Once standing steadfast on the waters of Rosario, Cavite, the San Nicholas Shoal Lighthouse served as a tertiary aid to navigation since its construction in 1997—its 30-foot concrete tower and red flashing beacon guiding mariners across a 7-nautical-mile range. In recent years, the site became a focal point of major reclamation activities, including the 265-hectare Harbor City Project, which eventually placed the lighthouse within a demarcated project exclusion zone. With sand extraction transforming the once-shallow shoal into deep water, its role in that location came to an end.

In 2023, the structure found a new purpose and a new home—relocated to the coastline near Villa Excellance, Tanza, Cavite (14°22'56"N, 120°49'17"E) and renamed Lighthouse Tanza. Now classified as a secondary aid to navigation, this 18-meter concrete tower stands proudly with its distinctive double red flash every 10 seconds. Officially illuminated during a lighting ceremony on 15 May 2025, it continues the legacy of its predecessor—shining across the waters, guiding mariners, and marking a new chapter in Cavite's maritime story.

LUNGSOD NG BACOR, NANAWAGAN SA PANGULO PARA SA SUPORTA SA DRAINAGE AT FLOOD MITIGATION PLAN

NANAWAGAN ni Bacoor City Mayor Strike B. Revilla kay Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr., para sa interbensyon at suporta sa pondo para sa ahensibong Bacoor Drainage Plan at dredging ng mga kritikal na dam at ilog sa lungsod.

Nakasaad sa kanyang liham na patuloy ang paglala ng pagbaha sa Lungsod dahil sa pagkapuno ng mga daluyan ng tubig at luma ng mga drainage infrastructure kaya kailangan ng agarang aksyon mula sa pambansang pamahalaan para pondohan ang pagpapatupad ng Bacoor Drainage Plan sa pamamagitan ng mga foreign-assisted programs gaya ng Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) o ng National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (NDRRMF); o sa direktang interbensyon ng Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), National Irrigation Administration (NIA), at Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) para

sa malawakang dredging at legal na turnover ng Molino 3 at 4 Dams.

Kabilang din sa panawagan ang agarang desilting ng mga ilog at kanal sa Bacoor, lalo na sa mga barangay na madalas bahain, ayon sa City Engineering Office.

Ang Bacoor Drainage Plan ay nakabatay sa dalawang pangunahing plano: ang JICA Master Plan (2022), na binuo sa tulong ng Japan International Cooperation Agency, at ang karagdagang plano mula sa DPWH na kinabibilangan ng Draft Final Master Plan Report ng Certeza Infosys Corporation at isang supplemental feasibility study para sa Bacoor River Improvement Project.

Pansamantalang inaprubahan ng Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Bacoor ang mga planong ito sa pamamagitan ng City Resolution No. 2025-643, na kaakibat ng Writ of Continuing Mandamus ng Korte Suprema sa MMDA v. Concerned Residents of Manila Bay (G.R. Nos. 171947-

48), na kinikilala ang mahalagang papel ng Bacoor sa Manila Bay watershed.

Paliwanag ni Revilla na barado na ng burak at basura ang mga dam at ilog na dating nagpoproteta sa kanila kaya kinakailangan ng agarang suporta mula sa national government.

"Sa kabila ng aming patuloy na kahilingan sa mga ahensya gaya ng NIA para sa turnover ng Molino dams, wala pa ring malinaw na tugon. Ang pagkaantala sa administratibong proseso ay lubos na humahadlang sa aming kakayahang kumilos," ayon sa Alkalde.

Ipinahayag ng Lungsod ang kahandaang ipatupad at panagutan ang anumang tulong na maibibigay ng pambansang pamahalaan, sa mahigpit na koordinasyon sa mga kaukulang ahensya. Gayunpaman, binigyang-diin din nito ang pangangailangan ng agarang aksyon, sapagkat bawat araw ng pagkaantala ay dagdag na panganib sa mga residente at ari-arian.

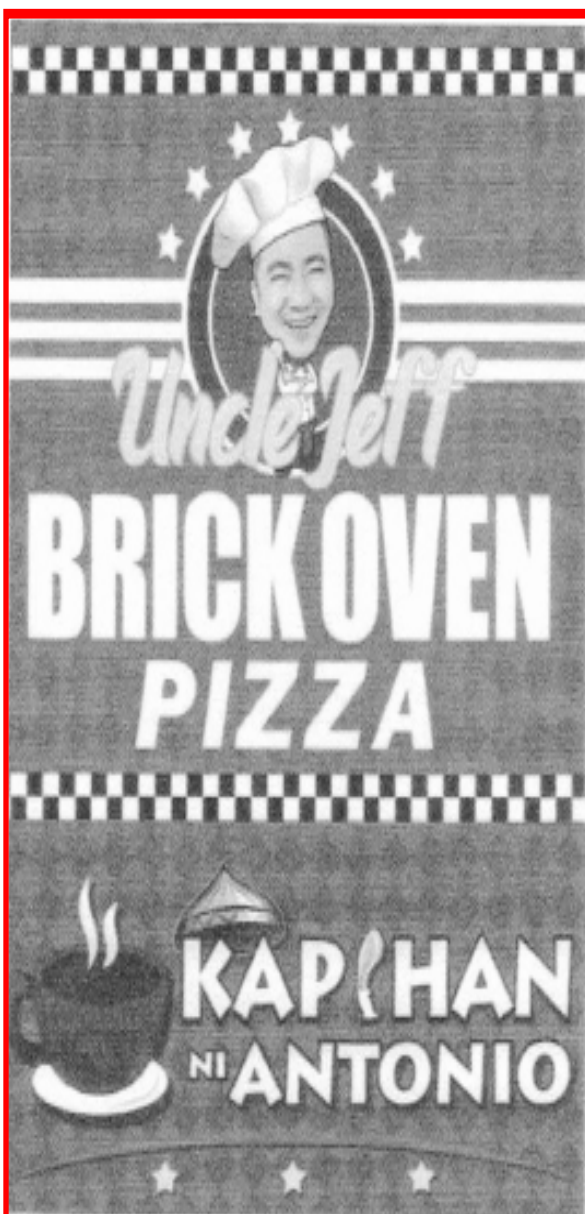
