

2026 NATIONAL BUDGET ALLOCATES P129.8B FOR PHILHEALTH



In a significant move to make quality healthcare more accessible for all, the newly signed Fiscal Year 2026 National Budget has allocated nearly P129.8 billion to the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth).

“These funds shall support preventive healthcare and the improvement of PhilHealth benefit packages, lowering the out-of-pocket expenses of Filipino families,” said President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. during the official signing of the P6.793 trillion national budget on Monday, January 5.

Notably, the allocation includes the restored P60 billion, which was transferred to the National Treasury in 2024. The restoration of these funds directly aligns with the Supreme

Court’s ruling, ensuring that resources intended for health remain dedicated to the welfare of PhilHealth members and beneficiaries.

This substantial funding further strengthens the national health insurer’s capacity to provide every Filipino with easier access to quality and affordable healthcare by expanding benefit packages, enhancing primary and preventive care programs, and reducing out-of-pocket costs.

With a P448.125-billion allocation, the 2026 General Appropriations Act (GAA) provides the largest health sector budget in Philippine history, a testament to the government’s commitment to universal healthcare.

The 2026 GAA primarily earmarks P1 billion for the Department of Health’s Universal

Health Care Fund to support the Zero Balance Billing Program in local government hospitals. This ensures that inpatient services for basic accommodations are fully covered. Additionally, this is complemented by significant allocations for disease surveillance, rapid response mechanisms, and sustainable health financing.

President Marcos Jr. emphasized that the 2026 GAA is anchored on a people-centered development agenda. By prioritizing human capital through a reliable healthcare system and responsible fiscal management, the administration fosters a resilient economy where every Filipino shares the fruit of development.

“Sa National Budget ng 2026, malinaw ang direksyon ng inyong pama-

halaan: magiging mas masinop, mas maingat, mas responsable kami sa paggastos ng pondo ng bayan. Ang bawat programa at proyekto ay dadaan sa masusing pagsusuri upang masiguro na ito ay may malinaw na benepisyo sa mamamayan—lalo na sa sektor na higit na nangangailangan,” Marcos stressed, noting that the administration remains steadfast in its duty to maintain integrity in every peso spent.

(The 2026 National Budget sets a clear direction: the government will be more prudent, more careful, and more responsible in spending public funds. Every program and project will undergo a thorough review to ensure it provides clear benefits to our citizens—especially to the sectors that need it most.)

The enactment of the P6.793 trillion GAA for 2026 marks a significant 6.9% increase from the P6.352 trillion national budget of 2025. This upward trajectory empowers the government to invest in public works and social protection programs while effectively navigating global economic shifts. (PIA)

More than 13.7 million Filipinos in Calabarzon have registered under the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys), according to the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Region IV-A.

Based on the PSA's preliminary count as of December 15, 2025, Cavite recorded the highest number of registrants with 3,503,633, followed by Rizal with 2,938,672. Batangas and Laguna posted comparable figures at 2,729,112 and 2,722,663, respectively, while Quezon registered 1,931,698 individuals.

PSA Regional Director Charito Armonia said the number of registrants reflects strong public participation in the government's national identification program.

"We attribute the steady increase in registrations to the expanded availability of national ID services through fixed and mobile registration centers across Calabarzon," Armonia said.

Armonia also reaffirmed PSA's commitment to ensuring inclusive identification and improving service delivery by bringing National ID registration and related services closer to the public.

The National ID is widely recognized as a valid proof of identity and facilitates access to government services, social protection programs, and financial transactions.

On Dec. 22, the PSA conducted National ID services to bring essential

government programs closer to communities. The initiative aimed to improve accessibility for elderly residents and katutubong 4Ps beneficiaries who often face mobility challenges and difficulty traveling to distant registration centers.

"By deploying the National ID Registration Team directly to communities, PSA Quezon ensured a convenient, efficient, and responsive registration process tailored to the needs of katutubong 4Ps beneficiaries," Armonia added.

The PSA continues to encourage unregistered residents in the region to register at the nearest PSA offices, malls, and partner local government units.

Registered individuals are also reminded that updating or correcting demographic information in the National ID System is free of charge at select registration centers. (PIA)

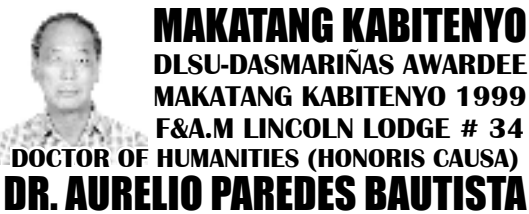

PGC continues health initiatives with medical and dental mission in Trece Martires City



On January 8, the Provincial Government of Cavite successfully conducted a Medical and Dental Mission in Barangay Cabezas, Trece Martires City, marking the continuation of the PGC's health initiatives for the new year.

The activity served a total of 582 patients, with 379 receiving medical consultations and 49 availing of dental services. Diagnostic services were also provided, including 100 fasting blood sugar (FBS) tests, 32 electrocardiogram (ECG) procedures, and 22 X-ray examinations. Free pre-

scribed medicines were likewise distributed to patients.

Medical and dental services were delivered by health professionals from the General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital (GEAMH), with the assistance of the Office of the Provincial Governor (OPG) medical mission team.

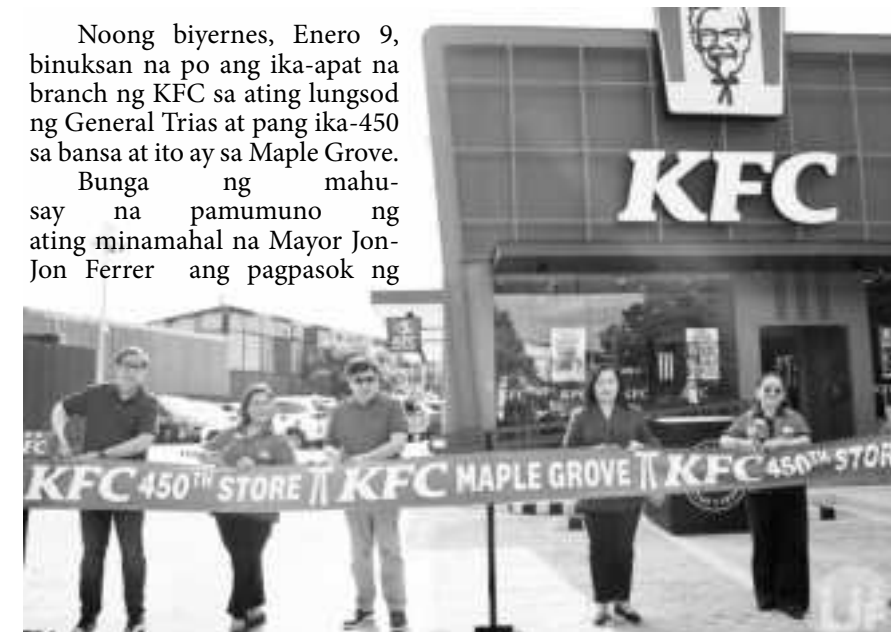

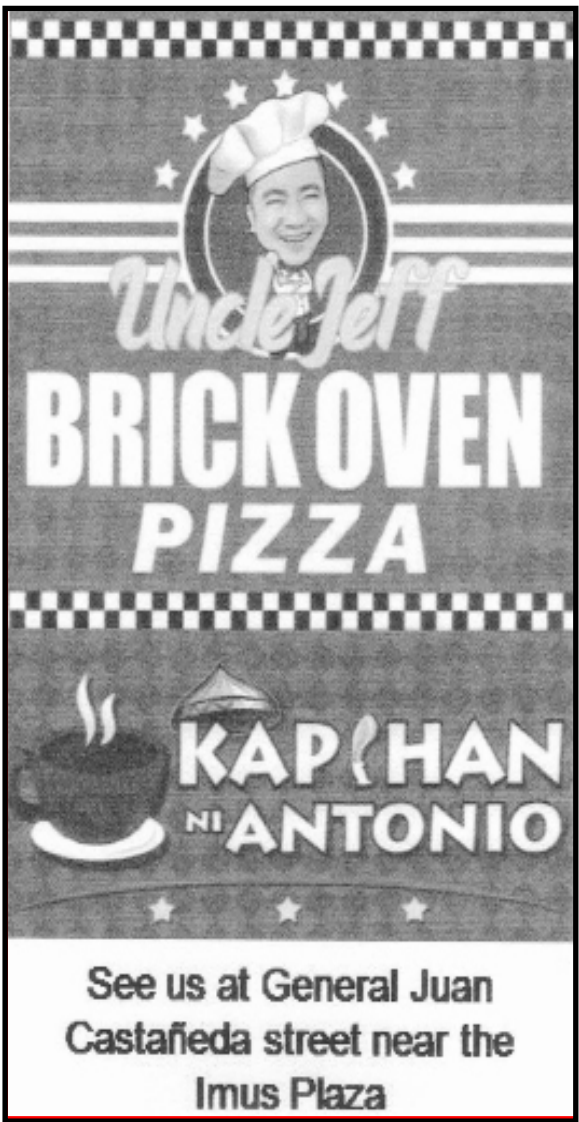
