

On Wednesday, May 15, MPT South kicked off the Alerto KadaKilometro the Tas TransCorporation in Las Pinas, Metro Manila, where more than 50 bus drivers who regularly traverse Manila-Cavite the Expressway (CAVITEX) invited were participate. Additionally, in partnership with Cavite State University (CVSU), drivers were refreshed on BLOWBAGETS, a vehicle maintenance checklist before hitting the road.

"Staying alert means always keeping your eyes peeled, being watchful for any potential dangers, and responding quickly to any shifts in traffic situations," emphasized Mr. Raoul Ignacio, President and General Manager of MPT South.

"This marks just the kick-off event of Alerto KadaKilometro campaign which will run throughout the year. At MPT South, we are not just in the business of toll roads but also committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all motorists who travel on CAVITEX and CALAX. 



The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) recently held an event to mark the 5th year anniversary of the Sagip Department's Manila Bay Program" with theme: "Sustaining Progress: Five Years Commitment Manila Rehabilitating Bay".

Representing DPWH Secretary Manuel M. Bonoan and Undersecretary Roberto R. Bernardo, chairperson of DPWH Manila Bay Special Task Force, were Assistant Secretary Nerie D. Bueno and Regional Office 4A Director Jovel G. Mendoza who led the anniversary celebration, held through a short program and a desilting operation along a tributary of Manila Bay in Bacoor, Cavite.

The event held at Brgy. Mabolo I, Bacoor City was also attended by Bacoor City Mayor Strike Revilla, DPWH National Capital Region Director Loreta Malaluan, Legal Service Director Gliricidia Tumaliuan-Ali, and Bureau of Equipment Director Toribio Noel Ilao, as well as representatives from Department of

Environment and Natural Resources Regional Office 4A, and Department of Interior and Local Government Regional Office 4A.

Since the launching of the DPWH Sagip Manila Bay Program in 2019, thousands of projects were undertaken by the Department in various areas including water management, solid waste management, social preparation and relocation, as well as habitat and ecosystem management.

To improve Manila Bay's water quality, the DPWH Bureau of Equipment, Unified Project Management Office - Flood Control Management Cluster, Regional Offices in NCR, 3, and 4A managed to dredge a total of 26.53 million cubic meters of silt and sediments along Manila Bay and its tributary waterways in Metro Manila, Central Luzon, and Calabarzon in five (5) years.

Another major a c c o m p l i s h m e n t covers solid waste management which include construction of 363 sanitation facilities, installation of 43 material

recovery facilities, conduct of coastal cleanup activates, and regular declogging of drainage structures in concerned regions.

New pumping stations and booster pumps were likewise installed along flood-
