A life built on hard work and perseverance



From the gateway of Bicolandia, Dominga Perez continues to strive in life with the help of her grass broom business that started in 2011.

"Age is just a number," a phrase that rings true for 76-year-old Dominga Perez of Camarines Norte, who pushes forward in her business journey with relentless grit and determination.

Not everyone is blessed with decades of physical strength, and Dominga remains grateful for the body that endured the test of time. She had a fair share of struggles, beginning with her days as a miner, then as a housekeeper, and now as a microentrepreneur.

After getting married, she learned to become a miner with her husband. However, after 13 years together, her first husband passed away. Despite

the loss, she remained strong and continued her duties as a mother.

Love found its way back to her life when she met her second husband, with whom she was blessed with six children. Mining remained their primary livelihood, as it was common in their community. Dominga has firsthand experience of the job. Unfazed by the dangers and hazardous environment, she would dig the ground and enter holes in search of gold.

There were times when she was lucky enough to find a few grams of gold, but there were also times when all she gained from mining was exhaustion.

Nevertheless, she continued doing this work for many years.

In 1996, her husband had to stop working due to an injury. Dominga, too, had to leave mining behind. To support her family, she worked as a house helper while peddling grass brooms made by her neighbors. She travelled to Sta. Rosa Sur and as far as Paracale, seizing every opportunity to sell grass brooms and earn a living.

Knowing that being a house helper was not a long-term solution, she sought to build something of her own. In 2011, she learned the craft of broom-making and turned it into a business. That same

year, she became a client of CARD Bank, a microfinance-oriented rural bank that provided small loans to aspiring entrepreneurs like her.

Her initial loan was used to purchase raw materials needed to make the product, while her income as a house helper covered their daily expenses.

When her husband was still alive, he worked with her to make grass brooms, ensuring the products were of good quality and durability. Now, one of her children has stepped in to help keep the business alive.

Crafting grass brooms is a good business decision for her, as it is an everyday, practical,

Kaalaman tungkol sa Alagaw bilang halamang gamot

Ang alagaw ay isang kilalang halaman na karaniwang tumutubog sa mga isla ng Pilipinas at sa mga karatig bansa nito. Ang dahon nito na malapad ay kilalang ginugulay at ginagawang salad sa maraming mga lugar. Mayroon din itong mga bulaklak na kumpol-kumpol sa isang sanga. Ang bunga naman ay maliliit na bilog na tila mga paminta na kulay lila o itim.

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Alagaw?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang alagaw ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang dahon ng alagaw ay maaaring makuhanan ng mabangong langis, at ilang mga kemikal gaya ng acyclic monoterpenediol diesters, premmaodorosides A, B, at C. Mayroon pang phenethyl alcohol glycosides, verbascoside, isoacteoside, bioside (decaffeoylverbascoside) and cistanoside F.

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:



Scientific name: *Premna curranii*
H. Lam.; *Premna oblongata* Miq.;
Premna pubescens Blume

Common name: Alagaw (Tagalog);
 Fragrant Premna (Ingles)

Dahon. And dahon ng alagaw ang pangunahing bahagi ng halaman na ginagamit bilang gamot. Ito ay maaaring ilaga at inumin na parang tsaa. Maaaring lagyan ng pantamis o kaya ay kalamansi upang mas malinamnam kung inumin. Maaari ring dikdikin at kunin ang katas upang ipampahid sa bahagi ng katawan.

Usbong. Ang mga bagong usbong na dahon at bulaklak ay kadalasang kinakain o ginagawang gulay na sangkap sa ilang mga lutuin.

Ano ang mga sakit na maaaring magamot ng Alagaw?

Ayon sa mga pag-aaral at nakagawian ng ilan, ang ilan sa mga sakit na maaaring malunasan sa pamamagitan ng paggamit sa halamang akapulko ay ang sumusunod:

1. Ubo na may makapit na plema. Ang pag-inom sa pinaglagaan ng dahon ng alagaw ay maaaring makatulong sa pagpapaluwag ng paghinga at pagpapalambot ng makapit na plema.

2. Tulo sa babae. Ang pinaglagaan din ng bagong usbong na dahon ng alagaw ay maaaring ipanghugas sa ari ng babae kung patuloy ang pagtulo (discharge).

3. Sipon. Maaaring maibsan ang mga sintomas ng sipon kung inumin ang pinaglagaan ng dahon ng alagaw.

4. Pananakit ng ulo. Ang dinikdik na dahon ng alagaw ay maaaring ilagay sa noo o ipahid sa sentido upang maibsan ang pananakit ng ulo.

5. Tuberculosis. Pinaniniwalaang nakagagaan ng pakiramdam at nakakabawas ng sintomas ng sakit na TB ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng dahon ng alagaw.

6. Pananakit ng sikmura. Maaring inumin ang pinaglagaan ng dahon para maibsan ang pananakit ng tiyan. Maaari ding ipahid sa nananakit na sikmura ang dinikdik na dahon ng alagaw na inihalo sa langis ng niyog upang maibsan ito.

7. Galis at mga sugat. Ang mga sugat at galis sa balat ay maaaring pahiran ng katas mula sa dinikdik na dahon ng alagaw.

8. Impeksyon ng mga organismo sa sikmura. Ang pagkakaroon ng mga peste sa sikmura gaya ng giardia at amoeba ay maaaring magamot sa pamamagitan ng pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng dahon ng alagaw.



MPT SOUTH KICKS OFF ROAD SAFETY MONTH WITH 'DRAYBERKS: READY 4 SAFETY' CAMPAIGN



May 22, 2025—With the goal of building a safer future on Philippine roads, Metro Pacific Tollways South (MPT South) marked Road Safety Month by unveiling its latest theme for road safety advocacy campaign "Drayberks: Ready 4 Safety," in a ceremonial launch held at the Golden Phoenix Hotel in Pasay City.

Over 100 stakeholders from both the public and private sectors attended the celebration, in partnership with national agencies including the Department of Transportation (DOTr), Toll Regulatory Board (TRB), Land Transportation Office (LTO), Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), PNP Highway Patrol Group Region IV-A, Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA), and PEA Tollway Corporation (PEATC). Local government units in Metro Manila and CALABARZON also joined the celebration, including representatives from Taguig, Parañaque, Pasay, Las Piñas, Bacoor, Imus, Kawit, General Trias, Dasmariñas, Silang, Santa Rosa, and Biñan.

The following major transport and terminal partners also attended

the event: Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX), One Ayala Terminal, and advocacy organizations like ACTO; bus companies such as TAS Trans Corp., Erjohn & Almark Transit Corp. Co., Don Aldrin Transport Inc., Saulog Transit, and Jasper Jean Services Inc.; UV groups such as DIPTA-MOA, United 12 Corp., TVTAP; modern and traditional jeepney groups such as Paliparan 3, Kapit Bisig Transport, PABODA, CAMBIO, and Universal Transport; and Philippine Multimodal Transport and Logistics Association Inc. as a representative for the logistics sector.

Mr. Jose Ma. K. Lim, the President and CEO of Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), delivered the welcome remarks. He emphasized the critical role expressway operators play not just in building infrastructure, but also in promoting a culture of safety on and beyond their roads. He stated, "This project is just one of the many ways MPTC demonstrates its unwavering commitment to the safety of all road users. We believe that true progress in road safety comes through collaboration—by working hand-in-hand with government, private partners, and the

communities we serve."

The main event was the unveiling of the new Road Safety Campaign of MPT South, "Drayberks: Ready 4 Safety" Campaign, which was led by Ms. Arlette V. Capistrano, MPT South Vice President for Communication and Stakeholder Management. The Drayberks program, first introduced in 2018, has evolved into a well-regarded platform for promoting road discipline. Now in its sixth year, Drayberks has been recognized as a model road safety program, most recently earning a Bronze Stevie® Award in the Innovation in Communications/Public Relations category at the 2025 Asia-Pacific Stevie Awards. With the refreshed Ready 4 Safety campaign, MPT South aims to reach drivers of all classifications—from public utility drivers and logistics operators to private motorists—through updated modules grounded in four key points: Responsible driving, expressway rules, pre-trip vehicle inspection, and practicing discipline on the road.

"Ready 4 Safety" strengthens our promise to equip every driver with the knowledge and values needed to navigate roads safely—not only for their own benefit, but for

everyone's," Capistrano shared during the unveiling. The event culminated in a powerful moment as participants stood together to recite the Drayberks Pledge, led by MPT South OIC Elnora D. Rumawak. This collective commitment to safe, disciplined, and responsible driving was further solidified with a symbolic pledge signing, uniting government agencies, transport groups, and local leaders under one shared goal.

As the curtains closed on this milestone celebration, MPT South reaffirmed its mission: that beyond building roads, it is building a culture of safety, accountability, and readiness—one driver, one community at a time.
