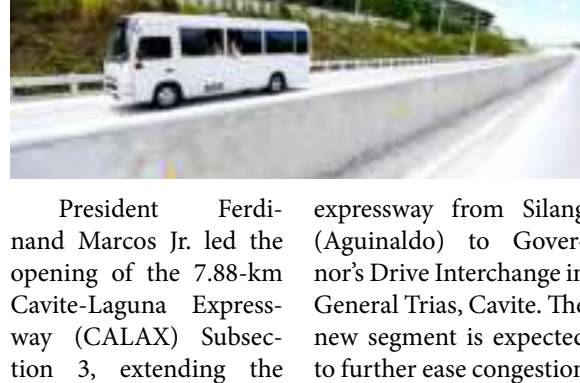


# PBBM OPENS CALAX SUBSECTION 3, BOOSTS SOUTH LUZON CONNECTIVITY



President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. led the opening of the 7.88-km Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) Subsection 3, extending the expressway from Silang (Aguinaldo) to Governor's Drive Interchange in General Trias, Cavite. The new segment is expected to further ease congestion

and cut travel time between Biñan, Laguna, and Gen. Trias, Cavite, to just 26 minutes from one (1) hour, further strengthening South Luzon's transport network.

Designed to accommodate additional 6,000 motorists daily, Subsection 3 provides a faster alternative route for commuters and businesses by bypassing heavily congested local roads in Cavite's growing industrial and residential corridors.

With this milestone, the operational length of CALAX now spans 26 kilometers from the Mamplasan Entry in Biñan, Laguna.

The entire 44.6-kilometer CALAX project, will eventually link the Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX) in Kawit to the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) in Mamplasan. The network features eight strategic interchanges: Laguna Technopark, Laguna Boulevard, Santa Rosa-Tagaytay, Silang East, Silang (Aguinaldo), Governor's Drive, Open Canal,

and Kawit. Once fully integrated with CAVITEX, the combined network is projected to serve up to 95,000 vehicles per day, acting as a regional backbone for trade and mobility.

CALAX Subsection 3 (Governor's Drive Interchange to Aguinaldo Interchange stretch) will be free for all classes for one month. Motorists will only pay the existing toll fees for CALAX Subsections 4 to 8 (Mamplasan in Biñan, Laguna to Silang (Aguinaldo) in Cavite. Any updates will be announced by the Toll Regulatory Board (TRB) in coordination with CALAX management.

CALAX is an MP-CALA Holdings Inc. project with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) as project grantor.

MPCALA Holdings Inc., the developer and operator of CALAX, is a subsidiary of the Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), the toll road arm of the Metro Pacific Investments Corporation (MPIC). ###

The local government of General Trias, led by Mayor Luis "Jon Jon" Ferrer IV and Vice Mayor Jonas Labuguen, extended financial assistance to the transport sector on May 7 at the General Trias Sports Park in Barangay Santiago.

A total of 2,383 registered and franchise-holding beneficiaries received P5,000 each in the first batch, while more than 1,000 additional beneficiaries are set to receive aid in the next distribution.

According to Mayor Ferrer, further support is also being prepared for jeepney drivers, riders, and even colorum drivers, including assistance in processing and regularizing their franchises.

"This is a big help for our drivers, especially amid the continuous rise in fuel prices," the mayor said.

Meanwhile, members of transport groups (TODA) in General Trias continue to strive to provide orderly and continuous public service to commuters.

NITA: BAIL HEADING SA REVILLA CASE "WALANG MATIBAY NA EBIDENSIYA"

Isang matinding pahayag ang pinakawalan ni Carlos Ayala ng National Institute for Transparency and Accountability: matapos ang serye ng bail hearings, malinaw umano—mahina ang kaso laban kay Ramon Bong Revilla Jr. Ayon kay Ayala, umikot ang buong argumento ng prosekusyon sa iisang testigo, habang ang iba'y puro "hearsay" at "derivative testimonies," at higit sa lahat, kapansin-pansin ang kawalan ng konkretong dokumento na direktang mag-uugnay sa dating senador sa pera o sabwatan.



Sa pagdinig sa Sandiganbayan, inaasahang lalong titibay ang kaso. Ngunit ang nangyari—kabaliktaran. Sa testimonya ng halos 20 witnesses, tila mas lalong lumuwag ang posisyon ni Revilla kaysa madiin. Sa ilalim ng panunumpa, sunod-sunod ang pag-amin: walang personal na kaalaman, walang direktang ugnayan, walang matibay na ebidensiyang magpapatunay na siya ang tumanggap o sangkot sa sinasabing milyong-milyong pondo.

Umiikot ang kaso sa umano'y anomalya sa ₱92.8 milyong flood control project sa Pandi, Bulacan. Ngunit sa loob mismo ng korte, nagbago ang direksyon ng naratibo. Wala umano nakakita, walang direktang nakausap—puro proseso, puro kwento. Sa madaling salita: kulang sa laman ang paratang.

Isang pangalan lang ang tumindig bilang direktang nag-akusa—si dating DPWH Usec. Roberto Bernardo, ang tinaguriang "state witness." Iginiit niyang umabot sa ₱500 milyon ang naideliver umano kay Revilla. Ngunit sa buong pagdinig, wala ni isang testigo ang nagkumpirma sa kanyang salaysay. Mas lalo pang nabutas ang alegasyon nang mismong driver at aide ni Bernardo ang umaming hindi nila matiyak kung pera nga ba ang laman ng kaniyang dinadala.

Dagdag pa rito, lumutang sa testimonya na si dating DPWH Usec. Cabral umano ang nag-utos na pangalanan si Revilla bilang "proponent" ng proyekto—isang detalye na kalaunan ay pinirmahan at inaprubahan ni dating DPWH Sec. Bonoan. Para sa ilang observers, malinaw na posibilidad na ginamit lamang ang pangalan ng dating senador, at hindi siya aktwal na sangkot sa operasyon.

Sa kabuuan, tila mismong mga testigo ang naglantad ng kahinaan ng kaso. Sa halip na patibayan ang akusasyon, ang testimonya ang unti-unting sumira sa pundasyon nito.

Ngayon, nasa kamay ng Sandiganbayan ang pasya. Ngunit sa direksyong tinahak ng pagdinig, isang mabigat na tanong ang bumabalot sa publiko: kung ang ebidensiya ay manipis, maaari bang ipagkait ang bail? Ang sagot—malapit nang malamang, at posibleng magtakda ng tono sa isa sa mga pinakamainit na kasong sinusubaybayan ngayon. MARGIE BAUTISTA
