# TESDA to train 20 NBP inmates in urban farming

MANILA - The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) will be training at least 20 persons deprived

of liberty (PDLs) of the New Bilibid Prison (NBP) on urban farming and agripreneurship.

"This is voluntary for those who would like

to avail of the training. This would run for five days, and tentatively set to start on September 30," TESDA Secretary Isidro Lapeña told the Philippine News Agency on Monday.

Initially, 5,000 square meters were allotted for this project,



but Lapeña said the Bureau of Corrections has allocated 2.5 hectares of land that can be developed.

# DOH CALABARZON STRENGTHENS HEALTH CARE SYSTEM AGAINST DELTA VARIANT THREATS



DOH-CALABARZON Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo says the regional office continues to implement programs and initiate innovative plans to strengthen its health care system to enable to respond to the present pandemic.

Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) continuous to strengthen its health care system against the ongoing threat of Delta Variant cases in the region.

"We have already established the "One Hospital Command Center (OHCC) in which we have link

the health and medical services of our regional hospitals, particularly the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Cavite and the Batangas Medical Center in Batangas. Kabilang rin sa network na ito ang ibang malalaking public hospitals sa probinsya ng Laguna, Quezon at Rizal upang magbigay ng kinakailangang health services sa ating kababayan lalo

na sa mga positibong Covid virus. Kaya mayroon tayong well-coordinated response at referral system na syang namamahala sa ating mga Covid cases," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"We all Covid-19 cases as Delta Variant cases and this is the reason why we initiated and established the "Project Delta" with the

objective of preventing the immediate spread of the virus in high-risk communities."

Janairo also emphasized that Covid patients admitted in government health facilities in remote areas need not worry as they have been conducting telemedicine consultations since 2018. "Maraming health facilities na nalagyan ng telemedicine services sa iba't-ibang malalayong probinsya and the most recent is the teleicu system placed at Quezon Medical Center in Lucena City, to monitor critical Covid patient in intensive care units (ICU) which is also designed to protect health-care workers from possible infection due to less exposure."

As of September 16, 2021, the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit recorded 406 Delta Variants with Laguna having the highest number of cases at 112

followed by Cavite with 99 cases, Rizal with 83, Batangas – 65, Quezon – 33 and Lucena City with 14 cases.

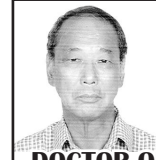
Most source of Delta infection comes from local transmission with 355 cases with the largest number also from Laguna with 102 cases followed by Cavite with 82 cases, Rizal – 78, Batangas – 52, Quezon – 28 and Lucena City with 13 cases.

A total of 51 Delta cases came from Returning Overseas Workers (ROF) with Cavite topping the list with 17 cases followed

by Batangas with 13, Rizal and Quezon with 5 cases each and Lucena City has one case.

Janairo said that the regional office continues to conduct mass antigen and RT-PCR testing to prevent transmission.

"Follow health protocols, for young children and senior citizens better stay indoors just to be safe and get vaccinated if you have not yet received your dose. It is better to have an additional protection than none at all," he reminded residents. (GLEN RAMOS)

## LIMITADONG FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES, APRUBADO NA NI PANGULONG DUTERTE

Inanunsyo ni Department of Education Secretary Leonor Briones na aprubado na ni Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte ang pagsagawa ng limitadong face-to-face classes sa ilang paaralan sa bansa.

Ayon kay Briones, lilimitahan lamang muna sa 100 kabilang ang 20 pribadong paaralan ang papayagang magsagawa ng face-to-face classes partikular na sa mga lugar na mayroong minimal risk ng COVID-19.

Kinakailangan din umanong bigyan ng pahintulot ng mga magulang at ng lokal na pamahalaan ang mga estudyanteng lalahok sa naturang klase.

Nilinaw naman ng kalihim na may nakatakdang bilang

lamang ng mga mag-aaral ang maaaring dumalo sa face-to-face classes.

Kagaya na lamang halimbawa ng mga nasa Kindergarten, 12 lamang na mag-aaral ang papayagang pumasok sa paaralan samantala nasa 16 naman ang papayagan para sa mga nasa grade 1-10 at 20 para sa mga nasa senior highschool.

## DOH, SINIMULAN ANG OPERASYON NG ONE HOSPITAL COMMAND CENTER SA CALABARZON



Nagsimula na ang operasyon ng One Hospital Command Center (OHCC) sa CALABARZON, na layon ay mapaingting ang sistemang medikal ng rehiyon sa gitna ng banta ng COVID-19 Delta variant.

Ipinaliwanag ni Dr. Eduardo Janairo, DOH-Calabarzon director na sa pamamagitan ng

OHCC ay magiging “well-coordinated” ang response at referral system ng COVID-19 cases sa buong rehiyon.

“We have established the OHCC in which we have a link to the health and medical services of our regional hospitals, particularly the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Cavite and the Batangas

Medical Center in Batangas,” ani Janairo sa isang pahayag na inilabas noong Linggo ng DOH-Calabarzon.

“Included in this network are the large public hospitals in the provinces of Laguna, Quezon, and Rizal to provide necessary health services to residents who test positive for the COVID-19 virus.”

Sa kasalukuyan ay nangunguna sa listahan ang lalawigan Laguna na may 102 Delta cases mula sa local transmission na sinundan ng Cavite, 82; Rizal, 78; Batangas, 52; Quezon, 28; at Lucena City, 13.

# Back to the Wild: DENR CALABARZON Releases Turned Over Wildlife to their Natural Habitat

The DENR CALABARZON through its Conservation and Development Division released five (5) heads of Reticulated Python (*Malayopython reticulatus*) and six (6) heads of Marbled Water Monitor Lizard (*Varanus marmoratus*) last July 9, July

17, and July 18, 2021 near Mount Nagcarlan, Lamot II, Calauan, Laguna and in Quezon Protected Landscape and Binahaan River Watershed Forest Reserve, Pagbilao, Quezon.

Prior to the release, the Region's Wildlife Release Team observed the

species for any imprint or docile behavior, and secured health certificates from attending veterinarian of the Provincial Veterinary Clinic of Laguna indicating fit for release, and coordinated with the concerned barangays.

"As much as possible, we conduct im-

mediate release of turned over wildlife to avoid imprinting and domestication, and also to reduce the number of wildlife being maintained at the Regional Wildlife Res-

cue Center. We have also hired a technical staff to closely monitor the species being rehabilitated at the Rescue Center", Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria said.

The Regional Wildlife Rescue Center located in Barangay Lamot II, Calauan, Laguna, currently houses a total of 186 wildlife. From January to September 2021, a total of 29 heads of wildlife were released back to their natural habitat. Before disposition, the Wildlife Release Team conducts coordination meetings with the local community to orient them on RA 9147 or Wildlife Resources Con-

servation and Protection Act and the planned release of wildlife in their area.

In case of encountering wildlife, the DENR CALABARZON is urging the public to report the incident to the nearest DENR office in your area. ## PAG-AALIS NG MGA FISHING STRUCTURES SA CAVITE, ITUTULOY NG DENR

Itutuloy na ng Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) ang demolisyon ng mga umano'y "ilegal" na istruktura sa pangingisda, tahungan, at talabahan kagaya ng mga sapra at baklad sa probinsya ng Cavite matapos nilang makumpleto ang bilang nito.

Maglalabas na ang departamento ng Notice of Demolition, ayon kay DENR-Calabarzon regional director Nilo Tamoria.

Batay sa kaniya, aabot sa 954 "ilegal" na istruktura ang kanilang nabilang at mahigit 400 dito ay tahungan ngunit makikipag-ugnayan pa

umano ang DENR sa mga lokal na pamahalaan sa Cavite upang i-regulate ang mga tahungan sa kanilang mga lugar.

Aniya, pasok na ipwesto ang mga tahungan sa category ng dagat sa Cavite, na "SB" o "swim and bath", ngunit dahil masyadong marami na ang mga istruktura nang ayusin.

"Sa SB quality level ng tubig, tatlo lang ang puwedeng activities. Sa fishery, yung mussel production lang ang puwede tsaka honing ng fry... May regulasyon din yan based sa Fisheries Code. Dahil nagkakat na, sinasabi naman nila di nila iniisyuhan ng permit, pero sa context

ng SB quality of water, puwede yung tahungan... I-regulate lang in such a way na talagang mazonify yung use ng city water which is the mandate ng LGU," ani Tamoria.

"Yung fish cages, nagde-depend yung kinulong mong mga isda sa feeds. So impact agad yun sa quality ng tubig kaya nga di ina-allow yun sa isang area na SB ang category," paliwanag pa niya.

Samantala, patuloy ang panawagan ng mga maliliit na mangingisda at iba pang grupo sa tanggapan ng DENR na huwag nang ituloy ang demolisyon, na makakaapekto sa kanilang pangkabuhayan.

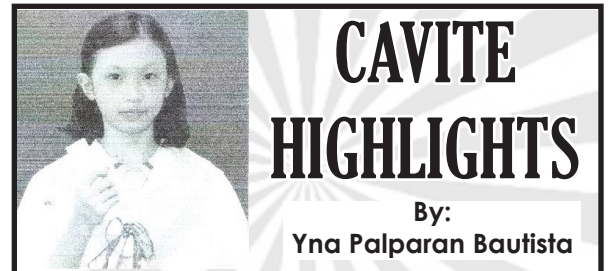
bulnerableng sektor pagdating sa pandemya," saad sa Facebook post ni Poblete.

## PH ranks 8th with the most COVID-19 Cases



The Philippines ranked eighth among countries with Covid-19 cases in the past 28 days. This is according to the global tracker of the Johns Hopkins University and Medicine (JHU)

based in Maryland.

As of September 19, 2021, the Philippines has 527,114 COVID-19 cases in the last 29 days with 2,366,749 total cases.

Other Asian countries like Malaysia at sev-

enth with 542,737 cases; Thailand at 10th with 432,620; Japan at 11th with 390,827; Vietnam 13th with 340,316 and Indonesia at 17th with 221,481 cases.


Other top six countries are the United States with 4,290,319 cases, followed by India with 1,023,929; the United Kingdom with 943,964; Iran with 768,165; Brazil with 673,838 and Turkey with 623,820 cases.

Ninth is Russia with 516,723, France at 12th with 354,853; Mexico 14th with 335,568; Germany at 15th with

274,070; Israel 16th with 234,908; Cuba 18th with 219,182; South Africa 19th with 200,124 and Spain at 29th with 159,093 cases. Globally, a total of 228,493,023 COVID-19 cases were recorded.

DOH Undersecretary, Maria Rosario Vergeire said that NCR remains in high-risk classification for COVID-19 cases though the trend is going down and rather slowly.

SM Malls in Laguna, San Pablo, Calamba and Santa Rosa joined the Commission on Elections' (Comelec's) synchronized registration to speed up application and accommodate more voter applications days before the September 30 registration deadline. Ms. Niña Wong, Public Relations Manager of SM City San Pablo on Thursday said that “the opening of these satellite Comelec Voter Registration (CVR) centers at the SM Supermalls will not only provide voters with more

registration venues, but will also give the public a safer, more convenient option in the midst of the new normal and the ongoing Covid 19 pandemic”.

To ensure health protocols are observed in satellite registration sites, Comelec will cater to at least 250 voter applicants a day in SM City San Pablo and more or less 600 slots with SM City Calamba and SM City Santa Rosa.
