SOWING SUCCESS



Niño de Guzman, 38, a proud CARD SME Bank client and agripreneur from General Santos City, stands on his flourishing asparagus and corn farm. It is his living testament that hard work and perseverance can turn small dreams into reality.

In Barangay San Jose, General Santos City, lives a man whose story proves that success is not born from wealth; it is grown through hard work, faith, and perseverance. Niño de Guzman, a vocational graduate, husband, and father of three, has transformed his humble beginnings into a thriving agribusiness that not only changed his life but also uplifted those around him.

His journey from a sari-sari store owner to a successful agripreneur is a story worth telling and one that is truly inspiring.

Humble Beginnings

Born into a family that relied on agriculture as its primary source of livelihood, Niño was raised with a deep respect for the land and the value of perseverance. From a young age, he was immersed in farming and fishing life, helping his parents and learning how to make a living from the soil and sea. These early experiences would ultimately shape his future.

Before fully committing to farming, Niño explored various livelihood opportunities. He sold fish and engaged in multiple income-generating activities to support his

growing family. For two years, he worked at an automotive company while his wife managed their modest sari-sari store. However, it was always agriculture that drew him.

With a small dream and limited capital, Niño started a modest farming venture. Over time, that small seed blossomed into a thriving agribusiness focused on high-value crops such as asparagus, sweet and purple corn, and more.

"In doing business, it's important to separate personal matters from business," Niño shares, highlighting one of the key principles that helped him succeed.

Weathering the storms

Agriculture, while fulfilling, is not without its challenges. Natural calamities often pose threats to crops and disrupt operations. But Niño's resilience shines in these moments. His approach is grounded in preparedness and smart financial management.

"In times of calamities, it is essential to have savings, so you have something to use when things get tough," he advises.

Through a positive mindset and a commitment to sustainable farming practices, Niño has been able to sustain and grow his business even through adversity.

A crucial part of Niño's growth was made possible with his six-year clientship with CARD SME Bank, a thrift bank under CARD MRI. With a modest loan of PHP 3,000, he reached a total of PHP 350,000, which he reinvested to improve operations and expand his

agribusiness.

With the success of the business, his produce is distributed not only around General Santos City but also to markets in Cotabato, Davao, and even Manila. He now employs 15 workers and earns at least PHP 150,000 per month, a remarkable leap from where he began.

"We decided to stay consistent and committed to our business because we saw how it changed our lives," Niño reflects.

With this support, he not only uplifted his own family but also created opportunities for others in his community.

Giving back to the community

Today, Niño is more than just a farmer; he is a changemaker. By employing local workers and partnering with small seed producers, he plays a vital role in strengthening the agricultural economy in his area.

"As a way of giving back, we support local seed producers by buying the seeds from them, and continue to provide jobs to the local community," he says.

Looking ahead, Niño dreams of expanding his farm even further, with hopes of securing a comfortable retirement and a better future for his family. But more than that, he wants to continue planting seeds of opportunity for others that create a legacy rooted in service and success.

"To aspiring entrepreneurs, especially those starting from humble beginnings, if you don't try, you will never see success in life. Despite life's challenges, if you persevere, nothing is impossible," he concluded.

Kaalaman tungkol sa Asparagus bilang halamang gamot

Ang asparagus ay kilalang-kilala na gulay na kinakain ng mga Pilipino. Ang halaman ay maliit lamang na may maliliit at mala-kaliskis na mga dahon at maliliit na bilog na bunga. Karaniwan itong tumutubo sa mga malalamig na bansa sa Europa. Sa Pilipinas, ito ay makikita sa matataas na lugar tulad ng Benguet at Baguio.

Ano ang mga sustansya at kemikal na maaaring makuha sa Asparagus?

Ang iba't ibang bahagi ng halamang asparagus ay maaaring makuhanan ng maraming uri ng kemikal at sustansya na maaaring may benepisyo sa kalusugan:

Ang ugat ng asparagus ay makikitaan ng ilang mga substansya at kemikal gaya ng sugar, gum, albumen, chloride, acetate at phosphate of potash, malates, at iba pa.

Ang bunga ay may taglay na grape-sugar at sparagancin.

Ang buto ay kinukuhanan ng langis, aromatic resin, sugar, at spargin.

Sa dahon naman, makakakuha ng amino acids at ilang mga inorganic na mineral

Anong bahagi ng halaman ang ginagamit bilang gamot, at paano ginagamit ang mga ito?

Maaaring gamitin bilang gamot ang ilang bahagi ng halaman tulad ng:

Ang buong halaman ng asparagus ay ginagamit bilang halamang gamot. Karaniwang pinakukuluan ang buong halaman at iniinom ang sabaw.

Ano ang mga sakit na maaaring magamot ng Asparagus?

1. Rayuma. Kadalasang ginagamit ang katas ng halaman para ipanggamot sa pananakit ng mga kasukasuan dulot ng rayuma. Maaaring pakuluan ang halaman at ipainom ang pinaglagaan nito.

2. Tuberculosis. Ang ugat ng halamang asparagus ay ginagamit ding panglunas sa karamdamang tuberculosis.

3. Hirap sa pag-ihi. Mabisa ring panglunas sa hirap sa pag-ihi ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng ugat ng asparagus.

4. Pamamanas o gout. Ang pinakuluang gulay na asparagus ay mabisang panglunas din sa pamamanas at gout sa ilang bahagi ng katawan.

5. Cancer. May ilang pag-aaral din ang nagsasabing may taglay na ilang mga sustansya na makapagpapaliit o makakabawas ng pagkalat ng cancer cells sa katawan.

6. Pananakit ng ngipin. Sa ibang lugar, sinusunog ang ugat ng asparagus at pinapaamoy sa taong nakararamdam ng pananakit ng ngipin.

7. Hirap sa pagdumi o pagtitibi. Ang ugat ng halaman ay karaniwang ginagamit din para padaliin ang pagdudumi.

8. Hang over. Nakatutulong ang pag-inom ng pinaglagaan ng asparagus at pagkain ng mismong gulay nito sa pagbawas ng epekto ng alak sa katawan.

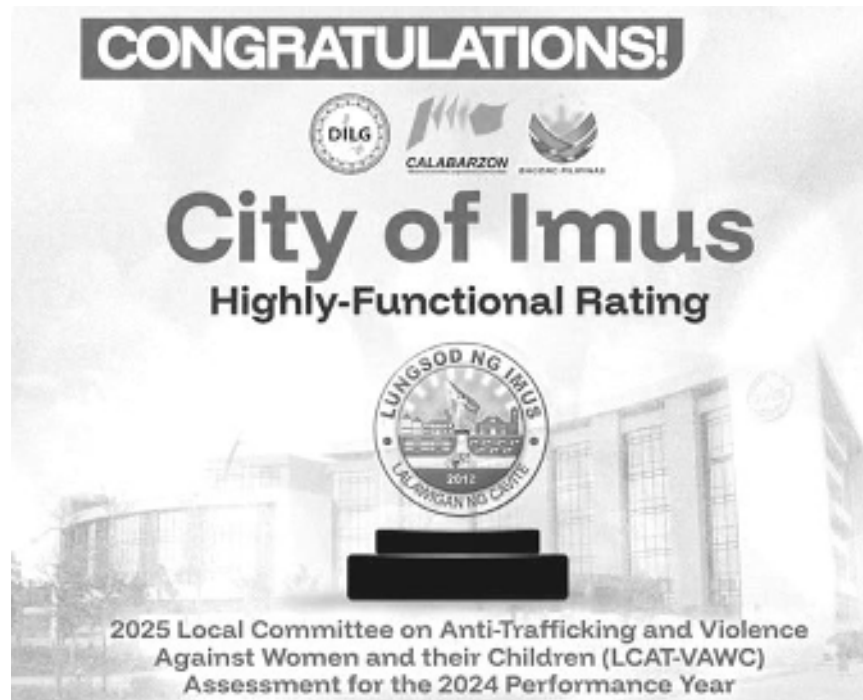
