



DepEd Cavite's Romanes Bags Regional Award, Named National Semi-Finalist for Dangal ng Bayan 2025

CAVITE, Philippines – For her groundbreaking contributions to education, ethics, and public service, Ms. May Anne Joy D. Romanes, Senior Education Program Specialist for Planning and Research of DepEd Cavite, has been honored with a regional award and named a national semi-finalist for the 2025 Dangal ng Bayan Award of the Civil Service Commission (CSC). Just last year, Romanes was named Gawad Patnugot Outstanding Researcher – Teaching-Related

Category (with Distinction) by DepEd CALABARZON, the highest honor given to a researcher or personnel in Region IV-A. This regional recognition solidified her status as a leading figure in educational research and innovation.

Under her leadership, DepEd Cavite recorded an 807% increase in completed research studies—from 221 in 2019 to 1,788 in 2024. Her inclusive programs empowered teach-

ers, school leaders, and non-teaching personnel to become active contributors to evidence-based governance and instruction.

One of her landmark initiatives, the Cloverleaf Program, addressed teacher burnout and anxiety, benefiting over 3,000 personnel. Her digital innovations—such as the DepEd Cavite InfoKiosk and the Cavite Association of Research Educators Cross Cultural Engagement and Fellowship mentorship network—modernized education data access and provided free research training in 22 countries.

As a staunch advo-

cate of ethical practices, Romanes implemented division-wide policies on anti-plagiarism and ethical AI use. She continues to mentor hundreds of students and public servants at no cost, living out her belief that knowledge must be shared, not sold.

Now a semi-finalist for the national Dangal ng Bayan Award, Romanes stands among the most exemplary civil servants in the country—recognized for integrity, innovation, and dedicated public service.

The final results for the national Dangal ng Bayan Award will be announced by the CSC in September 2025.

FREE HEARING AID SERVICES EXTENDED TO 65 CAVITENOS



In its continuous effort to provide inclusive healthcare services, the Office of the Provincial Persons with Disability Affairs Officer (OPPDAO), in partnership with Manila Hearing Aid, conducted a Hearing Test for Adults with Hearing Loss on July 31 to August 1, 2025, at the Residential Care Facility in Trece Martires City. A total of 65 beneficiaries will receive free hearing aids, offering them a renewed opportunity to connect with their surroundings and enhance their quality of life. The two-day event featured a comprehensive set of hearing care services including otoscopy, tympanometry, hearing

tests, and hearing aid trials. These procedures were conducted by professionals from Manila Hearing Aid, ensuring quality service and accurate diagnosis for each participant. The initiative is part of the Provincial Government of Cavite's ongoing programs to support persons with disabilities by addressing hearing loss which is one of the most overlooked conditions among adults. With early detection and the provision of appropriate devices, hearing-impaired individuals are empowered to live more comfortably and actively engage with their communities.
