Cayetano sa kabataan: Kayo ay mahalaga

Sa pagbubukas nitong Sabado ng Taguig Sports League ngayong taon, pinangakuan ni Senador Alan Peter Cayetano ang kabataan ang Taguigeño na hindi pababayaang ng Taguig ang kanilang mga pangangailangan para sa isang mahaba at malusog na buhay.

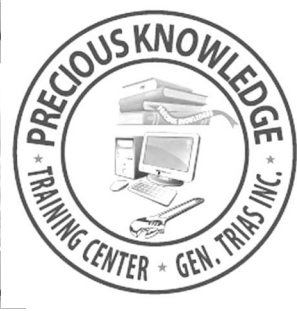

Metro Pacific Tollways Corp. (MPTC), the leading mobility infrastructure and solutions provider in the Philippines, joins the country in celebrating the road safety month with 'Mission: Road Safety'. MPTC is undertaking this initiative to reinforce its expressways' road safety mission based on the 3 pillars of safety – safe self, safe vehicle, and safe roads.

"Mission: Road Safety" institutionalizes road safety awareness seminars and digital information campaigns to educate the general and motoring public, ensuring their safe journey along MPTC expressways in Luzon and Visayas— NLEX, SCTEX, NLEX Connector, CALAX, CAVITEX, CAVITEX C5 Link, and CCLEX (Cebu-Cordova Link Expressway).

The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) cited that an average of 345 daily fatalities is caused by transport accidents in the Philippines.

"Road safety is at the core of Metro Pacific Tollways' business. We have advanced protocols in place to avoid untoward incidents, we have responsive on-ground and 24/7 hotline personnel to ensure that our motorists are well attended to, expressways that are built for safety, and employees who have passion for innovation to explore more ways to better serve our stakeholders," MPTC President and CEO Rodrigo Franco explained how safety remains the top tier in the list of priorities of the group.

Empowered motorists and commuting public

MPTC units NLEX Corp and Metro Pacific Tollways South (MPT South) have already established their efforts in the road safety awareness scene, through respective flagship programs Biyahero Road Safety Caravan and Drayberks Drive Road



Safety Seminars. These programs intensified education on proper expressway driving, traffic rules and regulations, importance of vehicle road worthiness, and preparation of the driver (self) and their passengers.

Cebu Cordova Link Expressway Corporation (CCLEC)'s advocacy program dubbed Is-torya Ta Bai! cultivates safe driving habits and orients motorists on key safety features of Cebu's iconic toll bridge CCLEX.

'Per stakeholder' approach

To further strengthen its efforts, business units target various stakeholders that they can tap to amplify MPTC's safety mission.

NLEX Usapang Driver is a forum aimed at educating drivers from bus and trucking companies on safe expressway driving. To date, over seven bus and 13 trucking companies have participated in this program. The unit also has Kaligtasansa Daan (KalSaDa) road safety education program targeted for its community partners and neighboring barangays.

Last November 2022, NLEX and Paramount Consumer Prod-

ucts launched the 'Nickelodeon Safety First with PAW Patrol' campaign showcasing messages of safety for children. The safety messages can be seen on toll plaza banners and billboards along NLEX's extensive road network until June 2023.

MPT South's Bayaning Kalsada (BayaniKa) is a program that teaches kids about road signs and familiarize them with road safety measures, particularly on expressways. Since its inception in 2022, over 800 school children from host communities have benefitted from it.

Safety is practiced year round. During peak travel seasons and holidays, MPTC units from North to South intensify their operations under the 'Safe Trip Mo Sagot Ko' initiative. In anticipation of increased traffic volume, over 1,200 patrol crews, traffic marshals, and security teams are deployed to ensure effective traffic management along its expressways. Emergency medical services and incident response teams are also fielded at strategic areas.

Safe road for all
These efforts are all in line with the United Nations General Assem-

bly adopted resolution "Improving global road safety" with the ambitious target of preventing at least 50% of road traffic deaths and injuries by 2030.

MPTC echoes UN's thrust in its corporate Sustainability Strategic Goals by continuously improving its services and providing top notch customer experience to its stakeholders. Aside from its tollways, MPTC created the MPT DriveHub app that brings expressway services to the hands of the customer to bring about a more satisfactory travel experience. SSS runs after contribution evaders in simultaneous nationwide campaign



The Social Security System (SSS) today conducts simultaneous Run After Contribution Evaders (RACE) operations in 108 selected areas around the country to call on non-compliant employers to settle their contributions delinquencies.

SSS President and Chief Executive Officer Rolando Ledesma Macasaet said that the synchronous RACE activities across the country affirm SSS' commitment in ensuring the social security protection of its 31.96 million employee-members.

"We will be issuing notices to business employers around the country who neglect their legal obligations of paying their employer and employees' share in the contributions because it deprives them of the social security benefits they truly deserve," Macasaet said.

After receiving the Show Cause Orders, he said SSS gives delinquent employers 15 days to coordinate with their respective servicing SSS Branch Office and settle their contribution delinquencies.

Macasaet reminded all employers that Republic Act No. 11199 or the Social Security (SS) Act of 2018 requires them to report for coverage to the SSS all their employees and/or kasambahays within 30 days from their actual employment date and remit the corresponding monthly contributions of their workers.

On the other hand, household employers

shall shoulder the SS contributions of kasambahays who are earning P5,000 or less.

Under the SS Act, employers who fail to register their employees or have not deducted and remitted their contributions will be penalized with a fine of P5,000 to P20,000 and face imprisonment ranging from six (6) years and one (1) day to 12 years.

"We appeal to all employers to be considerate to their employees by reporting them to SSS and

regularly remitting their monthly contributions so they can be protected by receiving social security benefits in times of various contingencies," Macasaet said.

He urged them to settle their delinquencies by availing of the contribution penalty condonation programs offered by SSS that will allow them to pay the unremitted contributions less the accrued penalties.

Delinquent business employers can apply for the Contribution Pen-

alty Condonation, Delinquency Management and Restructuring Program (CPCoDe MRP) while Household Employers can avail of the Contribution Penalty Condonation and Restructuring Program (CPCR-P).

SSS conducted its first RACE operations in 2017 when it visited delinquent employers in Greenhills, San Juan, and Cubao, Quezon City. The following year, SSS brought the RACE campaign to the regional level. ###

LONGEST SEA-CROSSING BRIDGE PROJECT IN NORTHERN MINDANAO NOW AT 69 PERCENT STATUS

The Department of Public Works and Highways Project (DPWH) in Northern Mindanao the 3.17-kilometer Panguil Bay Bridge is ongoing in full gear.

At an overall accomplishment rate of 69 percent, the 7.37 Billion bridge project was inspected recently by Senior Undersecretary Emil K. Sadain, in-charge of DPWH infrastructure flagship projects under "Build, Better, More" program of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.

He was joined in the field inspection by DPWH Unified Project Management Office-Roads Management Cluster 2 (UPMO-RMC 2) Project Director Sharif Madsmo H. Hasim; Stakeholders Relations Service Director Randy R. Del Rosario; Project Managers Teresita V. Bauzon and Marlon V. Galerio; and District Engineer Maria B. David.

In his report to DPWH Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan, Senior Undersecretary Sadain said that weather permitting, the inter-island bridge project is target to attain 90 percent



completion by December 2023, reach 95 percent by March 2024, and to open to vehicular by June 2024.

By reducing down the travel time to 7 minutes the 2 to 2.5 hours land travel between Tangub City, Misamis Occidental and Tubod, Lanao Del Norte, the bridge is expected to bring many benefits to the local economy and conveniences for businesses and the general public in Northern Mindanao.

We are particularly excited about the upcoming completion of the Panguil Bay Bridge Project, which we believe marks a significant milestone for the whole Mindanao, added Senior Undersecretary Sadain.

This valuable infrastructure project will greatly enhance economic growth as it will serve as a vital gateway that connects and further strengthens the region's infrastructure, providing seamless transportation of goods and services.

Although the design and build activities for the Panguil Bay Bridge Project were

slowed down by the corona virus pandemic in 2020 and 2021, this remarkable infrastructure project has started to recover in 2022 and early 2023 anchored on the catch-up plan and construction improvement measures.

Construction blitz started after the full completion of all the 54 bored piling works to allow the start of construction of the 36 abutment and pier column, 32 coping, and commence on both ends at Tubod and Tangub City the incremental launching method (ILM) for the superstructure.

Funded by a loan agreement between the Government of the Philippines and the Government of South Korea through its Economic Development Cooperation

Fund, the construction work is under joint venture contractor Namkwang-Kukdong-Gumwang with Yooshin Eng'g Corp. in JV with Pyunghwa Eng'g & KyongHo Eng'g & Architects as project consultant.

The bridge project itself is impressive in its own right as the main and approach bridges will feature cast-in-place pile foundations and will be built using free cantilever and incremental launching methods respectively.

The main bridge will be 320-meter long with parallel high strength HDPE-coated multi-strands stay cable, while the length of the two approach bridge sections and approach roads will be 1.38-kilometer and 1.47-kilometer, respectively. (DpwhpioPhoto/Renante Arjay Jarobel)
