DOH-CALABARZON RESUMES FACE-TO-FACE TRAININGS FOR HEALTH WORKERS ON MENTAL HEALTH



DOH-CALABARZON Regional Mental Health Outcome Manager Ms. Paulina V. Calo emphasizes the importance of providing the proper psychological first aid to distress patient during the two-day "Orientation on Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS) on COVID-19 Vaccination Program" for service providers held in San Mateo, Rizal.

With the downgrading of Covid-19 Alert to Level 3, the Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) on Tuesday started its face-to-face trainings for health workers particularly an "Orientation on Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS) on COVID-19 Vaccination Program" for service providers.

A total of three batches will be held this month from November 2-3, 4-5 and 8-9 with 98 participants expected to attend in scheduled.

According to Paulina V. Calo, Regional Mental Health Outcome

Manager, The two-day practicum is the continuance of the MHPSS training for health workers last year which was abruptly halted due to the pandemic.

Participants undergoes a practicum on how to properly conduct a psychological first aid as an 'interviewer' and as a 'patient' during the second day of the two-day "Orientation on Mental Health and Psychosocial Support

(MHPSS) on COVID-19 Vaccination Program" for service providers held in San Mateo, Rizal.

Psychological First Aid or PFA is given to an individual who is in distress and providing them a caring comforting presence by helping them feel safe and calm. It empowers the individual by supporting strengths

and providing existing coping skills.

"The PFA is a humane, supportive and flexible response to a fellow human being who is suffering during or after crises or emergencies including the current. COVID 19 pandemic,"

Calo emphasized.

She also assured that the training-workshop is being held with strict health protocols being observed including the wearing of face mask, social distancing and proper hygiene. (GLEN RAMOS)

CAVITE LGUS COMMENCE PEDIATRIC VACCINATION

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) — Several cities and municipalities in Cavite joined the rest of the country in simultaneously rolling out the vaccination program to minors aged 12-17 years old on Wednesday, November 3.


The expanded pediatric vaccination rollout came after the successful vaccination of minors in the National Capital Region on October 15, 2021.

In Noveleta town, children with comorbidities accompanied by their

parents lined up at the Primark Town Center vaccination center in Barangay Magdiwang to get the first dose of their Covid-19 vaccine.

Other municipalities which started their pediatric vaccination meanwhile, include Tanza which has inoculated 30 minors, Carmona with 30 minors, Noveleta with 60 minors, and Mendez-Nuñez town which has inoculated 457 adolescents.

Trece Martires City also rolled out its vaccination program for

Ang Department of Science and Technology (DOST) sa Calabarzon at ang Cavite State University (CvSU) ay nagtutulungan upang palakasin ang industriya ng kape sa rehiyon.

Sa isang taped report na ipinalabas noong Biyernes, sinabi ni DOST Secretary Fortunato de la Peña na ang dalawang organisasyon ay nagtatrabaho upang bumuo ng tissue culture growth chamber para sa mga seedlings ng kape.

Kasama ang National Coffee Research, Development, and Extension Center, bumuo sila ng tissue culture growth chamber

para makagawa ng mga seedling na walang sakit sa mas maikling panahon.

Aniya, "Through the growth chamber innovation, tissue-cultured embryos are subjected to a tightly controlled environment, thus decreasing the chance of plant contamination and mortality rate. With its promising appeal to the market, the technology is foreseen to open more opportunities for the government and private organizations to put up income-generating tissue culture laboratories."

with 34GB connectivity load per month, it said in a statement.

Earlier, the Alliance of Concerned Teachers demanded a PHP1,500 monthly internet allowance, saying the SIM cards provided by

the department were not enough to meet the connectivity requirement of distance learning.

The department said the 1GB per day for 30 days is enough to access e-learning and whitelisted or zero-rated DepEd applications based on

analytics consumption tests.

"It can also support eight hours of video conferencing," it added.

The DepEd has been requesting the Commission on Audit (COA) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) in 2020 for the possibility of granting internet allowance in cash, which will require almost PHP18 billion in public funds.

Under DepEd's current budget, there is no existing legal basis and fund cover for such "monthly internet or connectivity allowance."

COA Circular No. 2013-003 states all payments without legal basis will be disallowed in audit by the Commission.

"We will continue to work with involved agencies and stakeholders to ensure that our teachers are afforded with such support moving forward," the DepEd said. (PNA)

DENR 4A Forest Monitoring Officer's Body, found after a Drowning Incident in General Nakar, Quezon



Retrieval of the body of FMO Rigor Santos 2km away from Pagsangahan bridge in General Nakar, Quezon

After three days of continued search and rescue operations, the body of the missing DENR4A Forest Monitoring Officer Rigor Santos has been found 2km away from Pagsangahan Bridge, General Nakar at around

11 AM, October 30, 2021. Selected members of the Regional National Greening Program Validation Team along with 3 laborers and a staff from CENRO Real were conducting survey and mapping activities at the

proposed e-NGP site in Brgy, Mahabang Lalim, General Nakar Quezon when the drowning incident happened at 8:30 AM last October 28. While traversing the Kanan River, Santos was swept away by the raging water current.

Search and rescue operations were immediately conducted by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office of Infanta, Quezon on the same day of the incident while the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Committees of Barangays Minahan Norte, Minahan Sur, Maigang, Batangan,

Pisa, and Mahabang Lalim were alerted to monitor for possible sighting of Santos. The CENRO Real Quick Response Team was also dispatched in the area while the RNGP Coordinator contacted the Indigenous Peoples of General Nakar to conduct an independent search and rescue operation at the Banks of Agos

River. Four motorboats were deployed in Agos River for a parallel search operation of local residents. Aerial search was also conducted by CENRO Real while the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer Oliver Olivo closely coordinated with the military and local MDRRM for the continued operation.

At around 11AM on October 30, the body of Santos was found by Forest Protection Officer Ruben Bornolla, Forest Ranger Windel Adornado, and FPO Ronnie Odi floating 2km away from Pagsangahan Bridge. The body was immediately retrieved and transported to the town proper of General Nakar. The family of FMO Santos was informed regarding the incident while his brother

was accompanied by representatives from the DENR CALABARZON Regional and Field Offices to General Nakar. Rigor Santos is a 30-year-old native of Tanay, Rizal and a graduate of Bachelor of Agricultural Technology from the University of Rizal System. He is a Forest Monitoring Officer assigned at the Regional National Greening Program Coordinating Office

(RNGPCO) of DENR CALABARZON and has served the Department for almost 8 years. He has two children and is the current breadwinner of his family. The DENR CALABARZON has submitted a report to the DENR Undersecretary for Field Operations and Environment regarding the incident and continued assistance is currently being provided to the family.

Ang General Mariano Alvarez ay nagsagawa ng pagbabakuna sa University of Perpetual Health System-JONELTA nitong Nobyembre 4.

Pinangunahan ito nina Mayor Maricel Torres, Municipal Health Officer Dr. Eduardo Alcasid, MLGOO Reginaldo Revilla, at mga kapitan ng barangay sa kanilang bayan.

Nauna namang nagsimula ng pagbabakuna ang bayan ng Carmona noong Nobyembre 3, kung saan

umabot sa 60 kabataan ang nabakunahan ng Municipal Health Office, ayon kay Mayor Roy Loyola.

the pediatric population with 50 minors given with the first shot of the Pfizer Covid-19 vaccine.

The local governments of General Mariano Alvarez and General Emilio Aguinaldo also joined other towns in Cavite in commencing its inoculation program for minors.

According to Aguinaldo Rural Health Unit, children aged 12 - 14 years are included in the community-based immunization for the anti-measles, tetanus, diphtheria including the anti hpv/anti-cervical cancer for girls aged 14 years and will subsequently be scheduled for the Covid-19 vaccination after the said activities. The City Government

of Tagaytay announced it will begin vaccinating minors on Friday, November 5 while the pediatric vaccination in Imus will commence on Monday, November 8.

To prepare for the city's pediatric vaccination rollout to be held on Monday, November 8, the city government of Imus held a simulation exercise at the Ospital ng Imus supervised by Imus City Health Office Medical Office IV, Dr. Ferdinand Mina.

Pfizer-BionTech is one of the two vaccines with emergency use authorization for 12 to 17 years old issued by the Philippine Food and Drug Administration.

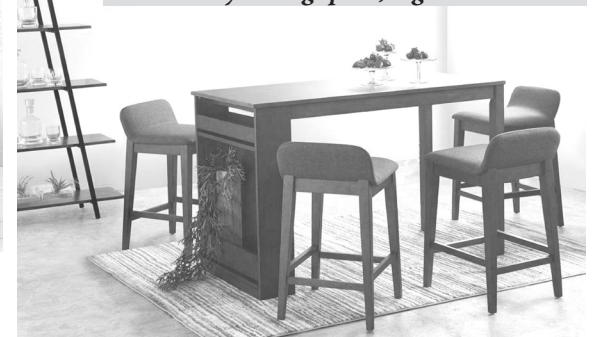

CAVITE HOSPITAL RECEIVES LAND AMBULANCE FROM DOH-CALABARZON

Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) turned-over one unit of land ambulance to General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital, a tertiary provincial hospital located in Trece Martires, Cavite.

The simple ceremony was held at the regional office in Project 4, Quezon City on October 27, 2021.

The new unit of land ambulance is part of the 2 units allocated by DOH-Health Facility Enhancement Program (HFEP) 2021 to the region to be distributed to selected public health facilities.

extinguisher, dashcam with memory card (front & back), digital clock, cellular phones (2 pcs), IV holder, air purifier, LED flashlight, USB connector (for driver’s cabin accessories), sharps container, garbage container and extra set of tools.

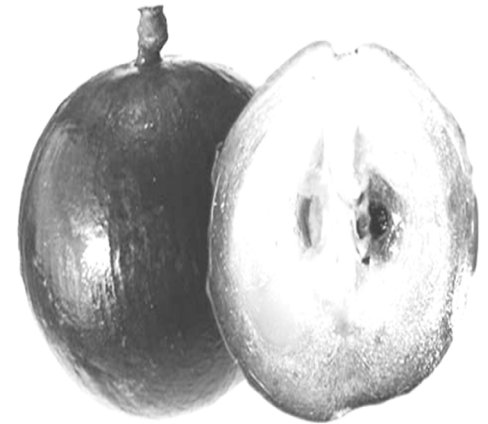

VACCINE WILLINGNESS IN PH CLIMBS TO 64% SWS POLL

More Filipinos are now willing to be vaccinated for COVID-19 eight months into the country's inoculation efforts, a Social Weather Stations survey has suggested.

The results made public on Friday showed 64% of 1,500 adult respondents said they would get the jab. That was up by nine points from the 55% in June this year.

"It is twice as high as the 32% in May 2021, when SWS first surveyed about it," the local pollster said.

Early into the country's inoculation drive, the government has had to wrestle with vaccine hesitancy in one of Southeast Asia's worst

coronavirus outbreaks.

Authorities have repeatedly reminded that vaccinations reduce the chances of severe to critical hospitalization. Incentives and more mobility were also allowed for those complete with their doses.

The non-commissioned findings were done between September 27 to September 30 and had a margin of error of ±2.5%.

Of the 64%, 25% said they already had their second dose, 10% with their initial shot, 23% saying they will sure get vaccinated, and 6% saying they probably will.

Still, the percentage of those uncertain was at 19% while 18% outrightly said they were unwilling.

SWS noted an increase in vaccine willingness across education accomplishments. It stayed the highest among college graduates at 84%, up by 12 points from 71%.

It was followed by those who finished junior high school, from 59% up by nine points to 68%.

The number among elementary graduates was higher by 10 points, or from 49% to 59%, while the same increase was seen among non-elementary graduates from 27% to now at 37%.

But the local pollster said, too: "Overall willingness to get vaccinated is the highest among non-elementary graduates, remaining at one-third of those

respondents."

Latest data showed there are now 28.71 million Filipinos fully vaccinated for COVID-19.

That translates to 37.23% of the government's goal of inoculating 77.13 million this year. Some 33.75 million or 43.76% have received a first dose.

Government touted an achievement into its efforts after health workers administered 1.11 million doses of the jabs in a single day on November 4.

This month, inoculation czar Carlito Galvez Jr. said they are targeting up to 1.5 million vaccinations per day in the hopes of a better holiday season in the country.
