The provincial government of Cavite celebrated the 2022 Women's Month carrying the six years recurring theme, "We make Change Work for Women" with its sub-theme "Agenda ng Kababaihan Tungo sa Kaunlaran" through the initiative of the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) and Cavite Gender Focal Point System (CGFPS) at Bulwagang Tanglaw – DepEd Trece Martires, Cavite on March 23, 2022 via blended setting (on-site and virtual).

Guests and participants were welcomed by Ms. Maria Fe M. Satsatin, OIC-HRMO and GAD Chairperson. She stated that the provincial government will continuously provide and implement initiatives promoting gender equality, women empowerment and other policies for the common good of employees.

The event focused on the sub-theme

"Capable of Victory with TEnacity: Babae Lumalaban, Umaangat sa Gitna ng Pagsubok" highlighting the success of three Caviteñas in their respective field amidst the challenges and celebrating the historical influence of women in the development of the province. The other guest was Dr. Vivian Espallardo, OB Gyne Department Head of Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital who talked about the programs and activities of OB Gyne Department including several community-based medical missions on



maternal health, both pre-natal and post-natal.

Last was Dr. Benjamina A. Pereyra, founder of One Life Foundation, Inc., a non-profit organization advocating for persons with disabilities (PWD) who founded the Happy Homes – a housing cooperative that builds intentional community for persons with special needs.

On the same day, a Gender Sensitivity Training was facilitated

by the Human Resource Management Office via Zoom platform with more than 200 PGC employees in attendance.

Meanwhile, last March 21, 2022, also part of the PGC's women's month celebration, PSWDO and Cavite GFPS in cooperation with the Provincial Health Office - Technical department conducted a health and wellness activity for the PGC employees. More than 60 employees availed the services

provided which include nutrition assessment and counseling, HPV and Tetanus Diphtheria immunization, dental check-ups, HIV screening

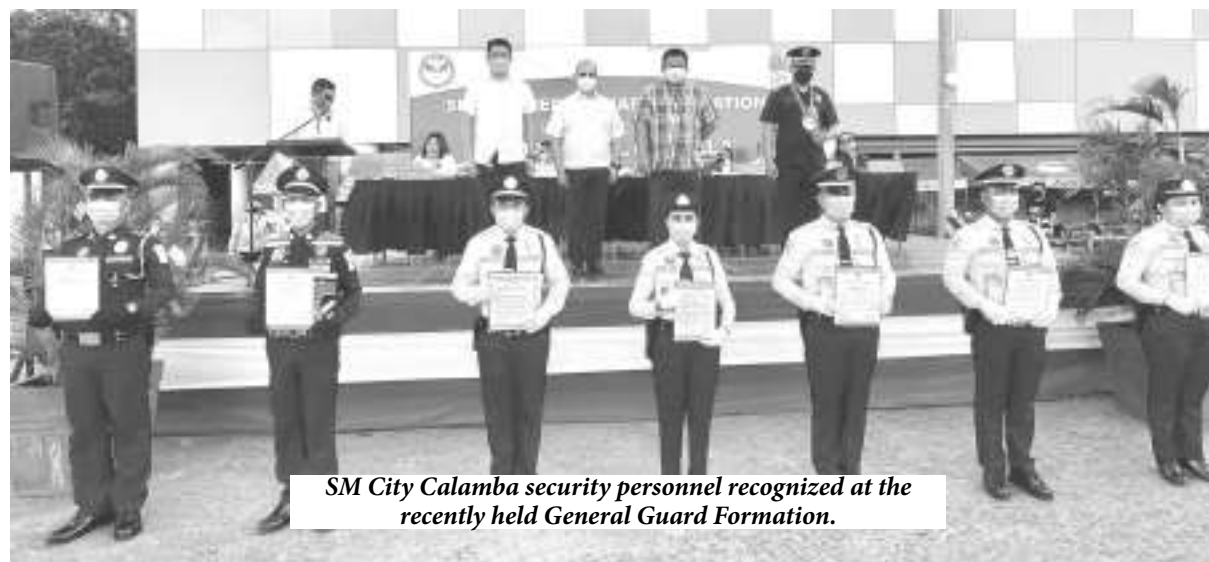

System (IDAS). The CRS IDAS is a platform that will be used in the verification of the identity of the client requesting civil registration certificates. With this platform, CRS can do an authentication method wherein the PhilSys Credentials of the client will transmit to the PhilSys Registry via a secured network connection to perform an automated and real-time matching process, and then the PhilSys Registry returning an immediate 'yes' or 'no' response.

first place in the CC/ICC category. Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya was declared the winner in the Municipality category, receiving 807 Safety Seals.

DILG-Manila City, on the other hand, took first place in the HUC category for DILG-issued Safety Seals with 557. DILG-San Carlos City, Pangasinan, led the CC/ICC category with 284 Safety Seals. 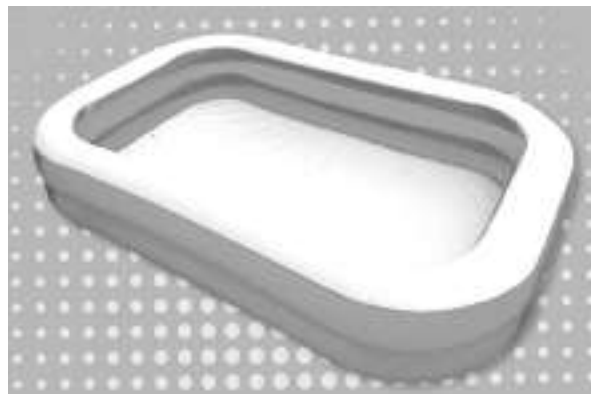

Lyn A. Fernandez, OIC- Office of the Chief Administrative/ Human Resource Manager Officer of DOST CALABARZON welcomed the auditors

and showed support to CWWTL Team during the opening meeting.

After the two-day assessment, it was concluded that the existing approved

signatories, namely Ms. Anna Marie S. Daigan and Ms. Joan Mae B. Acasio for Microbiological Testing and Ms. Verjo Angelie Maristela- Sisante for Chemical Testing are still recommended by the technical assessors. One (1) additional new applicant, Ms. Thea Marie Joyce M. Diloy is now recommended as new PAB-approved signatories for Chemical Testing.


DTI-Philippine Accreditation Bureau officially granted the CWWTL its continued accreditation conforming to the requirements of the latest version of PNS ISO/IEC 17025 last February 17, 2021. The said accreditation

is valid until July 15, 2023 both for Chemical Testing and Biological Testing. The CWWTL was first granted accreditation on July 15, 2008 making it the first provincial-based laboratory to gain an international standards recognition.

Currently, the CWWTL is a service laboratory equipped to perform conventional and rapid tests on water and wastewater. It has the capability to determine the physical, chemical, and microbiological properties and quality of water and wastewater or effluents. The tests procedures being used are in accordance with the international standard methods. It

is also a Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)-Recognized Environmental Laboratory, Department of Health (DOH)-


Accredited Water Testing Laboratory and a Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) Authorized to Operate a Chemical Laboratory.

The Cavite Water and Wastewater Testing Laboratory (CWWTL) of the Department of Science and Technology-CALABARZON (DOST-CALABARZON) maintains its continued accreditation based on the requirements of ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standards after the recently concluded Remote Second Surveillance Visit and Special Assessment conducted by the DTI-Philippine Accreditation Bureau's Laboratory Accreditation Division (DTI-PAB-LAD) last 23-24 March 2022.

The Philippine Accreditation Bureau (PAB), formerly the Philippine Accreditation Office, is the national accreditation body of the Philippines and the central body to accredit inspection, testing, and certifying bodies and other bodies offering

conformity assessment services in accordance with Executive Order 802.

Accreditation is the process in which an authoritative body formally recognizes the competence, impartiality, and capability of an organization to carry out specific activities, like certification, testing, calibration and inspection.

The assessment team was composed of Ms. Dinah Lyra Pantaleon as Team Leader, Ms. Leticia Pangilinan as Team Member, together with Ms. Evangeline Palomillo and Ms. Xienina Lim as Technical Assessors. In his message, Mr. Alvin S. Mojica shared how the provincial government worked in partnership with the City Government of Gen. Trias, the LRTA and other agencies in order to finally finish the project after resolving some issues that surrounded it. He said that the housing units and facilities will be turned over to the city government in the coming

weeks.
