Bacoor LGU Calls for National Gov't Support for Drainage and Flood Mitigation Plan

The City Government of Bacoor has officially requested immediate national intervention and funding support for the comprehensive Bacoor Drainage Plan and the urgent dredging of critical dams and rivers in the city.

In an official letter submitted to Malacañang, Mayor Strike Revilla emphasized the urgent need to address worsening flooding in Bacoor caused by severely clogged waterways and outdated drainage infrastructure.

Revilla further urged the national government to fund the implementation of the Bacoor Drainage Plan—whether through



foreign-assisted programs such as the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) or the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (NDRRMF); or through direct intervention by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), National Irrigation Administration (NIA), and Department of

Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) for large-scale dredging and the legal transfer of Molino 3 and 4 Dams.

The call also includes immediate desilting of rivers and canals, especially in flood-prone barangays prone to flooding identified by the City Engineering Office.

INITIAL ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN and all interested persons are directed to appear and show cause why the same should not be granted.

Let this Order be published once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.

A further perusal of the record shows that there is no proof that the Office of the Solicitor General was furnished with a copy of the petition.

Accordingly, petitioner is hereby ordered to submit proof of service of the petition and annexes thereof to the Office of the Solicitor General within five (5) days from receipt of this Order pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2-11-10-SC, Section 5, paragraph 4, which provides that:

"xxx it shall be filed in six copies. The petitioner shall serve a copy of the petition on the Office of the Solicitor General and the Office of the City or Provincial Prosecutor within five days from the date of its filing and submit to the court proof of such service within the same period xxx"

Failure to do so shall cause the dismissal of this case.

The Office of the Solicitor General is deemed notified of the case title and case number assigned to this case.

The Bacoor Drainage Plan is based on two main strategies: the JICA Master Plan (2022), developed with assistance from JICA, and a supplementary plan from the DPWH, including the Draft Final Master Plan Report from Certeza Infosys Corporation and an additional feasibility study for the Bacoor River Improvement Project. The Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor provisionally approved these plans through City Resolution No. 2025-643, aligned with the Writ of Continuing Mandamus from the

Supreme Court in MMDA v. Concerned Residents of Manila Bay (G.R. Nos. 171947-48), acknowledging Bacoor's vital role in the Manila Bay watershed.

The city expressed its readiness to implement and take responsibility for any assistance provided by the national government, in close coordination with relevant agencies. Nonetheless, it stressed the urgency for immediate action, as each day of delay increases risks to residents and property.

Cavite Career Caravan brings employment opportunities to Indang



A total of 171 jobseekers participated in the Cavite Career Caravan held on August 29, 2025, at the Indang Multipurpose Hall, resulting in 24 applicants hired on the spot. The event was spearheaded by the Provincial Government of Cavite through the OPG-Office of the Provincial Public Employment Service Manager (OPPESM) in coordination with the Local Government Unit of Indang.

The caravan featured job openings from 37 local companies and 4 overseas recruitment agencies covering a broad range of industries and skill levels. To further assist the applicants, several national government agencies were also present at the event, including the SSS, Philhealth, Pag-IBIG, PSA, DTI, NBI, TESDA, and BIR. These agencies provided support for applicants' additional documentary requirements and

answered queries related to membership, registration, and government services.

The Office of the Provincial Legal Officer also participated in the event, offering free legal advice and consultations to address employment-related concerns of the jobseekers. Mayor Virgilio Fidel expressed his gratitude to Governor Abeng Remulla, Vice Governor Ram Revilla Bautista, 7th District Congressman Ping

Remulla, and OPPESM Head Rizalie Pinpin-Enero for their invaluable support in making the event a success. The Cavite Career Caravan forms part of the province's wider initiative to bring employment opportunities closer to communities, especially in municipalities where access to job markets can be limited. It aims to empower Caviteños by directly connecting them with potential employers.

Kaalaman tungkol sa Asparagus bilang halamang gamot

Ang asparagus ay kilalang-kilala na gulay na kinakain ng mga Pilipino. Ang halaman ay maliit lamang na may maliliit at mala-kaliskis na mga dahon at maliliit na bilog na bunga. Karaniwan itong tumutubo sa mga malalamig na bansa sa Europa. Sa Pilipinas, ito ay makikita sa matataas na lugar tulad ng Benguet at Baguio.

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Asparagus?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang asparagus ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang ugat ng asparagus ay makikitaan ng ilang mga substansya at kemikal gaya ng sugar, gum, albumen, chloride, acetate at phosphate of potash, malates, at iba pa.

Ang bunga ay may taglay na grape-sugar at sparagancin.

Ang buto ay kinukuhanan ng langis, aromatic resin, sugar, at spargin.

Sa dahon naman, makakakuha ng amino acids at ilang mga inorganic na mineral

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:

Ang buong halaman ng asparagus ay ginagamit bilang halamang gamot. Karaniwang pinakukuluan ang buong halaman at iniinom ang sabaw.

Ano ang mga sakit na maaaring magamot ng Asparagus?

1. Rayuma. Kadalasang ginagamit ang katas ng halaman para ipanggamot sa pananakit ng mga kasukasuan dulot ng rayuma. Maaaring pakuluan ang halaman at ipainom ang pinaglagaan nito.

2. Tuberculosis. Ang ugat ng halamang asparagus ay ginagamit ding panglunas sa karamdamang tuberculosis.

3. Hirap sa pag-ihi. Mabisa ring panglunas sa hirap sa pag-ihi ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng ugat ng asparagus.

4. Pamamanas o gout. Ang pinakuluang gulay na asparagus ay mabisang panglunas din sa pamamanas at gout sa ilang bahagi ng katawan.

5. Cancer. May ilang pag-aaral din ang nagsasabing may taglay na ilang mga sustansya na makapagpapaliit o makakabawas ng pagkalat ng cancer cells sa katawan.

6. Pananakit ng ngipin. Sa ibang lugar, sinusunog ang ugat ng asparagus at pinapaamoy sa taong nakararamdam ng pananakit ng ngipin.

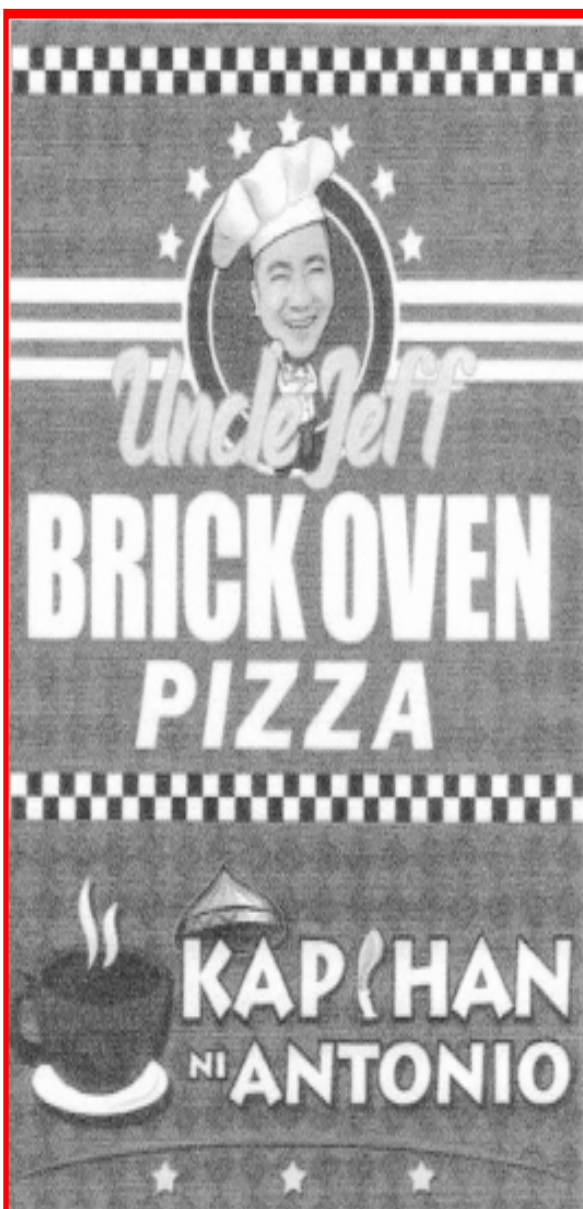
