

DENR CALABARZON conducts clean-up of water hyacinth in Angono River



DENR CALABARZON Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria leads the regional department in the conduct of a clean-up activity in Angono River.

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) CALABARZON and the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office

(PENRO) of Rizal conducted a river clean-up activity at Lakeside Eco-Park, Brgy. San Vicente, Angono, Rizal on September 17, 2021, in celebra-

tion of the International Coastal Clean-up (ICC) Day observed every third Sunday of September of each year. The theme of this year's celebration is

“Understand and Beat Marine Pollution”.

Led by DENR CALABARZON Regional Executive Director Nilo B. Tamoria, a total of 46 personnel from the regional and provincial department participated in the activity. Rizal PENRO Ramil R. Limpiada, PENRO Technical Services Division Chief Ernesto M. Diso, Jr., and Manila Bay Site Coordinating and Management Office (MB-SCMO) - Rizal Site Coordinator Marilyn B. Paunil also graced the event. The barangay government headed by Hon. Domingo P. Perez and the local River Rangers also joined.

The volunteers collected a total of 615 kg water hyacinth and 75 kg as-

sorted waste composed of straw, plastic cups, plastic bottles, plastic bag, diaper and styrofoam. The collected wastes were hauled by the Municipal garbage collectors for proper disposal.

MBSCMO - Rizal staff, Jenesis P. Erana said Angono River is one of the major river systems connected to Laguna Lake where water hyacinth are observed. Per recent assessment made by the DENR National Capital Region, the water hyacinth proliferating in Laguna Lake and its tributaries eventually float towards the Napindan Channel, Pasig River, and Manila Bay.

Early in August 2021, Environment Secretary

Roy A. Cimatu ordered the immediate removal and control of water hyacinth in Manila Bay area. “Part of phases of the operational plan (for the Manila Bay Rehabilitation Program) is to clean the baywalk from garbage. When garbage continue to flow, hindi talaga masasatisfy ang standard. We must prevent at all cost the entry of garbage to baywalk,” Cimatu said while referring to the recent garbage issues in Manila Bay, particularly, the flow of water hyacinth from Laguna and Rizal, and bamboo poles from illegal aquaculture structures in Cavite, towards the Bay.

DENR CALABARZON encourages the public to join the regional department in its advocacy to rehabilitate Manila Bay and the coastal areas of the region by regularly conducting clean-ups within and outside their respective homes and by exercising ecological solid waste management practices such as waste segregation-at-source, proper waste disposal, composting of biodegradable waste, and recycling.###

health experts, local government units (LGUs) and learners' families.

The pilot implementation, a combination of physical classes and distance learning, is applicable for the schools that passed the two departments' strict vetting process and have the support of their respective LGUs, Briones said.

DepEd Director for Planning Service Roger Masapol said the pilot implementation would be done among a maximum of 120 schools across the country, prioritizing Key Stage 1 learners (Kinder to Grade 3), after passing the School Readiness Assessment by DepEd and their local governments.

"Face-to-face classes, even in limited form, can mitigate the challenges of distance learning. It can address the needs of learners with no adult in the family qualified to perform the role of learning facilitator and ease the negative mental health and child development impact of the lack of face-to-face interaction and socialization among learners," Masapol said.

Briones noted that the guidelines implement the Prevent, Detect, Isolate, Treat, and Reintegrate framework highlighting the importance of the availability of water, sanitation and hygiene facilities, proper ventilation in

classrooms, ensuring that classroom layouts enable physical distancing between persons, prioritization of students who will benefit most from limited face-to-face learning modality, management of foot traffic and conduct of simulation activities before implementation of the pilot.

"DepEd also drafted a contingency plan with recommended actions for different scenarios. The scenarios range from where there is a suspected case presenting symptoms, to a scenario where there is a resurgence of Covid-19 cases in multiple barangays and this sets the policy on when schools should impose a lockdown," Briones said.

Meantime, Health Secretary Francisco Duque III said the department committed to providing additional protection for the teachers through vaccination.

"While vaccination is not mandatory, classroom learning will be limited to vaccinated teaching personnel. So as not to disenfranchise unvaccinated teachers, they may teach using distance or online modules. This also presents options for parents who are still hesitant to send their children to school," he added.

World Health Organization Representative to the Philippines Dr.

Rabindra Abeyasinghe lauded the Philippine government's decision to approve the pilot run of limited in-person schooling in low-risk areas and assured that it would continue to support the government in the pilot implementation of in-person classes.

"Deciding to open schools must be guided by risk-based approach, taking into consideration the epidemiology of Covid-19 transmission at the local level and the capacity of educational systems to adapt to operate safely," Abeyasinghe said. (PNA)

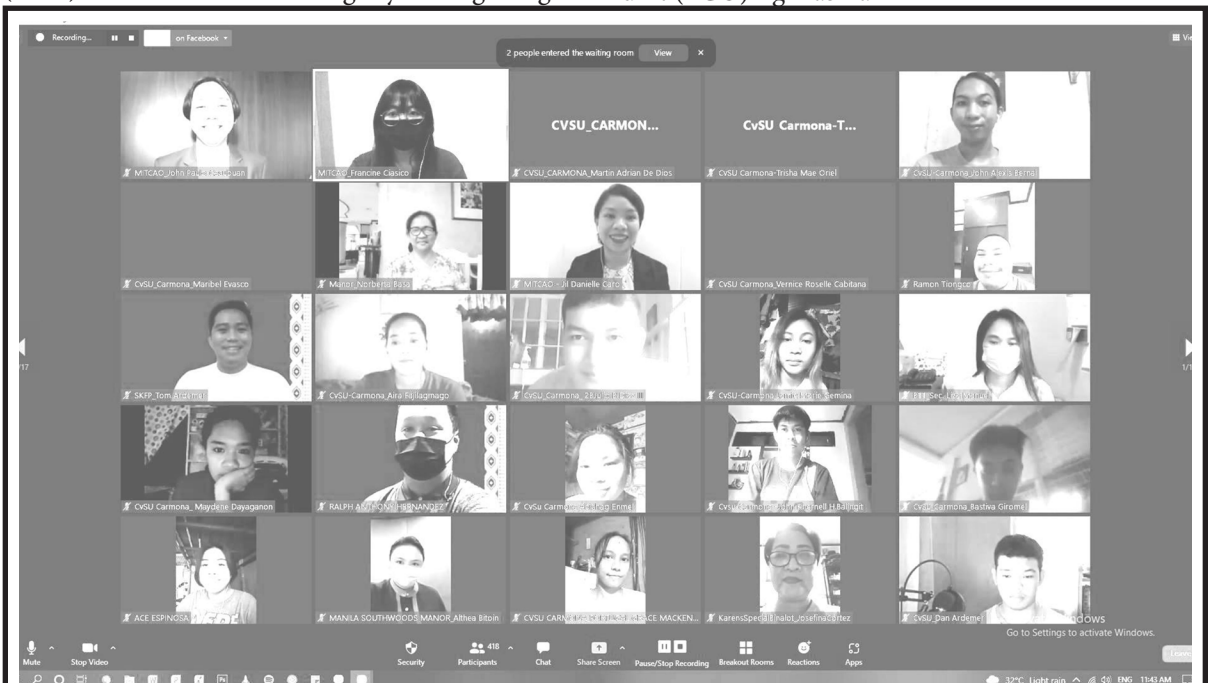

Julian Felipe was a revolutionist who did not carry a gun. He was once a Filipino musician in HongKong and Aguinaldo was so impressed with his work that he asked Julian to compose the music to be played during the Proclamation of Independence on June 12,1898. 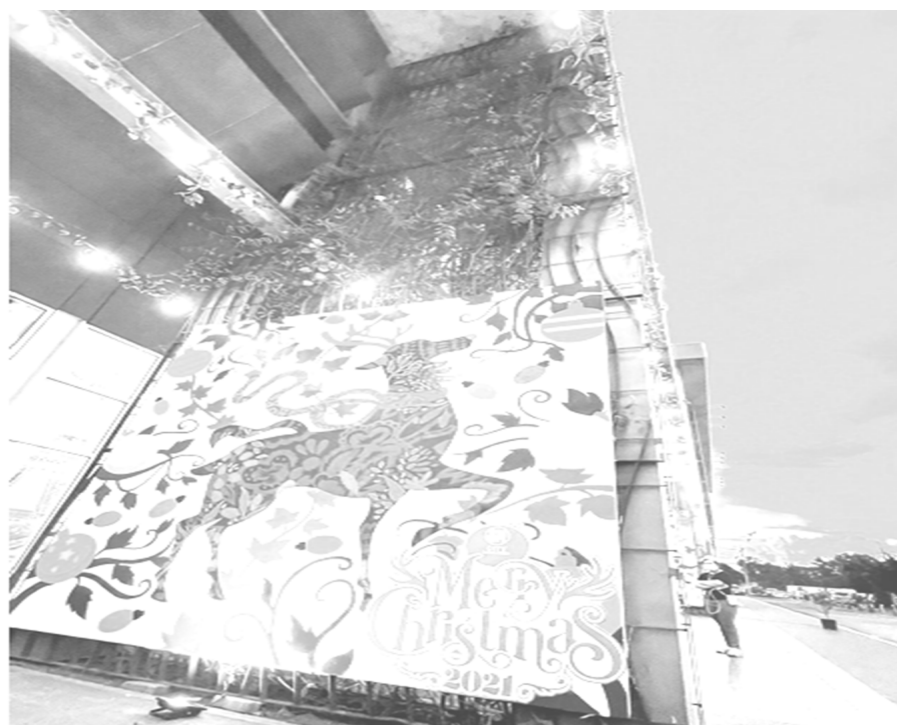

While the VCO mixed in the meals has helped to significantly reduce the symptoms of mild COVID-19 patients, the lagundi formulation study showed an insignificant difference to the recovery time of the study participants as compared to those who were not given with lagundi. Nevertheless, adjuvant therapies offer ways to ease mild symptoms of COVID-19

and build stronger immune responses but it is not the cure itself. Like vaccines, adjuvant therapies do not guarantee 100% protection from contracting the virus.

Three speakers were invited to discuss managing mild COVID-19 cases at home and the use of virgin coconut oil and lagundi as adjuvant therapies, namely: Dr. Alfonso R. Regala, Chief, Program Implementation and Outreach Division, Health Promotion Bureau, Department of Health; Dr. Imelda Angeles-Agdeppa, Director, DOST-Food and Nutrition Research Institute; and Dr. Cecilia C. Maramba-Lazarte, Director, Institute of Herbal Medicine, UP Manila – National Institute of Health. Dr. Regala discussed how isolation and quarantine works when managing mild COVID-19 cases at home as well as the importance of becoming agents of “tamangimpormasyon” by validating information through DOH website

and reporting fake news to them. Meanwhile, Dr. Agdeppa and Dr. Lazarte presented the results of their studies on mild COVID-19 cases, respectively. While the VCO mixed in the meals has helped to significantly reduce the symptoms of mild COVID-19 patients, the lagundi formulation study showed an insignificant difference to the recovery time of the study participants as compared to those who were not given with lagundi. Nevertheless, adjuvant therapies offer ways to ease mild symptoms of COVID-19

and build stronger immune responses but it is not the cure itself. Like vaccines, adjuvant therapies do not guarantee 100% protection from contracting the virus. D O S T - CALABARZON OIC-Regional Director Emelita P. Bagsit expressed her gratitude and hoped that they were more informed through the webinar, “Napakaimportante po nitodahil this will be our contribution bilang mga Pilipino namatulunganyungating whole nation or whole of government approach in addressing this pandemic.”
