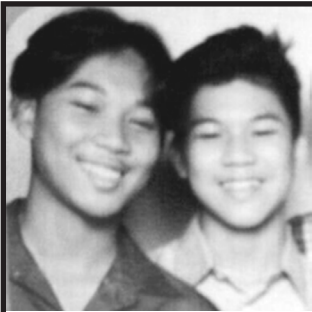

## PhilHealth expands DCPM coverage; releases P6.3 billion in payments



The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is urging health care facilities (HCFs) located in areas with high concentration of COVID-19 cases as determined by the Inter-Agency Task Force/National Task Force Against COVID-19 (IATF-NTF) to avail of its Debit-Credit Payment Method (DCPM).

PhilHealth has implemented the DCPM to fast-track the settlement of its payables to HCFs to ensure continuous delivery of services during the COVID-19 pandemic. The DCPM was first made available to HCFs treating COVID-19 patients in the National Capital Region, Batangas, Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, Pampanga, and Rizal.

In view of IATF Resolution Nos. 121, 118-A, 116-C, 114-C, 114-A, and 113-A, s. 2021, PhilHealth said that it is expanding coverage for the DCPM to the following provinces and cities:

Area	Provinces/Cities
<b>Mindanao</b>	Agusan del Sur, Butuan City, Cagayan de Oro City, Davao City, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Sur, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga del Sur, Zamboanga Sibugay

Interested health care facilities in the said cities and provinces are required to submit their Letter of Intent (LOI) to the concerned PhilHealth Regional Office to qualify for fast-tracked payments under DCPM.

Pursuant to Section V of PhilHealth Circular No. 2021-0006, the DCPM shall only be applicable to (the applying HCFs) in-process claims received from March 8, 2020 to April 7, 2021. On the other hand, claims returned, denied, under investigation and those approved for payment as of April 7, 2021 are not qualified under the DCPM. The HCFs also must have claims for COVID-19, have no Interim Reimbursement Mechanism (IRM) balance on record, and have not been served with any suspension of accreditation during the applicable period.

As of June 14, 2021, PhilHealth already disbursed more than P6.3 billion to 206 HCFs under the DCPM. ###

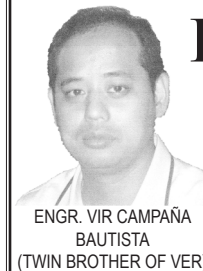

## Revisioning Enforcement Operations in CALABARZON: ELEPS on the Way

Members of the Joint Regional Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (RMFPC) and the Regional Enforcement Task Group (RETG) CALABARZON discussed the newly created Environmental Law Enforcement and Protection Service (ELEPS) during its Second Quarter Meeting conducted last June 29, 2021, at the DENR

CALABARZON Conference Hall, Brgy. Mayapa, Calamba City, Laguna.

DENR Assistant Secretary for Enforcement Atty. Daniel Darius M. Nicer provided context on the enforcement operations of DENR. As a prelude to the establishment of the Environmental Protection and Enforcement Bureau, the DENR created

the ELEPS through an Administrative Order signed by DENR Secretary Roy A. Cimatu.

ASec. Nicer introduced the new strategies in their enforcement operations under the operational guidelines of ELEPS. "Ang enforcement nainiisip natin ay 'yong naghahabol tayo ng truck na may troso at nakikipagbakbakan... babaguhin na natin ang ganitong pananaw sa sistema ng enforcement... unahin natin at bibigyan ng importansya ang information gathering on the state of the environment in our areas of jurisdiction and then from there, act accordingly to stop any ongoing damage and to prevent further damage to our environment... this envisions a system na hindi lang naka-rely sa ating mga kamay at katawan na nakasubo sa labanan. Gagamit tayo ng mga sistema at teknolohiya na maayos, sistematiko, at ligtas para saatin. We will prioritize prevention of environmental destruction over prosecution on environmental offenses... ang focus natin ay sa source, hindi sa distribution point", he said.

In strengthening the intelligence operations of the Department, ASec Nicer mentioned, "Alam natin na ang ating mga kalaban sa kalikasan ay nagtatago sa dilim at kasukalan ng mga gubat sa mga disoras na mga pagkakataon. Doon natin sila hahanapin. We will overcome their primary defense - their inconspicuousness and inaccessibility of our primary resources. Pagkahuli, we will do a quick response to avoid further damage to the environment and the lives of people."

Through ELEPS, environmental protection is ensured without compromising the safety of the enforcement officers. "It will be good for the environment, and it will be safer for us as enforcers. Hangga't maaari ayaw ko nang may makitang nasasawi or injured sa ating mga enforcers", A Sec Nicer reiterated. From 2017-2021, a total of 13 DENR Environmental Defenders were killed in the line of duty, not to mention other enforcers in other line agencies.

Further updates on the creation of the ELEPS were provided by the DENR CALABARZON Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria. He shared the vision and direction of ELEPS, the status of the proposed EPEB Bill, Existing DENR Enforcement Organizational Structure, rationale on the creation of ELEPS as EPEB Provisional to institutionalize, mainstream, and strengthen the environmental law enforcement of DENR, and the proposed ELEPS organizational structure.

In 2019, DENR Secretary Roy A. Cimatu

appealed for the creation of Enforcement Bureau to ensure the security of the people in enforcing environmental laws. RED Tamoria shared that to date, the EPEB Bill was already filed at the congress with 4 principal and 13 co-sponsors at the House of Representatives and 2 main sponsors at the senate. While waiting for the passage of the Bill, ELEPS, as an interim enforcement arm, was formed through a Department Administrative Order to have a dedicated office in the Department who will guide the Regional and Field Offices in all enforcement aspects. RED Tamoria clarified that once the EPEB Bill is enacted, the ELEPS shall be aligned with the provisions as stated therein.

Meanwhile, DENR CALABARZON Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services Alfredo Palencia recognized the contribution of the

RMFPC in monitoring environment-related activities in the field. He said, "malaki po ang tulong na naibibigay sa departamento ng RMFPC para sa ganon ay 'yong mga reports ng illegal activities at pagkasira ng ating kalikasan ay mapigilan natin... alam naman natin na hindi kaya ng DENR alone kundi dapat ay sama-sama tayo".

Topics during the activity were the (1) Status of plans and programs of RMFPC discussed by RMFPC Chair Manuel A. Beloso, (2) Battle plan against illegal logging activities in Quezon Province tackled by Quezon PENR Officer Ramil Limpiada, (3) Status of Quarry Operations in CALABARZON shared by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau, and (4) Status of Sanitary Landfill and Open Dumpsite in the Region presented by the Environmental

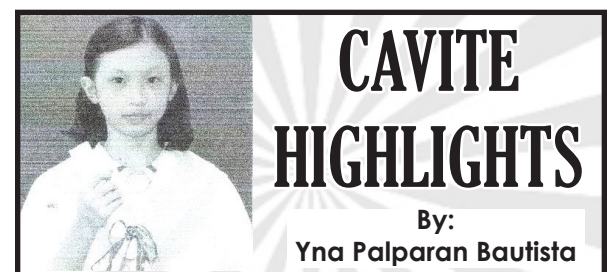

Parehong alintutunin rin ang isagagawa para sa mga manlalakbay na senior citizen.



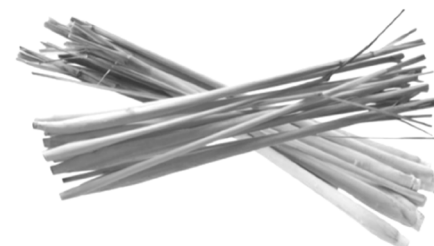
Cases against Revilla's former aide, Richard Cambe, were also dismissed by the Sandiganbayan because of death.
