Ayon sa Pangulo ng PHAPI - Quezon Chapter Dr. Juan Eugenio Villanueva, humingi sila ng pagpulong upang maresolba ang kanilang hiling na mabayaran ang kanilang mga pending hospital claim. Aniya, "Ano ang hakbang na gagawin ng PhilHealth para mabayaran ang hospital?"

Binigyang kasigu-

raduhan naman ni ARVP Granali na agarang ipo proseso ang mga aplikasyon ng mga pasilidad sa DCPM upang ito ay mai-release na sa lalong madaling panahon.

Nagbigay din ng suporta ang PHAPI-Quezon Chapter sa PRO IVA na patuloy silang maki-kipagtulungan sa PhilHealth para sa adbokasiya na makapag bigay ng serbisyong medikal.

Gayundin, nakipagpulong si PCEO Atty. Dante Gierran, COO Eli Dino D. Santos at ang PRO IVA officers kay Quezon Governor Danilo Suarez patungkol sa pagpapatupad ng DPCM. Pinasalamatan ni PCEO Atty. Gierran at ARVP Granali ang pamunuan ng Probinsya ng Quezon sa pagbabalik ng pondong hindi nag-ami nagkakahalaga ng Php 83 million na mula sa Interim Reimbursement Mechanism o IRM.

Mayroon 65 na pasilidad ang nag-avail ng DPCM 1 buong Region 4A at patuloy din ang

pakikipag-ugnayan ng PhilHealth Regional Office IVA Reachout team sa mga hospitals na may aplikasyon ng 20 pasilidad sa DCPM2.

Upang ma-avail ng isang Health Facility ang DPCM, kinakailangan makapasa sa mga sumusunod na panuntunan:

>Walang balanse sa Interim Reimbursement Fund

>May Covid-19 package claim na kahit isa

>Walang penalty o suspension sa loob ng applicable period

>Para sa mga Health Facility na naka-avail ng DPCM 1 and 2, maaari pa din silang mag avail kung atleast 20% ng nairerelease na halaga ng DPCM ay na reconcile na.

Naglabas ng memorandum ang Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) at Department of Health (DOH) na nagtatakda ng limitasyon sa pagbili ng paracetamol at iba pang mga gamot laban sa trangkaso bunsod ng mataas na demand nito sa gitna ng patuloy na pagdami ng bagong kaso ng COVID-19 sa bansa.

Sa memorandum circular no. 22-01, magkakaroon ng purchase cap para sa paracetamol, carbocisteine at iba pa upang maiwasan ang pagkakaroon ng kakulangan sa suplay at pagtaas ng presyo ng nasabing mga gamot.

Nakasaad sa nasabing memorandum na ang bawat indibidwal ay maaari lamang makabili ng 20 pirasong tableta ng Paracetamol habang 60 tableta naman ang

papayagan sa kada kabahayan.

Sa likidong gamot naman, ang isang indibidwal ay maaari lamang makabili ng limang bote, at 10 naman sa buong kabahayan.

Hindi rin papayagan ang pagbebenta ng mga gamot sa online platforms maliban na lamang kung mayroon itong permiso mula sa Food and Drug Administration.

Ang sinumang lalabag sa nasabing memorandum ay mahaharap sa kasong paglabag sa Price Act, at Consumer Act of the Philippines.

Kaugnay nito, nauna nang kinumpirma ni DTI Secretary Ramon Lopez na ang mga gamot gaya ng Biogesic at Decolgen ay pansamantalang 'out of stock' na sa ibang lugar dahil sa isyu sa delivery ng nasabing mga gamot. (GOCAVITE)

## PhilHealth vows to settle some P25.4-B of hospital claims

Philippine Health Insurance Corp. (PhilHealth) president Dante Gierran on Tuesday assured that the current in-process claims amounting to PHP25.45 billion would be paid within six months to private hospitals.

Gierran made the assurance during a virtual meeting of the House Committee on Health on the latest developments regarding the agency's reimbursements and payments to hospitals based on its various circulars related to Covid-19 benefits package claims.

He said the payment shall be made through the Debit-Credit Payment Method (DCPM), which was adopted by PhilHealth to facilitate the settlement of accounts payable to healthcare facilities during the state of public health emergency due to the Covid-19 pandemic to ensure the continuous delivery of healthcare services.

According to



PhilHealth, the DCPM will allow the speedy release of funds to qualified hospitals nationwide that have signified intention to avail of the new payment mechanism while PhilHealth processed their claims.

Gierran said as of Jan. 7, 2022, the agency has released PHP12.05 billion to 444 hospitals via the DCPM.

Meanwhile, Marikina City Rep. Stella Luz Quimbo questioned PhilHealth officials about the average turnaround time it takes to process Covid-19-related claims.

Quimbo said it is "unacceptable" that PhilHealth can only process 21 percent within

two years and that the agency lacks the complete data on the average number of days it takes to process unpaid claims.

Meanwhile, PHAPI president Dr. Jaime Almora said the planned "disengagement" of hospitals from PhilHealth over billions of pesos worth of unpaid claims means that private health care providers will no longer lend money to PhilHealth for the payment of medical expenses by the Filipinos.

Almora, however, said PHAPI was willing to assist PhilHealth members who will directly shoulder the expenses for the reimbursement of claims from the agency.



## PhilHealth Extends 2021 Accreditation of Healthcare Facilities

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) on Tuesday announced that it will extend the validity of all currently accredited health facilities (HFs) until January 31, 2022.

In its Advisory No. 2021-049 signed by its President and CEO Atty. Dante A. Gierran, the state agency made the extension provided that "... they (HFs) have submitted their complete applications for CY 2022 accreditation to the concerned PhilHealth Regional Office on or before January 31, 2022."

The PhilHealth Chief also reminded that applications received for continuous or renewal of accreditation beyond January 31, 2022 may result in a gap in a facility's accreditation.

Earlier in November 2021, PhilHealth released Advisory 2021-046 saying it has started accepting applications for continuous or renewal of accreditation until December 31, 2021. However, to give HFs ample time and to ensure continuous processing of their claims, the validity was further extended.

Continuous accreditation is provided under the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 10606 or the National Health Insurance Act of 2013. Accreditation is granted to health care providers that have applied through basic participation and complied with the requirements prescribed by PhilHealth, qualifying them to uninterrupted participation in the Program until their accreditation is withdrawn based on rules set by the Corporation. ###

## SPIA Development Consortium granted OPS for Cavite's Sangley Point International Airport Project



SPIA Development Consortium, a group led by local and international firms, has been granted the original proponent status (OPS) by the provincial government of Cavite for the redevelopment of Sangley Airport into an international gateway.

In October last year, the Cavite provincial government declared a second failed bidding after no bids were submitted for the airport project.

In a statement, SPIA Development said they submitted the unsolicited proposal in November 2021 to form a joint venture with Cavite for the Sangley Point International Airport project.

SPIA added that Cavite Governor Jonvic

Remulla issued the Certificate of Acceptance to the consortium on January 7, 2022.

"Acceptance of the unsolicited proposal is a clear sign of the Province's commitment to delivering this nationally significant and legacy project to the Filipino people. We are very glad and hopeful that this consortium made up of reputable domestic and well-known global development and investment companies will help us successfully complete the project," Remulla said.

The long-delayed Sangley Airport project is envisioned as a fully modernized, world-class, and green airport that is designed to meet an anticipated increase in demand for air transport

in the next 30 to 40 years.

The consortium also said that as soon as the project is awarded, they are prepared to transform SPIA into a premium international gateway that can serve as an alternative to the congested Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA).

After final planning, design, and financial closing, the work would immediately begin with the construction of a 4.6-kilometer connector road from the Kawit Interchange of Cavite that would lead to Sangley, with the time of completion estimated at two years, according to the consortium.

The SPIA Development Consortium Philippine

lead members are Cavite Holdings Inc. (CHI) - that was responsible for the development, design, and construction of the Manila-Cavite Expressway (Cavite) that was eventually acquired by Metro Pacific Investments Corp., and the Yuchengco Group of Companies (YGC), a conglomerate engaged in construction, infrastructure development, banking, insurance, and automotive services, among others.

Joining the local companies are global firms including South Korea's Samsung C&T Corp, Germany's Munich Airport International GmbH, and UK's Arup Group.
