The activity gathered 20 former Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) and was organized in collaboration with the Office of the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Officer (OP-

SWDO), aiming to equip participants with practical skills that can serve as a source of livelihood.

Ms. Myrachel P. Cuadra, Officer-in-Charge of OPCDO, formally opened the program and welcomed the participants, emphasizing the importance of skills development in building sustainable income opportunities. This was followed by an inspiring message from Mr. Allan Valencia, RSW, MMus, of OPSWDO, who encouraged the participants to maximize the training as a stepping stone toward self-reliance.

An orientation on OP-

CDO programs and services was also conducted by Ms. Sheryll H. Loyola, Livelihood Division Head, to further guide participants on available support for their future ventures. The training proper was facilitated by Ms. Corazon A. Tepora, who shared her expertise in baking, providing hands-on learning for the participants. A key agenda of the

meeting was the relocation of 32 Informal Settler Families (ISF) affected by property acquisition for the Manila Light Rail Transit Line 1 South Extension Project. The relocation forms part of Package 3 of the project and covers activities such as social preparation, pre-relocation screening, site assignments, documentation, and the eventual relocation and turnover of housing units.

The meeting was organized through the City Engineering Office headed by Jicky Jutba, with representatives from the City Administrator's Office and the Housing Urban Development and Resettlement Department (HUDRD) also present.

The focus area is along the LRT-1 South Extension Project alignment with a 10-meter Right-of-Way (ROW) identified as LRTA-acquired property. Initial activities conducted include:

- 1st General Assembly and document collection held at Zapote III

Barangay Hall on March 19, 2026

• Census survey and on-site document collection conducted on March 26, 2026

Other matters discussed during the meeting included the relocation status of Maynilad Water Services and PT&T facilities, the issuance of Certificates of Compliance for demolition and eviction for affected ISFs, and updates on right-of-way clearing and demolition works.

The meeting highlighted the continued coordination between the Bacoor City Government and national agencies to ensure the smooth implementation of major infrastructure projects while addressing the welfare of affected residents.

Scientific name: Averrhoa carambola Linn.; Averrhoa pentandra Blanco Common name: Balimbing (Tagalog); Carambola (Espanyol); Star Fruit (Ingles)

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Balimbing?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang balimbing ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang mga dahon at bunga ng balimbing ay may taglay na saponins, alkaloids, flavonoids at tannins

Ang buto naman ng balimbing ay makukuhanan ng alkaloid, harmaline, at C13H14N2O.

Ang bunga ng balimbing ay kilala ring mapagkukunan ng iron at Vitamin B at C. Mayaman din ito sa oxalate at potassium

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:

Dahon. Ang dahon ng balimbing ay kadalasang pinapakuluan at pinapainom sa pasyente. Maaari din itong dikdikin at ipantapal sa balat para sa ilang mga kondisyon.

Bulaklak. Ang bulaklak ay pinapakuluan din at iniinom ang pinaglagaan para sa ilang mga kondisyon sa katawan.

Bunga. Ang bunga ng balimbing ay maaaring kainin mismo, o katasan upang mainom ang juice. Maaari rin itong pakuluan at ipainom sa pasyente.

Buto. Ang buto naman ay dinudurog at pinupulbos at inihahalo sa inumin upang ipanggamot sa ilang mga karamdaman.

6. Iritasyon sa mata. Ang katas ng bunga ng balimbing ay ipinapatak sa mata kung dumaranas ng iritasyon dito.

7. Pagkokombulsyon. Tumulong sa pagtigil ng panganginig ng kalamnan dulot ng pagkokombulsyon ang pag-inom sa katas ng bunga ng balimbing.

8. Hika. Ginagamit sa paggamot ng sakit na hika ang pag-inom sa dinurog na buto ng balimbing na hinalo sa inumin.

9. Kakulangan ng potassium sa katawan. Ang bunga ng balimbing ay may mataas na lebel ng potassium, kung kaya, maaari itong gamitin bilang supplement sa kakulangan ng potassium sa katawan.

Si Armando "Jun" Ducat Jr. ay isang kilalang Filipino civil engineer, businessman, at social activist na nakilala sa bansa dahil sa kontrobersyal na insidente noong 2007 sa

Maynila. Si Jun Ducat ay naging laman ng mga balita matapos nitong i-hostage ang isang bus na lulan ang mga preschool students bilang bahagi ng kanyang protesta upang ipanawagan ang mas maayos na serbisyo ng gobyerno, partikular sa edukasyon at kahirapan.

Naging mapayapa ang pagresolba sa insidente at ligtas na nakalabas ang lahat ng mga batang bihag matapos ang negosasyon sa mga

awtoridad. Kilala rin si Ducat bilang tagapagtatag ng Musmos Day Care Center sa Tondo, Maynila, na layuning magbigay ng libreng edukasyon sa mga batang mahihirap.

Sa mga sumunod na taon, nagpatuloy siya sa mga community projects at iba pang inisyatiba na may layuning tumulong sa mga kapus-palad, kabilang ang mga proyekto sa Cavite. Isa na siya ngayong resort owner sa Naic, Cavite, kung saan itinatag niya ang "Paraiso de

Jun Quixote," na ayon sa kanya ay layunin na gamitin ang kikitain upang makapagpatayo ng libreng ospital sa lalawigan.

Aminado ang ilan na mali ang naging hakbang ni Ducat sa insidente ng pangho-hostage, ngunit binibigyang-diin din ng marami ang kanyang naging panawagan laban sa korapsyon at para sa mas maayos na edukasyon ng kabataan—na aniya'y susi sa mas magandang kinabukasan ng bansa.

# Cavite strengthens flood mitigation efforts and inter-agency coordination through strategic meetings



The Provincial Government of Cavite reaffirmed its commitment to disaster resilience and effective governance through two significant meetings held on March 23, at the New Provincial Government Center in Trece Martires City: the Flood Mitigation Committee (FMC) Meeting and the Local Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) Meeting.

The Flood Mitigation Committee Meeting was convened by Ms. Annabel Cayabyab, Head of the Office of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (OPENRO), on behalf of Cavite Governor Francisco Gabriel "Abeng" Remulla. The meeting brought together key officials and stakeholders involved in the Cavite Industrial Area Flood Risk Management Project (CIA-FRIMP), alongside representatives from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), and

partner agencies.

Notable participants from JICA included Mr. Aoki Nobuhiko, Ms. Catherine Palanca, and Ms. Shino Yamauchi, while local government units from Imus City, Bacoor City, General Trias City, Kawit, Rosario, and Noveleta were also represented, underscoring the collaborative nature of the initiative.

During the session, Mr. Shuji Kaku, CIA-FRIMP Project Team Leader, and Ms. Mimi Estaris, Non-Structural Measures (NSM) Specialist, presented updates on ongoing flood mitigation efforts, covering both structural interventions such as drainage improvements and pumping stations, and non-structural measures including early warning systems, community preparedness, and land-use planning. Engr. Aurelio Mendoza, Project Manager of DPWH-UPMO, further contributed technical insights that enriched the discussion and planning process.

The FMC contin-

ues to serve as a vital platform for coordination, strengthening partnerships among national agencies, local government units, and development partners toward enhancing flood management systems and building safer, more resilient communities across Cavite.

On the same day, the Local Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) Meeting was held and presided over by Provincial Administrator Engr. Gilbert Gandia. A key highlight of the LIAC meeting was the discussion of the salient provisions of Republic Act No. 12289, also known as the Accelerated and Reformed Right-of-Way (ROW) Act. The law aims to streamline and expedite the acquisition of right-

of-way for national government infrastructure projects, addressing common delays caused by land acquisition issues. Discussions emphasized the importance of inter-agency cooperation in implementing the law effectively, ensuring fair compensation, minimizing displacement concerns, and accelerating project delivery.

The LIAC serves as a critical mechanism for harmonizing policies, resolving implementation issues, and ensuring that national and local development initiatives are carried out efficiently and in accordance with existing laws and regulations.

Together, these meetings highlight the Provincial Government of Cavite's proactive approach in addressing flood risks while strengthening institutional coordination, paving the way for sustainable development and improved quality of life for its constituents.---
