SARA DUTERTE'S VP CANDIDACY: AN OPPORTUNITY TO WIDEN REACH OF SERVICE

Running for the Vice Presidential position, Davao City Mayor Sara Duterte says it is a path allowing her to heed her supporters' call to serve the country and make her a stronger person and public servant.

"I am here to answer your call. I appeal to all supporters to stay calm. Let us be circumspect and stay the course," she added.

After she filed her Certificate of Candidacy (COC) for reelection as Davao City Mayor on October 2, Duterte's supporters continued their call for her to run for higher office, specifically the presidency.

On November 9, Duterte withdrew her COC for the mayoral position and her younger brother, Vice Mayor Sebastian Duterte, took her place.

Her VP candidacy was then filed by a Lakas-CMD (Christian Muslim Democrats) representative on Saturday, quickly followed by the announcement of the Partido Federal ng Pilipinas that they are adopting Duterte as

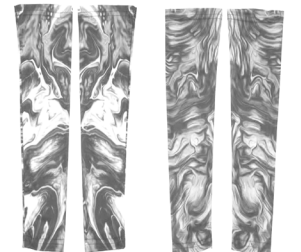

H e l m e t s . "Investing in a good helmet is always worth it," says Aldrin. "When choosing a helmet, always look for the Consumer Product Safety Committee (CPSC) sticker inside. This

ensures you'll be offered a high level of protection if you do end up in a crash."

- **Bike Lights.** It is important to see and be seen when you're out on the road, and Aldrin advises us to "choose a white bike light in front and red bike light for the back. High visibility (hi-viz) clothes or vest and straps can also help for you to be visible especially in low-light conditions or at night."

- **Repair Kits.** "Don't go out on a ride, whether short or long, without your tool kit," says Aldrin. "A good kit should include spare tube/s and/or patch kit, pump, tire levers and cycling multi-tool."

- **A Bike bag -** "It's a good idea to bring essentials like IDs, money, mask, face shield (if you will go to an indoor place, closed venue), food and water," says Aldrin. And find yourself a good bag for all your stuff.

Gen. Mariano Trias was the first Politico-Military Governor of Cavite during the Philippine Revolution. He was very much trusted by President Aguinaldo as he was made Vice President as a result of the Tejeros Convention and in the Biak-na-Bato Republic. He was Secretary of Finance and later Commander of Filipino Forces in Southern Luzon. He surrendered to the Americans after Aguinaldo was captured in Palanan. He was the founder of the Nationalista Party Chapter in Cavite. He died in 1914.

the running mate of its standard-bearer, Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr.

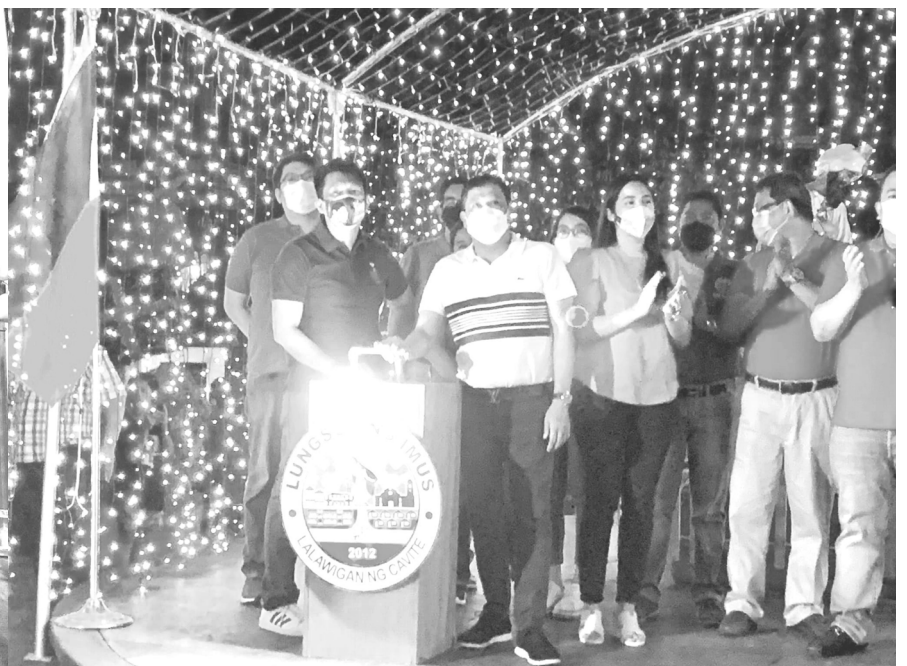
Regarding the issues confronting the ruling party, Duterte said she

Senior citizens are automatic members of PhilHealth



In line with the recent observance of the Filipino Elderly Week, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) have again reminded Filipinos 60 years old and above that they are mandatorily covered under the National Health Insurance Program pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 10645, and as reiterated under RA 11223 or the Universal Health Care Law of 2019.

Under Section 5 of RA 10645, all senior citizens shall be covered by PhilHealth. Their annual premium contributions shall be borne by the National Government from the proceeds of RA No. 10351 (Sin Tax Law), provided that they are not currently covered by any existing (membership) category of PhilHealth. Likewise, a senior citizen must not have a regular source of income to be granted this privilege under the law.

PhilHealth President and CEO Atty. Dante A. Gierran invited senior citizens to ensure that they are duly registered or are updated in their records with PhilHealth.

"We have partnered with the Office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) in the local government units so that elderly Filipinos can be registered with PhilHealth conveniently,"

adding that "qualified senior citizens should only submit two duly accomplished PhilHealth Member Registration Form (PMRF) to the OSCA where they reside and await notification if their Member Data Record is already sent by PhilHealth."

If a senior citizen opts to register at any PhilHealth Local Health Insurance Office, they must also present and submit a copy of their Senior Citizens' ID or any proof of age together with a 1x1 photo taken within the last six months, in addition to their filled-out PMRF.

As of June 2021, some 8.4 million Senior Citizen Members and 1.3 million Lifetime Members were registered with PhilHealth, with a combined qualified dependents of 3.3 million. From January to June 2021, PhilHealth has paid a total of P9.408 billion in benefits representing some 988,000 claims filed by elderly members nationwide.

Among the top medical conditions paid by PhilHealth were community-acquired pneumonia, hypertension, cerebral infarction or stroke, urinary tract infection, and congestive heart failure. ###

Ang kakawate o madre kakaw ay isang puno na karaniwan sa mga lugar sa Southern Tagalog Region. Ito ay kadalasang nakatanim bilang ornamental dahil sa bulaklak nito na kulay mapusyaw na rosas (pink). Ang bunga nito kahalintulad ng batakaw o pods na lumilikha ng tunog kung sakaling matutuyo sa araw.



Scientific name: *Gliricidia sepium* (Jacq.) Steud.; *Robinia sepium* Jacq.

Common name: Kakawate, Madre Kakaw (Tagalog); *Gliricidia*, Aaron's rod, St. Vincent's Plum (Ingles)

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Kakawate (Madre Kakaw)?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang kakawate ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang halamang kakawate ay mayroong formosin, formononetin, gliricidin-6a-gliricidol-9a, medicarpin (pterocarpan), 7,4'-dihydroxy-3'-methoxyisoflavin, 2'O-methylsepiol, tannin, at trihydroxyflavone.

Ang kahoy nito ay may taglay na stigmastanol glucoside at 3'4'-dihydroxy-trans-cinnamic acid octacosylester 2

Ang buong puno nito ay may tannin na mabisang panggamot sa maraming kondisyon.

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Ano ang mga sakit na maaaring magamot ng Kakawate (Madre Kakaw)?

1. **Dermatitis.** Ang katas dahon o kaya ay pinaglagaan nito kasama ng ugat at balat ng kahoy ng kakawate ay mabisang para sa mga kondisyon sa balat tulad ng dermatitis. Ipinanghuhugot lamang ang mga ito sa apektadong balat.

2. **Kagat ng mga insekto.** Mabisang pantaboy sa mga insekto ang pagpapahid ng dahon ng kakawate.

3. **Sugat.** Nakatutulong nang malaki sa mabilis na paghilom ng sugat ang dagta na nakukuha mula sa kahoy, ugat, at dahon ng kakawate.

4. **Galis.** Ang paggagalis sa balat ay maiibsan din ng pagpapahid ng katas mula sa dahon, kahoy at ugat ng kakawate. Maaari din gamitin bilang pampahid ang dinikdik na dahon ng kakawate na hinalo sa langis ng niyog.

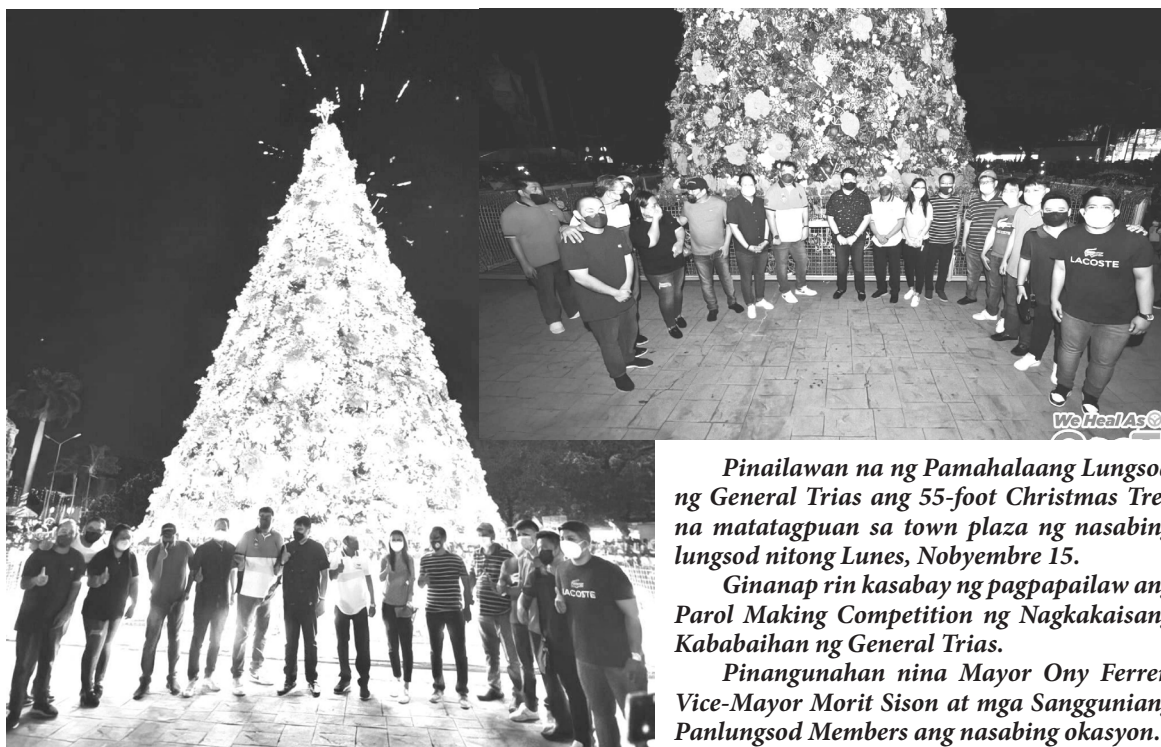
