Samantala, sa WalterMart Santa Rosa, ang Wellcare Clinics and Lab ang magsisilbing katuwang para sa mga manggagawa mula sa Monde Nissin at mga kawani ng LGU Santa Rosa City. Tinatayang nasa 200 pre-determined employees ang inaasahang lalahok sa bawat venue, ngunit lubos ding hinihikayat ang mga "walk-in na manggagawa at iba pang miyembro ng PhilHealth na bumisita sa mga naturang malls upang makapili ng kanilang YAKAP provider at makagamit ng serbisyong medical sa ilalim ng PhilHealth YAKAP.

Ayon sa PhilHealth, ang pagbubukas ng mga klinika sa loob ng mga mall ay isang stratehikong hakbang upang ilapit ang serbisyong medikal sa mga manggagawang limitado ang oras dahil sa trabaho.

Ang PhilHealth YAKAP ang pangunahing mekanismo sa ilalim ng Universal Health Care (UHC) Law upang itaguyod ang preventive care—o ang pag-iwas sa sakit bago pa ito lumala. Sa pamamagitan ng PhilHealth YAKAP, mababantayan ng mga YAKAP Clinics ang kalusugan ng mga miyembro para ang bawat Pilipino ay mapanatili ang mabuting kalusugan, maagang matukoy ang anumang

Parañaque Eyes Economic Boost with Full Connectivity of CAVITEX C5 Link



Parañaque City is poised for accelerated economic growth as Mayor Edwin Olivarez expressed strong optimism following the full connectivity of the 7.7-kilometer CAVITEX C5 Link, which now provides a high-speed gateway to key business hubs in Cavite and Taguig.

For Mayor Olivarez, the milestone marks the realization of a long-envisioned transformation for the city's competitiveness. "Pangarap lang ito dati, ngayon totoo na," the Mayor said. "The opening of the CAVITEX C5 Link Segment 3B will make travel from Parañaque to Cavite and Taguig, and back, in just a matter of minutes. More importantly, its impact on businesses,

investors, and opportunities for our city will be immeasurable."

Segment 3B completes the alignment of the CAVITEX C5 Link. It connects Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) to C5 Road in Taguig City, reducing travel time from the usual 1.5 hours to just 15 minutes.

The improved mobility is expected to serve as a vital economic enabler, particularly as rising fuel costs continue to affect logistics and daily travel.

CAVITEX C5 Link provides efficient access to NAIA and C5, via key interchanges at the R1 Expressway (Coastal Road), Sucat Road (Dr. A Santos Avenue), and C.P. Garcia Avenue (C5 Road), benefitting over 30,000 motorists daily.

The operational benefits of the project are echoed by the city's traffic management team. Reynaldo Murillo, Head of the Parañaque Traffic and Parking Management Office (TPMO), emphasized the project's role in improving urban traffic systems.

"Dahil kumpleto na ang koneksyon mula Cavite papuntang Metro Manila, inaasahang mababawasan ang traffic at mapapadali ang access sa mga pangunahing lugar tulad ng Taguig at airport. Ginhawa sa biyahe at mas maayos na daloy ng trapiko ang pangunahing benepisyo nito," Murillo noted.

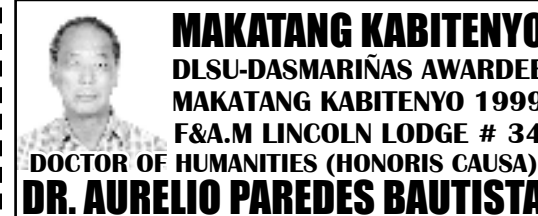
Barangay Moonwalk Chairwoman Jemelene Qui also shared the

Mayor's optimism, noting the immediate relief for local residents. "This development is expected to make daily commutes more convenient and contribute to a more productive environment for everyone," Qui said.

While the alignment is now fully connected, a portion of Segment 3B is currently operating under a modified scheme, with two lanes in each direction, as the remaining Right-of-Way (ROW) concerns are being addressed to achieve its full six-lane capacity with a 2x2 service road. Despite this, the local government remains confident that the new connectivity will immediately drive investments, stimulate business activity, and generate more employment opportunities for Parañaqueños.

The CAVITEX C5 Link expressway is a joint venture between Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation's (MPTC) subsidiary, the Cavite Infrastructure Corporation (CIC), and the Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA) and operated by the PEA Tollway Corporation (PEATC).

TRB greenlights toll collection for Segment 3B of the CAVITEX C5 Link

The Toll Regulatory Board (TRB) has authorized the toll collection for the final segment of the CAVITEX C5 Link, starting May 5, 2026. Since opening on March 30, 2026, Segment 3B has provided free passage to almost 9,000 motorists daily.

CAVITEX C5 Link Segment 3B connects Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) to C5 Road in Taguig City, re-

ducing travel time from the usual 1.5 hours to just 15 minutes.

Starting May 5, motorists using the CAVITEX C5 Link from Taguig to Sucat Road (Dr. A. Santos Avenue) or vice versa, will pay the following rates: P59 for Class 1, P117 for Class 2, and P176 for Class 3 (inclusive of Segment 3B rates).

For those coming from Taguig and going straight to Roxas Bou-

levard or Zapote, the following toll rates will apply: P97 for Class 1, P194 for Class 2, and P291 for Class 3 vehicles.

With the CAVITEX C5 Link now fully connected, it offers efficient access to NAIA and C5 via key interchanges at the R1 Expressway (Coastal Road), Sucat Road (Dr. A. Santos Avenue), and C.P. Garcia Avenue. The expressway

also strengthens the logistics link between the Cavite industrial hubs and the commercial centers in the National Capital Region, supporting regional economic growth. It further serves as an alternative route, especially for heavy vehicles, helping ease congestion on major arterial roads across Cavite and the southern portion of Metro Manila.

RIPPLING EFFECT OF TURNING DREAMS INTO PROGRESS



Glaiza Velasco, together with her husband, has attended several international food exhibits featuring their products, with participation endorsed by DTI and supported by LGUs.

What started with just two small containers has now grown into about 500 drums, which Glaiza Velasco from Pangasinan now uses to store fermented sugarcane juices.

Glaiza began selling vinegar produced by the farmers when she was still a working student in 2008. As a working student, she balanced her studies with a job at a fast-food chain and selling vinegar at school and in public markets.

Later that year, she took the risk of creating her own vin-

egar, given the abundance of sugarcane in their area. Because of her hard work, she completed her education and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Commerce, Major in Management.

After graduation, she entered the corporate world but soon realized that running her own business suited her better. In 2016, she was determined to take her vinegar business seriously, so she resigned from her job and focused on marketing her product. Glaiza went to public markets to

offer samples to help customers distinguish her all-natural vinegar from other commercial brands. From then on, more people became her customers. Through consistency, she built a strong presence in the market.

In 2020, while the pandemic brought hardships to many, it became a blessing in disguise for their business. With the proper permits and operating requirements in place, most orders came to them, allowing their business to grow.

However, problems were inevitable. As sugarcane prices remained unstable, she rented land in 2021 to grow their own. Even so, they still buy sugarcane from farmers from time to time to meet all the growing demands of their products.

With their marketing strategy, they have been able to supply supermarkets, convenience stores, local government units, bus stops, and public markets. E-commerce platforms also help them reach customers nationwide.

To ensure consistent quality, their employees continue to undergo training, seminars, and workshops on food safety and manufacturing practices. As the number of customers increased, they were able to build their production facility and invest in assets.

Around 2018, she learned about CARD SME Bank, a thrift bank under CARD Mutually Reinforcing Institutions (CARD MRI). Her first loan of PHP 3,000.00 was used to buy sugarcane. She currently has an active loan with the bank, which she uses as additional capital for the business.

Because of her entrepreneurial skill, Glaiza was recognized as the Pagkilala sa Mga Likha ni Inay (PsMLNI) Gawad Maunlad 2025



winner. This award recognized people like her who, through hard work and responsible financing, grew their businesses from simple livelihoods into stable ventures. PsMLNI is conducted annually by CARD MRI to honor clients who, through hard work and institutional support, have achieved growth and success.

"Pangarap kong maging global company at brands ang aming negosyo, maging maganda ang kinabukasan ng mga empleyado at mga pamilya nila (It is my dream for my business to be recognized globally, and

for my employees and their families to have a brighter future)," she stated.

It was a ripple effect; she was able to provide for her family, create employment for others, and help farmers earn income. Her journey may have been tough, but the fact that she can meet not only her family's needs but also help others is what drives her to do even more.
