Addition of LRT-1 Station in Bacoor endangers the livelihood and residence of Talaba locals.



From its original plan, the LRT Line-1 Cavite Extension only covers two stations in Bacoor City namely in barangays Zapote and Niog. Prior to the announcement of the additional station, residents from Zapote and Niog has already experienced the impending threats of

demolition and arson. Its dangers were already exhibited last September 10, 2024 when a fire broke out in Sitio Kanluran, Brgy. Zapote 3 where 932 families and 4,460 individuals were affected. After the incident, private security goons from VV security agency and JR18 security agency were hired by

the LRMC and city government of Bacoor, to encamp the site.

Private goons were ordered to guard the site to prevent any obstruction on the construction of the LRT stations. Local residents were prohibited to rebuild their homes even the entry of materials for their houses. Since then, locals reported multiple accounts of threats, intimidation and harassment from the securities.

The same goes with the households in Sitio Tabon in Zapote 3. They have experienced

demolition attempts carried out by demolition teams and staff from the office of the Mayor of Bacoor city government last November 15, 2024. The team intimidated, threatened and pressed the locals to self-demolish their homes.

From this, the additional Talaba station would only aggravate the problems of displacement and arson in the city. Thousands of local fisherfolk and informal workers will lose their livelihoods and residence all for the benefit of the developers from Light Rail Manila Consortium (LRMC) and the Revilla dynasty.

Therefore, we strongly denounce the additional station of LRT-1 Cavite Extension placed in Talaba. The project, as a whole, must be reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and Department of Transportation (DoTr) to take into account the affected residents.

We call on all residents to protest against the construction of LRT-1 Cavite Extension. We are for development but not for the development of the few and elite!
