Marcos converges meeting on right-sizing program

MANILA – President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. on Tuesday presided over a sectoral meeting on the updates of his administration's right-sizing program.

The Presidential Communications Office (PCO) did not give any details about the meeting but released photos of the

meeting to reporters.

Present during the sectoral meeting were Executive Secretary Lucas Bersamin, Special Assistant to the President Antonio Lagdameo, Press Secretary Cheloy Garafil, and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Undersecretary Wilford Will Wong and

Director John Aries Macaspac.

Presidential Legislative Liaison Office chief Secretary Mark Llandro Mendoza and Assistant Secretary Rose Virginie were also present during the sectoral meeting.

In his first State of the Nation Address

(SONA) in July last year, Marcos cited a National Government Rightsizing Program (NGRP) as among his administration's priority measures.

He described it as "a reform mechanism that seeks to enhance the government's institutional

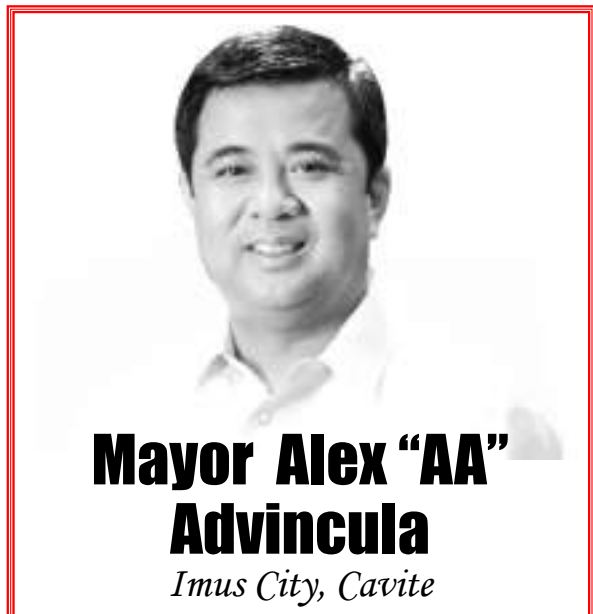

(PRU Life UK), Lead Resource Management Corp., Pasig Industries, Inc., Philippine Seven Corporation, Powerlane Resource Corp., Sanford Marketing Corporation (SM Savemore Market) - EPZA, Star World International Manpower & Placement Agency, Inc., and Synergy

MANILA - The Taguig City government formally opened its "Life of Christ" exhibit at the TLC Village in Barangay Lower Bicutan to give Taguiguëños a place to reflect this Lenten season.

The attraction is open from Holy Tuesday until Easter Sunday from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

In a statement, the city government said Taguiguëños can reflect on Jesus' passion, death, and resurrection on different corners of the park, which features The Stations of the Cross, Prayer Corner and



Prayer Boxes, and Art Installations.

The city government also said 14 panels, presenting events in Jesus Christ's last day, contained each an apt Bible verse, a reflection, and an activity or a question.

Those asking for spiritual blessing can do so in the Ask Jesus provision, where they can write down their prayer intentions, and light a candle in the Prayer Corner and Prayer Boxes.

A black interactive Cross installation art is also placed in the middle

of TLC Square, where visitors can write down their sins and bad habits on black paper and nail them individually on the cross.

During her visit to the park, Taguig Mayor Lani Cayetano hoped that regardless of religious affiliation, Taguiguëños would put focus on being grateful for the greatest sacrifice of Jesus Christ who saved the world from sins.

going through so many trials," she added.

Meanwhile, Senator Alan Peter Cayetano, meanwhile, asked Taguigueneños and the leaders of the city to remember two very simple commandments to have a more meaningful Holy Week:

"Love God with all our hearts, spirit, and mind above everything and everyone,... and love yourself and love others as you love yourself."

Meanwhile, Southern Police District (SPD) director Brig. Gen. Kirby John Kraft ordered the deployment

of 815 police officers during Holy Week to ensure the safety and security of the public.

The SPD covers the cities of Makati, Pasay, Taguig, Parañaque, Las Piñas and Muntinlupa as well as the municipality of Pateros.

It said the six cities and one municipality under SPD have a total of 82 places of worship, which will be secured by 323 police officers while another 46 police officers will man one-stop-shop help desks in strategic areas.

Kraft said a total of 141 police officers

will secure major thoroughfares, while 110 are assigned to transportation hubs.

The 46 commercial areas in the southern metropolis will be secured by 109 police personnel while the number does not include the 86 cops in malls and other places of convergence.

"The SPD will conduct a big preparation for the Holy Week and our personnel are ready to respond to any situation that needs immediate action," Kraft said in a separate statement. (PNA)

capacity to perform its mandate and to provide better services, while ensuring optimal and efficient use of resources."

"Compared to previous government reorganization efforts, the NGRP will entail a comprehensive strategic review of the functions, operations, organization, systems and processes of the different agencies, and massive and transformational initiatives in agencies concerned, such as mergers, consolidation, splitting, transfer and even the abolition of some offices," he said.

"The rightsizing efforts will also involve the conduct of a comprehensive strategic

review of functions, programs and projects that will cut across various agencies," he added.

On March 14, the House of Representatives passed a bill that would allow Marcos to right-size the government bureaucracy.

House Bill No. 7240 or the proposed Act Rightsizing the National Government, was passed with 292 votes, three against and zero abstentions.

Rightsizing is defined under the bill as "the process of analyzing and designing the appropriate roles, mandates, structures, functions, sizes, systems, as well as processes of government agencies to ensure

effective, responsive and efficient service delivery."

The measure authorizes the President to right-size the executive branch to eliminate redundant, duplicate and overlapping functions.

To oversee the implementation of the program, the Committee on Rightsizing the Executive Branch shall be established.

Since assuming office in June last year, Marcos has already abolished a number of government agencies through executive orders in line with rightsizing, namely the Presidential Anti-Corruption Commission, and Office of the Cabinet Secretary, among others. (PNA)

Health Benefits...

Kaalaman tungkol sa Okra bilang halamang gamot

Ang okra ay isang kilalang gulay na ipinangsasangkap sa ilang mga lutuin. Ang bunga nito na siyang ginagamit na panggulay ay pahaba, patulis at puno ng bilog-bilog na mga buto at may malapot at madulas na katas. Ang halamang ito ay may katamtamang taas, may bulaklak na madilaw at karaniwang itininatanim sa mga taniman para sa bunga na ginugulay.

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Okra?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang okra ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyong sa kalusugan:

Ang bunga ng okra ay mayroong pectin, mucilage, fat, tubig, at ash. Mayroon pa protina, lipid, carbohydrate, dietary fiber, sugars, sucrose, glucose, fructose at starch. May mineral din ito na calcium, iron, magnesium, phosphorus, potassium, sodium, zinc, copper, manganese, selenium.

Ang bunga ay may taglay din na bitamina gaya ng vitamin C, thiamin, riboflavin, niacin, pantothenic acid, folate, choline, ß-carotene, vitamin A, vitamin E, at vitamin K.

Ang mga buto ay makukuhanan naman ng palmitic acid, stearic acid, arachidic acid, oleic acid, at linolic acid. May taglay din ito na vitamin C.

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:

Ugat. Ang ugat ay karaniwang inilalaga upang mainom o ipang hugas sa ilang kondisyon sa katawan. Maaari ding itong dikdikin at ipantapal sa ilang mga kondisyon sa katawan.

Dahon. Ang dahon ay inilalaga at iniinom na parang tsaa. Dinidikdik nin ang dahon at ipinangtatapal.

Bunga. Karaniwang ginagamit bilang gamot ang bunga ng okra. Maaari itong ilaga at ipainom sa may sakit. Ang malapot na katas ng bunga ay mabisa rin para sa ilang mga kondisyon sa katawan.

Buto. Karaniwang dinidikdik naman ang mga buto at inihahalo sa gatas upang ipampahid.

Ano ang mga sakit at kondisyon na maaaring magamot ng Okra?

1. **Sore throat.** Ginagamit para sa kondisyon ng sore throat ang malapot na katas ng bunga ng okra. Makatutulong ito na mabawasan ang pananakit.

2. **Syphilis.** Ang impeksyon naman ng bacteria sa ari ay maaaring hugasan gamit ang tubig na pinagbabaran ng ugat ng okra.

3. **Sugat.** Matutulungan naman na mapabilis ang paghilom ng sugat sa pamamagitan ng pagtatapal ng dinidik na ugat at dahon.

4. **Lagnat.** Ang murang bunga ng okra ay makatutulong naman sa pagpapababa ng mataas na lagnat. Ito'y pinapakain sa may sakit. Maaari namang inumin ang pinaglagaan ng ugat para sa kaparehong epekto.

5. **Varicose vein.** Ang mga nakalitaw na ugat ay matutulungang maalis ng pag-inom sa pinaglagaan ng ugat ng okra.

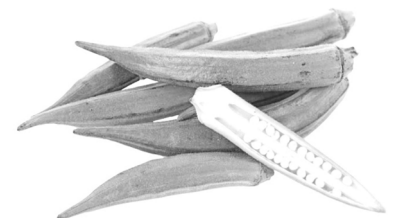
6. **Pulmonya.** Mabisa naman para sa sakit na pulmonya ang pinaglagaan ng dahon at bulaklak ng okra.

7. **Pagsusugat sa balat.** Ang kondisyon naman ng pagsusugat sa balat ay matutulungan din ng pagpapahid ng dinidik na buto ng okra na inihalo sa gatas sa apektadong balat.

8. **Pagtatae.** Para naman sa kondisyon ng pagtatae, inihahalo ang malapot na katas ng bunga sa inuming tubig.

9. **Hirap sa pag-ih.** Iniinom din ang pinaglagaan ng bunga ng okra upang bumuti ang pag-ih.

10. **Rayuma.** Ginagamit ang para sa kondisyon ng rayuma pinaglagaan ng ugat ng okra. Ito'y maaaring inumin.

She explained that the Regional Development Council (RDC) has identified women-related issues in the region such as the high prevalence of new HIV cases ranking second nationwide, next to the National Capital Region (NCR); increasing number of Adolescent (age ranging from 10-19) pregnancy; persisting cases of violence against women and children including distressed women overseas workers; as well as the continuing existence of pockets of poverty not only in the region but country-wide.

More so, the ARD said that the RDC has recently approved Regional Development Plan, which identified strategies to address these issues.

"Some of the strategies that

we have included are research and development, education, education particularly for women, the health literacy, and strict implementation of laws protecting women," she mentioned.

Laguna District 2 Representative Ruth Mariano-Hernandez, Dr. Patricia Sanchez of UP Los Banos, Ms. Leonie Reyes of Natures Dew Enterprise, and Dr. Eden C. Callo of Laguna State Polytechnic University (LSPU) shared their personal experiences in achieving Gender Equality and Inclusive Society in their respective fields.

In her closing message, Regional Gender and Development Council (RGADC) Co-Chairperson Josephine Parilla from the Pambansang Tagapag-ugnay ng mga Manggagawa sa Bahay-Workers in the Informal Sector Enterprise (PATAMABA-WISE), said the Council and its stakeholders will

serve as the light, voice and advocate for the protection of women.

"Hindi man tayo mananalo sa lahat ng laban, dahil minsan o kadalasan ang mundo ay hindi pumapabor, but it does not matter because we fight them all!" she remarked.

The DOST-CALABARZON and all the members of the RDC CALABARZON are united to promote and advocate for women empowerment and inclusion in every sector not only in the region, but in the whole country.

SMC expressways ready for Holy Week exodus

San Miguel Corporation's infrastructure unit said it has made all necessary preparations in anticipation of heavy traffic volume this week at all its expressways, namely the South Luzon Expressway, (SLEX), Southern Tagalog Arterial Road (STAR), the Skyway System, NAIA Expressway, and the Tarlac-Pangasinan-La Union Expressway (TPLEX), as Filipinos head out to the provinces for the traditional observance of Holy Week.

Starting Monday, April, 3, SMC Infrastructure increased its manpower deployment at all its tollways, to meet the expected holiday exodus, and help ensure more efficient and safe travels for motorists.

Mobile patrol units have been deployed at strategic locations, while more ambulant tellers will be positioned at major toll plazas to assist toll collection personnel, to speed up the flow of vehicles heading out of Metro Manila to northern and southern provinces.

"Our operations

teams are prepared for the rush of our kababayans leaving Metro Manila to spend the upcoming holidays with their loved ones in the provinces. We've made the necessary adjustments in our manpower deployment to ensure that traffic will flow smoothly along our carriageways and speed up the scanning of Autosweep tags and cards at exits," said SMC President and CEO Ramon S. Ang said.

"We encourage our motorists to make sure their Autosweep RFID accounts have sufficient load and to have their Autosweep cards ready in their vehicles, to avoid any delays. Our ambulant tellers are also equipped to scan cards for faster transactions, in case there is heavy build-up at the exits," Ang added.

Ang said the company has suspended all roadworks and activities that might disrupt the flow of traffic at expressways, starting 12:00 PM of April 3 until 10:00 PM of April 10. He said that SMC Infrastructure has also coordinated with authorities such as the

Police and the various local government units, on the implementation of traffic management plans.

"To our motorists, we ask for your patience and understanding, as we all try to get to our destinations safely this Holy Week. Kindly anticipate heavy traffic and plan your trips well. Also, please make sure your vehicles are in good condition and are road-worthy, as common problems we see at expressways--blown out tires and overheating engines--can also cause a significant amount of delay and inconvenience to other motorists," Ang said.

He asked motorists to always keep safety in mind when on the road. Apart from wearing seatbelts and maintaining a safe breaking distance, motorists are reminded to also adhere to speed limits along expressways.

SMC's at-grade expressways have a maximum speed limit of 100 kph for Class 1 vehicles, and 80 kph for Classes 2 and 3 vehicles. Skyway Stage 3 and the NAIA Expressway have a

maximum speed limit of 60 kph, for safety reasons.

In December last year, SMC Infrastructure implemented the Seamless Southern Tollways program which reduced the number of toll stops for motorists passing the South Luzon Expressway and STAR Tollway.

The program has since proven successful at minimizing traffic buildup along the expressways as motorists no longer needed to stop at the Calamba Main Toll Plaza and SLEX Greenfield.

"Before the Seamless program, traffic buildup at Calamba usually stretched five to seven kilometers. Now, it is gone," Ang explained. We have no more traffic build-up at Calamba and SLEX Greenfield, and our existing toll plazas there are being dismantled."

"We are grateful to our LGU partners who have been supportive of the Seamless Southern Tollways program. We continue to collaborate closely so that we can jointly manage the traffic flow in the exits," Ang added. (SMC Media Affairs)
