3rd Floor, SM City Bacoor – June 11, 2026 — The City Government of Bacoor, under the leadership of Mayor Strike B. Revilla, successfully conducted the Pre-Independence Day Strike a Job Fair 2026 through the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) headed by Dr. Abraham De Castro. The event was held at the 3rd Floor of SM City Bacoor and brought together employers, job seekers, and government partners in support of local employment generation.

Present during the activity were Vice Mayor Rowena B. Mendiola, Congresswoman Lani Mercado Revilla, Councilors Noly Galvez and Karen Sarino Evaristo, Board Member Alde Pagulayan, SM City Bacoor Mall Manager Ms. Joie Arvesu, and Ms. Catherine Uy of the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO).

A total of 70 participating companies from various industries, including retail, manufacturing, hospitality, healthcare, and business process outsourcing, offered more than 500 employment opportunities for aspiring applicants. Available positions ranged from entry-level and skilled jobs to professional and supervisory roles, providing diverse career options for job seekers with different qualifications and work experiences.

In addition to employment opportunities, the job fair featured a range of support services designed to help applicants improve their chances of securing employment. These included resume-building assistance, career counseling, and information sessions on government livelihood and employment programs.

The event attracted not only residents of Bacoor but also job seekers from neighboring cities such as Imus and Dasmariñas. More than 1,200 applicants registered and participated in the activity, demonstrating the strong demand for employment opportunities in the region.

Anchored on the theme, “True independence begins with the ability to provide for our families and secure honorable employment,” the job fair highlighted the importance of meaningful work in empowering individuals and strengthening communities.

Coming back to weaving, coming back home



Luzviminda R. Esperanza, 68, from Luisiana, Laguna, happily weaves pandan leaves into native bags by hand. The finished products are neatly arranged and ready for pickup by a distributor.

In the quiet town of Luisiana, Laguna, a simple woman gracefully weaves strands of pandan leaves, turning them into bayong or baskets and native bags. Luzviminda R. Esperanza, more fondly called "Lucy" by her friends and loved ones, has long been passionate about weaving.

Long before life demanded more of her, Lucy had been weaving with her bare hands since childhood. She not only turned this into an income-earning activity, but it is also a handed-down craft she first learned by watching her parents weave mats and bags.

But driven by the growing necessity, she braved life in Manila when she turned into a teenager. Lucy worked in stores and eateries. Later on, she also worked in parlor shops, offering hairstyling and beauty services to make a living. The soft rustle of pandan leaves in her hands was replaced by the fast-paced rhythm of survival in the city.

When her siblings started having families on their own, Lucy returned home to Luisiana, Laguna in 1983 to take care of her aging parents. Little did she know that her homecoming would also lead her to meet the

man who would become her husband. The following year, they married and began raising a family together.

While her husband worked as a tricycle driver, Lucy continued offering makeup and hairstyling services in their town to help provide for their children. Yet in between responsibilities as a mother while also trying to earn, weaving remained stitched into her. Lucy picked up the pandan leaves once again and continued crafting bags by hand. Each woven piece she produces from there also helps support her children's education and daily needs.

In 2016, after being invited by some of the first clients in their area, Lucy became a client of CARD MRI Rizal Bank, Inc., a microfinance-oriented rural bank. As a client, she began saving and became enrolled in the insurance services under CARD MRI.

When her husband died in 2019, Lucy was left to move in with one of her children in Batangas City and tried to continue offering beauty services in the new place. However, despite being with family, city life and its heat did not suit her.

Lucy eventually returned once again to the quiet rural life in Luisiana.

With her two children now grown, one staying in Batangas and the other in Cabuyao, Laguna, she decided to stop taking other jobs and fully return to weaving. Back in the very place where she learned the craft, weaving once again became both her source of livelihood and comfort.

Through the loan services of CARD RBI, she was able to gain additional capital to sustain her weaving business. Aside from the savings and loan services, the insurance services provided through the partner institutions of CARD RBI gave her peace of mind, knowing she has a safety net during difficult times. She also finds comfort knowing that these insurances can spare her family from hardship should anything happen to her.

Today, Lucy carefully buys pandan leaves, molds them, and transforms them into baskets and bags with her hands that have long memorized the process, but still craft it intently. It has now

become the main thread that sustains her everyday life. She can finish one basket in around fifteen minutes and create up to ten pieces a day while still tending to household chores. Her neighbors, who also weave, bring their finished products to Lucy's house, where distributors later collect them for the market.

With the same wisdom reflected in her woven creations, Lucy encourages fellow clients to continue saving and investing in insurance for their future: "Sila ay maghulog (sa savings at insurance) para may aasahan sila balang araw," she advised.

Lucy's fulfillment now rests in the well-being of her children and grandchildren, and in doing what she loves while living. She chose a quiet life. No grand displays, just a humble contentment gently woven through experiences she gained throughout the years, just like the strands of pandan leaves that she patiently moves by hand.

LGUs, Business Leaders Highlight CALAX Subsection 3’s Role in Driving Growth



The economic landscape of Cavite is poised for greater growth following the opening of the Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) Subsection 3, extending the expressway to Governor’s Drive Interchange in General Trias City.

With CALAX now spanning 26 kilometers from Mamlasan, Biñan, Laguna to General Trias, Cavite, local government officials and business leaders cited the project’s role in improving connectivity, attracting investments, and creating new opportunities for businesses and communities.

Florencio Ayos, President of the Gen-Tri Business Club, said the new subsection is a long-awaited devel-

opment that cuts travel time between Laguna and Cavite’s industrial hubs to just 26 minutes.

“We are no longer a destination that is hard to reach — we are now a city that is impossible to ignore. Infrastructure is not just about roads; it is about opening doors for every Filipino entrepreneur. General Trias is now better positioned than ever to attract investments, generate employment, and build a more resilient economy,” Ayos stated.

General Trias City Mayor Luis “Jon Jon” Ferrer IV described the new interchange as ‘a gateway to greater opportunities’ that positions the city as a thriving center of industry. “Habang patuloy na lumalago ang General

Trias bilang sentro ng industriya at kaunlaran, mahalaga ang proyektong tulad nito upang mas mailapit ang mga oportunidad sa ating mga kababayan,” said Mayor Ferrer.

The positive outlook was echoed by Dasmariñas City Mayor Jennifer Barzaga, who emphasized that the expressway enhances access to commerce, education, and tourism.

“Ang proyektong ito ay hindi lamang tungkol sa bagong kalsada, ito ay tungkol sa mas magandang kalidad ng buhay. Ang CALAX ay simbolo ng patuloy na progreso at ng ating samasamang pangarap para sa isang mas maunlad, mas konektado, at mas maa-liwalas na kinabukasan para sa bawat mama-

mayan,” Mayor Barzaga noted.

Barangay Adlas (Silang) Captain Joelito Generoso highlighted the project’s impact on local development. “Napakalaking benepisyo ng pagbubukas ng CALAX Governor’s Drive. Nagkaroon ng oportunidad sa negosyo, pagbubukas ng mga bagong trabaho, at pagtaas ng presyo ng lupa. Pinalakas din nito ang turismo at transportasyon ng mga kalakal,” Barangay Capt. Generoso said.

Meanwhile, Barangay San Francisco (General Trias) Captain Ryan Santor pointed to the long-term benefits of improved accessibility. “We believe that the opening of CALAX SS3 will bring lasting benefits to nearby communities through improved connectivity, increased investments, and easier transportation of goods and services,” said Barangay Capt. Santor.

Beyond improving travel, the opening of CALAX Subsection 3 is expected to strengthen trade, support business

expansion, and enhance Cavite’s competitiveness as an investment destination.

CALAX is an MPCALA Holdings Inc. project with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) as project grantor.

Mas pinalakas pa ng PhilHealth Regional Office IV-A ang kampanya nito para sa malawakan at abot- kayang kalusugan sa pamamagitan ng puspusang pagpapatupad ng dalawang pangunahing programa: ang Yaman ng Kalusugan Program (YAKAP) at ang Guaranteed and Accessible Medications for Outpatient Treatment (GAMOT).

Ang hakbang na ito ay alinsunod sa pagsusulong ng Universal Health Care (UHC) Act upang matiyak na ang bawat Pilipino ay protektado laban sa mataas na gastusing medikal nang hindi na kinakailangan pang ma-ospital.

Sa ilalim naman ng programang GAMOT, may hanggang P20,000.00 halaga ng pangunahing gamot kada taon ang bawat miyembro. Sakop nito ang 54 na klase ng

mahahalagang gamot kabilang ang:

1. Anti-Infectious
2. Anti-Hypertensive & Cardiology
3. Nervous System
4. Anti-Thrombotics
5. Anti-Asthma & COPD
6. Anti-Diabetics
7. Anti-Dyslipidemia

Samantalang ang 21 essential medicines ay makukuha sa napiling YAKAP clinic. Upang masiguro na mararamdaman ng mga mamamayan sa Cavite, Laguna, at Quezon ang alaga ng PhilHealth, patuloy ang proseso ng akreditasyon ng mga pasilidad sa buong rehiyon.

Sa kasalukuyan, mayroong 296 YAKAP providers sa Region 4A, kung saan 265 dito ay YAKAP-ready facilities na nakapag-comply na sa mga strict readiness requirements ng PhilHealth. Samantala, pinalawak na rin ang network ng mga partner pharmacies kung saan mayroon nang 223 PhilHealth GAMOT Providers sa buong rehiyon na rehistrado at handang mag-dispense ng mga libreng gamot sa mga miyembro.

Para sa mapakinabangan ang programa, narito ang apat na Simpleng Hakbang:

1. Assignment: MagpaPumili at magpatala sa isang YAKAP Provider gamit ang eGovPH mobile app o sa pinakamalapit na PhilHealth Local Health Insurance Office (LHIO).
2. First Patient Encounter (FPE): Bumisita sa napiling YAKAP clinic para sa pag-susuri at pagtukoy ng tamang pangangalaga ng kalusugan.
3. Empanelment: Pagpirma ng YAKAP Empanelment Slip (YES) para sa pagtataguyod ng normal na ugnayan o relasyon sa pagitan ng miyembro at ng napiling Primary Care Clinic (PCC).
4. Konsultasyon: Magpatingin sa YAKAP doctor ng clinic para mabigyan ng e-prescription kung kinakailangan gamot at laboratoryo/tests.
5. Dispensing sa GAMOT Provider: Dalhin ang reseta sa alinmang accredited GAMOT pharmacy

Ang patuloy na pagdami ng mga PhilHealth YAKAP at GAMOT facilities sa Region IV-A ay patunay ng dedikasyon ng ahensya na ilapit ang serbisiyong medikal sa mga komunidad upang ang bawat pamilyang Pilipino ay manatiling “malayo sa sakit.”
