

Mekeni Joins Hospital on Wheels Medical Mission for over 1,000 Porac Residents



PORAC, Pampanga (December 12-13, 2025) — Mekeni Food Corporation reinforced its commitment to community health and inclusive development

as it actively supported the Hospital on Wheels (HOW) medical mission that served more than 1,000 patients at the Jose Songco Lapid Gymnasium in Barangay Cangat-

ba, Porac, Pampanga.

The two-day mission delivered free medical, surgical, dental, and vision screening services to residents, with a strong focus on reaching in-

“For 18 years, Hospital on Wheels has advocated accessible healthcare. We are deep-



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ly grateful to Mekeni Food Corporation, the local government of Porac, and all our partners who shared their time, resources, and expertise to make this mission successful,” Sanchez said.

Porac Municipal Vice Mayor Trisha “Jen” Capil welcomed the initiative, noting its alignment with the municipality’s priorities.

“This medical mission is a big help to our community, especially our indigenous peoples. We thank the Hospital on Wheels, Mekeni, and all the partners for bringing this service to Porac, as it supports our administration’s goal of inclusive and accessible healthcare,” Capil said.

Aside from the medical, surgical, dental, and optical services, the mission also brought moments of care and comfort to beneficiaries through the distribution

of gift packs for IPs and children who attended the activity.

Hospital on Wheels has been conducting medical missions nationwide for 18 years, while Mekeni Food Corporation has supported the initiative for three consecutive years, demonstrating the company’s sustained commitment to health-focused community partnerships.

Bago matapos ang taong ito, muling nakapaghatid ng tulong ang Pamahalaang Lungsod ng Imus, sa pangunguna ni Mayor Alex Advincula, para sa mga Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) sa isinagawang PWD Assistance Payout. Sailing forward



Joel Lumangcas, a skilled boat operator, expertly navigates his boat across the crystal-clear waters of Bohol.

Bound to the sea for most of his life, Joel Lumangcas from Panglao Island, Bohol, moves with the waves. From a young age, he had already helped

his father with fishing, a livelihood that sustained their family.

In 2008, Joel found himself working at a dive shop, where he served as a speedboat operator for divers. One day, his boss offered him the chance to become a divemaster, just like his colleagues, which he readily accepted.

As a dive master, he ensured that tourists were fully briefed on all the underwater rules and knew what to expect during their tours. He guided them underwater, carefully overseeing their safety at all times.

Unfortunately, around 2010, he suffered a serious accident when an old tank he was using exploded, leaving his hands and feet severely injured. He spent two and a half months in the hospital, unable to walk. During this challenging period of his life, his wife, Cherry, stepped up as the family's breadwinner. Cherry went to their neighborhood selling banana cue to make ends meet, while Joel focused on his healing.

After three years

of recovery, Joel began helping his mother sell fish in the market. Five years later, when his injury had fully healed, someone offered him a job at sea again. At first, he was hesitant, still haunted by the trauma of his past accident, but his desire to provide for his family gave him the courage to confront his fears.

When he returned to work, Joel became a snorkeling guide for a tour agency owned by his Korean employer. Meanwhile, his wife worked as a dishwasher in a restaurant owned by the same employer.

During the low season, when there were no tourists, Joel would go fishing in the sea, selling the fish at his mother's stall in the market.

In 2018, Joel and his wife, Cherry, learned about CARD, Inc. (A Microfinance NGO) from a friend. With the institution's loan, Joel was able to purchase a boat. Currently, both of them have a loan of PHP 40,000.00 each, which they use to maintain their boat, renovate their house, and support their children's education.

"Malaki ang naitulong sa akin ng CARD, Inc., kagaya ngayon yung tourist boat na ginagamit ko sa paghahanapbuhay ay mula sa loan na kinuha ko sa kanila (CARD, Inc. has helped me a lot. For instance, the tourist boat I now use to earn a living was made possible through the loan I received from them)," Joel stated.

Looking ahead, Joel hopes to acquire his second boat, a venture that will not only increase their family's income but also provide for their children's education and evolving needs.

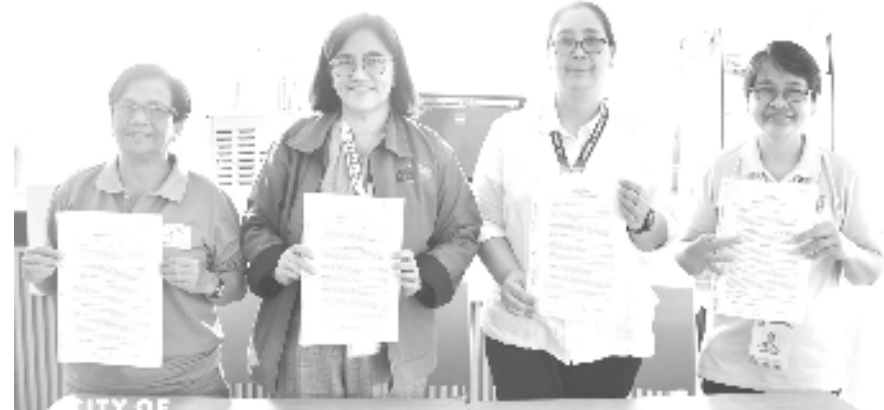

Kaalaman tungkol sa Atsuete bilang halamang gamot

Ang asparagus ay kilalang-kilala na gulay na kinakain ng mga Pilipino. Ang halaman ay maliit lamang na may maliliit at mala-kaliskis na mga dahon at maliliit na bilog na bunga. Karaniwan itong tumutubo sa mga malalamig na bansa sa Europa. Sa Pilipinas, ito ay makikita sa matataas na lugar tulad ng Benguet at Baguio.

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Asparagus?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang asparagus ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang ugat ng asparagus ay makikitaan ng ilang mga substansya at kemikal gaya ng sugar, gum, albumen, chlorine, acetate at phosphate of potash, malates, at iba pa.

Ang bunga ay may taglay na grape-sugar at sparagancin.

Ang buto ay kinukuhanan ng langis, aromatic resin, sugar, at spargin.

Sa dahon naman, makakakuha ng amino acids at ilang mga inorganic na mineral.

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:

Ang buong halaman ng asparagus ay ginagamit bilang halamang gamot. Karaniwang pinakukuluan ang buong halaman at ininom ang sabaw.

Ano ang mga sakit na maaaring magamot ng Asparagus?

1. Rayuma. Kadalasang ginagamit ang katas ng halaman para ipanggamot sa pananakit ng mga kasukasuan dulot ng rayuma. Maaaring pakuluan ang halaman at ipainom ang pinaglagaan nito.

2. Tuberculosis. Ang ugat ng halamang asparagus ay ginagamit ding panglunas sa karamdamang tuberculosis.

3. Hirap sa pag-ihi. Mabisa ring panglunas sa hirap sa pag-ihi ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng ugat ng asparagus.

4. Pamamanas o gout. Ang pinakuluang gulay na asparagus ay mabisang panglunas din sa pamamanas at gout sa ilang bahagi ng katawan.

5. Cancer. May ilang pag-aaral din ang nagsasabing may taglay na ilang mga sustansya na makapagpapaliit o makakabawas ng pagkalat ng cancer cells sa katawan.

6. Pananakit ng ngipin. Sa ibang lugar, sinusunog ang ugat ng asparagus at pinapaamoy sa taong nakararamdam ng pananakit ng ngipin.

7. Hirap sa pagdumi o pagtitibi. Ang ugat ng halaman ay karaniwang ginagamit din para padaliin ang pagdudumi.

8. Hang over. Nakatutulong ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng asparagus at pagkain ng mismong gulay nito sa pagbawas ng epekto ng alak sa katawan.

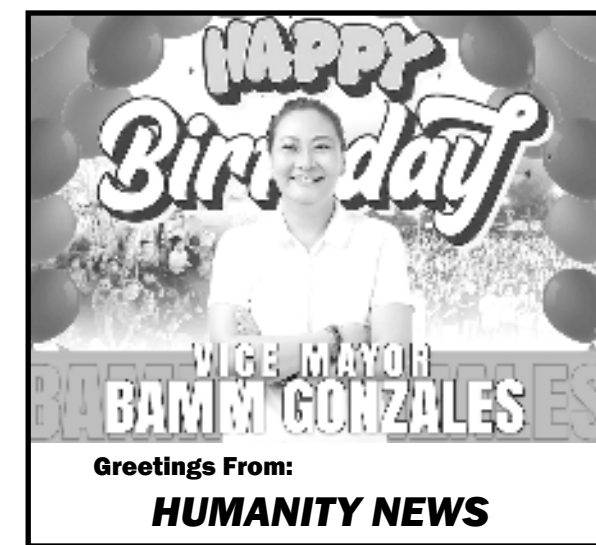
